Chairman's Review



主席報告書

Since being elected as Chairman in April 2005, I have come to realize what a job it is to keep up with all the Chamber activities during a twelve-month cycle. Every month creates new opportunities to meet people from all walks of life and sectors of business at Chamber events, and to hear their views.

Hong Kong had a very eventful 2005, not least of which was the experience of having three Chief Executives – Tung Chee-hwa, Henry Tang Ying-yen (albeit, acting) and Donald Tsang Yam-kuen — and two Policy Addresses all in the same year! It is a testimony to our institutions and our deepening political maturity that this unusual transition proceeded without any disruption to our excellent government services. Indeed, hosting the 6th

World Trade Organization Ministerial Conference (MC6) in December had a greater impact on most people's lives than did the year's political adjustments.

On policy matters there may have been a slight pause early in the year as senior officials settled into their new roles, but certainly no change of direction.

We expect that the key issues such as public sector reform, expanded public-private partnership, tackling our ever-worsening air quality, broadening the tax base and passing the long-overdue anti-racial discrimination law will return to the top of the agenda in 2006.

The expiration of the global textile quota system at the end of 2004 resulted in a highly predictable surge of



自從於 2005 年 4 月當選主席後,我發現要緊貼總 商會全年所有活動和項目,殊非易事。總商會每月 都會透過不同項目和場合接觸各行各業人士,聆聽 他們的意見和聲音。

香港的2005年事件簿非常充實,其中包括特首一職經過董建華、唐英年(雖然只是署任)和曾蔭權三人交接,為此港府去年更曾兩度發表施政報告。儘管如此、這段鮮見的過渡期卻未有干擾政府的出色服務,可見本港架構健全,政治日趨成熟。事實上,年內政治變動對廣大市民的影響,反不及香港12月主辦的世貿第6次部長級會議來得直接和切實。

去年初當政府高層出現新的人手調配之際,當局的政策工作稍為停頓了一陣子,但方針維持不變。我們期望政府今年重新著力推進關鍵工作,例如推行公務員改革、擴大公私營合作、改善日益惡化的空氣質素、擴闊税基及通過拖延以久的反種族歧視法例等。

全球紡織品配額制度於2004年底取消後,一如業界所料,大量中國出口產品湧入歐美主要市場,而歐美國家以保護手段回應也是意料中事。因此本會去年舉辦了6個小型研討會以討論相關課題,及舉行講座專題討論反傾銷調查的應對策略。

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exports from China to major markets in the U.S. and Europe. The equally predictable protectionist response was the subject of no less than six roundtables during the year, as well as a seminar on strategies for dealing with anti-dumping investigations.

And while on the subject of trade, more parochially, your Chamber remained an active lobbyist on your behalf for further expansion of the Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA) with the Mainland of China. After soliciting views from a wide range of member companies, we submitted a 20-page 'wish list' to government. I should also note that one of the key items on our previous lists — renminbi bank accounts in Hong Kong — has been realized.

The year under review was an active one for your Chamber, and a prosperous year for Hong Kong. The SAR has some 30,000 more companies in 2005 than in 2004; many of whom we hope will join the Chamber. Tourism arrivals reached a new record high as 23.35 million people visited our city, more than half of them from the Mainland of China. Nearly 100,000 new jobs were created, which helped to reduce under- and unemployment by over 55,000.

Our stock market capitalization topped the US\$1 trillion level in 2005, moving us into eighth place worldwide. We helped companies raise a record HK\$192 billion in initial public offerings, double the 2004 level and 45% higher than the previous record high set in

在區內貿易方面,總商會繼續積極為商界爭取進一步擴大「更緊密經貿關係安排」(CEPA)之內容。本會收集各行各業會員意見後,編製了一份20頁長的「期望清單」提交予政府考慮,我亦留意到本會較早前向當局提出於香港提供人民幣銀行帳戶服務的建議,已得到實現。

去年香港市道一片興旺,總商會會務亦繁忙而充實。2005年本港企業數目比上年增加了3萬多家,相信當中不少也有機會成為我們的會員。年內訪港旅客創下2,335萬人次的新高,其中逾半來自中國內地。另外,去年新增職位超過10萬個,使本港的就業不足及失業者減少55,000多人。

2005年香港股市市值高達1兆美元,全球排名上升至第8位。年內初次公開招股的集資額高達1,920億港元,創出新高,較2004年增加一倍,也較上次於2000年創下的紀錄高出45%。去年在香港透過初次公開招股集資的公司佔6成以上是內地企業。

本港去年雖面對不穩定因素,仍能創出佳績,令人 鼓舞。除了上文提過的政治轉變外,2005年油價 上升逾35%,較上一年的33%增幅更高。此外, 去年北京當局把人民幣兑美元匯價初步調升 2.1%,是中央自1990年代中葉以來首次調整匯 價。儘管面前存在挑戰,香港市道依然暢旺,原因 之一是我們高度講求效率。 2000. More than 60% of the funds raised through IPOs were for Mainland companies.

Impressively, this string of records was set during a year of uncertainty. Aside from the political hiccups that I mentioned earlier, oil prices were up more than 35% in 2005, after a 33% rise the previous year. Too, the monetary authorities in Beijing made the first adjustment to their exchange rate regime since the mid-1990s, initially raising the value of the renminbi by 2.1% vis-à-vis the US-dollar. Yet our city prospered, in part because we are extremely efficient.

December saw Hong Kong host, with some trepidation, the Sixth Ministerial Conference of the World Trade Organization. While we firmly believe in the principles of free trade, WTO meetings have been met with violent protests elsewhere, and so it wasn't surprising that the gathering in Hong Kong was accompanied by clashes between protesters and police. While few of us would sympathize with such violent means to an end, we certainly can be proud that the Hong Kong Police came away with their well-deserved reputation for discipline and fair play firmly intact.

Hong Kong was also the site for the Pacific Basin Economic Council's 38th International General Meeting. As PBEC Chairman, I had a firsthand view of how the Chamber – which also served as the PBEC Secretariat – manages major events, and it is very impressive.

去年12月,世貿第6次部長級會議在當局審慎策劃下於香港順利完成。雖然香港完全支持自由貿易,但鑑於以往外地多次世貿會議都遇上激烈的示威活動,香港世貿會議期間發生示威者與警方衝突亦是意料中事。對於以暴力方式表達訴求,大多數市民都不表贊同,不過一向以紀律嚴明、執法公正著稱的香港警務人員在會議期間亦不負眾望,全力以赴,維持社會治安。

此外,太平洋地區經濟理事會第38屆國際年會也於 去年在香港舉行。當時本人為太經理事會主席,而 總商會則擔任太經理事會秘書處。透過是次年會· 本人對總商會籌備大型項目之專業能力刮目相看。 政策方面·總商會尤其積極提倡環保措施。去年9月,本會與香港商界環保大聯盟、大珠三角商務委員會及內地相關組織攜手發起《清新空氣約章》·以配合「清新空氣計劃」之推行。該計劃旨在透過一系列公眾運動和項目,鼓勵企業採取措施,監控本身業務營運對環境的影響。事實上,我認為應多鼓勵港商以身作則,監控其內地廠房的排放,並以開放的態度接受檢測,為內地同業樹立榜樣。

兩年前沙士一役過後,近期出現的禽流感疫情又 再引起中港兩地以至全球高度關注。衛生署衛生 防護中心總監梁柏賢醫生去年11月蒞臨本會,向

CHAIRMAN'S REVIEW

On the policy front, your Chamber was particularly active in the environmental field. Together with the Hong Kong Business Coalition on the Environment, the Greater Pearl River Delta Business Council, and related organizations from across the boundary, the Chamber launched the landmark Clean Air Charter in September. This Charter is part of Project Clean Air which comprises a number of initiatives to encourage enterprises to audit, monitor and take action to control their own environmental impact. In fact I sometimes wonder whether we should not be encouraging our own Hong Kong businesses that operate across the boundary to lead by example in emission controls from their factories, and open themselves up to independent inspection.

Two years after SARS, we now have avian flu high on the list of cross-border and global concerns. Dr Leung Pak Yin, Controller for Health Protection of the Department of Health, briefed members in November on the dangers of and — more importantly — measures to control avian flu. International business, the environment, cross-border infectious disease and cutting-edge thinking from the world's opinion leaders remain on the Chamber's agenda for the coming year, and you may expect to hear much more about all of these issues.

Financially, we have continued to do well, as you will see from the data provided elsewhere in this Annual Report.

Our financial independence allows us to undertake projects on other than a for-profit basis, and in doing so

To my fellow members, I would like to thank you for participating in our Chamber events, and to extend an open invitation to provide to the Chamber secretariat your thoughts.

And before I close, a special word of thanks to our outgoing CEO, who informed the General Committee towards the end of 2005 of his intention to leave the Chamber at the end of April 2006. Eden came to us a little over eight years ago and very quickly established himself as a leader, and one who does so by example. I can tell you that he has made the lives of successive Chairmen of the Chamber a lot easier by his untiring commitment to the Chamber, and has ensured on behalf of all its members that the Chamber is very often the first port of call for government officials, local and foreign business people, and the many missions that come through Hong Kong, seeking advice, comment or direction. I am sure you will all join me in wishing him well as he moves into the commercial world.

Lastly, I wish you all every success in your business in 2006, and to Hong Kong in the years ahead.

CEO's Report



總裁報告

All of you who have been in Hong Kong since 1997 know that the years since the handover have been like a roller-coaster in Hong Kong. We saw the deep depression of the Asian Financial Crisis rising to the optimism of economic recovery in 2004, and then to the euphoria of a bustling economy in 2005. In fact, economists tell us that having two such years of back-to-back economic prosperity is so rare in Hong Kong that we have to go back to the 1980s to find a similar stretch of boom.

As a result, the Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce also had a second straight year of excellent financial health, while trying to adjust its services to help members in a time of better business conditions.

In 2005, we basically put the majority of our efforts in five areas:

1. We tried very hard to improve our business assistance capability for members. The Members Helpline was improved, with answers required to be given by our staff to callers within two working days. Every month, we logged about 120 phone calls from members with questions large or small. In addition, our China Economist fielded four or five telephone calls per week on business problems in China. Our Chief Economist helped our members understand the economic conditions, current and future, and explained to foreign investors and journalists the investment environment in Hong Kong. We also arranged dozens of

自 1997年以來一直居於香港的市民,都知道回歸 後香港的歷程就像坐過山車一樣。在亞洲金融危機 期間,我們曾一度掉進谷底,其後擺脱逆境,經濟 ※ 2004年重拾升軌,強勁復甦,興旺之勢頭更延 至 2005年。事實上,經濟師都指出,連續兩年 是有分景的情況甚為罕見,對上一次出現已是 80 年代的事。

2005年,本會工作主要集中於以下五方面:

1. 我們致力為會員提供更佳商務支援。「會員支援熱線」經已改良,所有來電查詢均會於兩個工作天內得到本會職員答覆。我們每月平均接獲約120個會員來電,查問大大小小的商務問題。本會的中國經濟師每週也會收到4、5個關於內地營商問題的電話查詢。我們的首席經濟師則協助會員瞭解目前和未來經濟形勢,並向外地商界和傳媒介紹香港的投資環境。去年我們安排了多個商質配對會,讓會員與訪港的商貿團體會面,藉此建立內地或海外

business-matching seminars for our members with visiting delegations, providing members the opportunity to connect with trade prospects from the Mainland or overseas. Finally, in July, we took over as the Secretariat of the Hong Kong-Mainland Joint Business Liaison Committee, which was formed five years ago to resolve business disputes encountered by our members in the Mainland. The SME members of the Chamber especially appreciated our efforts to raise our capabilities in the business assistance area.

2. We placed a great deal of emphasis on the environment in 2005. In June, we launched "Project Clean Air," starting with a Clean Air Charter which we circulated for member companies to sign, and was also

endorsed by our Guangdong counterpart. This project is supported by many associations around town, with our Chamber being the secretariat. It was also mentioned by the SAR Government in its discussions with Guangdong Province. We organized a Clean Air Day in the fall to raise the awareness of how to lessen air pollution. And, throughout the life of the project, funded by several members very much concerned about air quality in Hong Kong, we are educating the public and lobbying SAR and Mainland officials on the "crisis" nature of the air pollution problem in Hong Kong. In addition, we started a series of seminars on our harbour, a treasure of Hong Kong which sadly is falling victim to irregular planning and use. Our air, our water, and our harbour, and in turn, our quality of life are under siege, thereby

2. 去年本會著力提倡環保。我們於6月啟動「清新空氣計劃」,並隨即發起《清新空氣約章》,鼓勵會員公司簽署及實踐環保措施,該運動更得到廣東省同業支持。「清新空氣計劃」由本會擔任秘書處,城中多個組織全力給予支持,特區政府與廣東省當局商討之過程中也特別提到這項計劃。

其後本會於秋季舉辦「清新空氣日」,以提高市民的環保意識,鼓勵大家身體力行,協助減少空氣污染。「清新空氣計劃」得以推行,有賴幾名關注香港空氣問題的會員慷慨贊助。計劃之項目及活動旨在向市民灌輸環保知識,並希望令特區和內地官員明白,香港空氣污染問題其實可帶來危機。年內我們也舉辦了一連串研討會,探討海港相關議題。海港是我們的珍貴資源,但卻被規劃和運用不善所審。目前,本港的空氣、水質、海港以至生活素質每況愈下,本會非常關注香港的競爭力會因此而被削弱。

reducing Hong Kong's competitiveness, something that the Chamber is very concerned about.

3. In the latter part of 2005, we swung into full gear on WTO work. We started with the education phase by organizing a series of workshops informing members what is at stake in the Doha Round WTO negotiations. We also were in constant contact with the SAR Government to present the business community's "wishes" regarding the Ministerial talks held in Hong Kong in December 2005. Our Coalition of Service Industries can safely be called THE expert on WTO in the Hong Kong business community, and for many years in the past it had been registered as the only business NGO at the WTO Ministerial. In the case of the Hong Kong conference, we

were in the halls every day and every hour, pressing our concerns to delegates and reporting to members via the media and via our Website. We like to believe that we had a small role in nudging the talks to a successful conclusion, with which the Chamber was very pleased.

4. In order for Hong Kong to be competitive, and in order for the Chamber to be useful, international connections are very important. We received over 150 delegations during the year in review from overseas, and we sent several missions outbound, with Dubai & Tehran, and Singapore & Malaysia being our major trade mission destinations in 2005. The first half of 2005 saw the Chamber preoccupied with putting together a major international business conference — The 38th

International General Meeting of the Pacific Basin Economic Council. Over 500 business leaders attended from both sides of the Pacific Ocean, with numerous government leaders, as well as business speakers, coming to address them. In total, we had 54 speakers at this two-day conference. Madam Wu Yi, Vice Premier of China, and Dato' Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, the Prime Minister of Malaysia, were the headliners. Former U.S. Secretary of State General Colin Powell also addressed the group. In-depth seminars explored topics from environment to disasters to corporate governance to China business. It was a complex conference for the Chamber to run, but the result was very useful information to members and exposure of Hong Kong to an international business audience.

5. We cannot be a business association in Hong Kong without having significant China relations. We kicked off the year with a large delegation to the Northeast of China: Heilongjiang, Jilin, and Liaoning Provinces. Late in 2004, the Central Liaison Office (CLO) came to us and asked us to co-organize a delegation to that region with the Hong Kong Chinese Enterprises Association (HKCEA). Thirty of our members joined thirty members from the HKCEA and went for one week under the guidance of Madam Guo Li, Vice Director of the CLO. To this date, I still find delegates with business deals coming out of that very useful visit. Throughout the year, we had visits to the Pearl River Delta and to Sichuan for the 9+2 meetings, and we organized a Pearl River Delta conference in Guangzhou. Two visits to

5. 我們須擁有龐大的中國聯繫網,才算是個服務全面的香港商會。去年初本會舉辦了大型的東北三省(黑龍江、吉林和遼寧)訪問團。事緣於2004年底,中央聯絡辦事處(中聯辦)邀請我們與香港中國企業協會(中企協)一起組團赴東北考察。此行由中聯辦副主任郭莉女士擔任廳問,本會和中企協分別有30名會員參加。以我所知,該次東北之行至今

仍然為會員帶來商機。此外,本會去年訪問過珠江 三角洲及出席四川的「9+2」會議,下半年更在廣 州舉辦珠三角會議。年內我們曾兩度訪問北京,一 次是中國委員會赴京與內地機關討論營商的技術性 問題,另一次則由本會主席率領高層代表團上京, 與內地領導層談論中港商貿關係。去年共有70多 個內地團體來訪本會,我們亦與內地省市合辦了 128 個商貿展和講座。

這是我最後一次以總裁身份向大家報告會務,因為 我已於11月向總商會提出請辭,並計劃於2006年 春季離任。為總商會工作是件愉快的事,從中也獲 Beijing were made — one by the China Committee to discuss technical China business issues and the other, a high-level one, led by our Chairman, to discuss Hong Kong-China business relations. Coming in our direction were over 70 delegations from the Mainland who visited the Chamber and our members, and we co-organized 128 trade fairs and seminars with Mainland provinces and cities.

I have to tell you at this point that this will be my last report to you as the CEO of the Chamber. This is because I turned in my resignation from the Chamber in November, and I expect to leave the post in the spring of 2006. I have had a most wonderful and rewarding time in the Chamber, and as I said in the

opening sentence of this article, Hong Kong was like a roller-coaster, and I was one of the passengers through all these years with the Chamber. Without the terrific staff, the supportive members, and the dedicated Chairmen and Chamber leadership, I would not have enjoyed the ride as much as I did. I wish all of you a most prosperous 2006 and years beyond! Thank you!

國際商務部專責拓展和推廣環球商務聯繫,並為有意建立海外商務聯繫的會員提供服務。工作範圍包括籌辦外地考察團;為到訪海外商務代表團和訪客舉行會議;以及收集會員對國際商貿的意見,向有關當局反映。

The International Business Division is responsible for developing and promoting global business connections and the provision of services to Chamber members interested in establishing business contacts outside of Hong Kong. It organises outgoing missions and hosts meetings for incoming delegations and visitors from abroad. It is also responsible for collecting the views of members on international business and trade issues and making these views known to the relevant authorities.

PBEC International General Meeting

The highlight of 2005 for the International Business
Division was the Pacific Basic Economic Council (PBEC)
38th International General Meeting in Hong Kong. Over
500 delegates from the Pacific Basin region travelled to
Hong Kong in June to attend the conference. Among
the high profile speakers at the two-day event were

China's Vice Premier Madam Wu Yi, Malaysian Prime Minister Dato' Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, the then Director General of the World Trade Organization Dr Supachai Panitchpakdi, Malaysian Minister of International Trade and Industry Dato' Seri Rafidah Aziz, and Former United States Secretary of State General Colin Powell. Under the theme of "Pacific Basin:

去年6月在香港舉行的太平洋地區經濟理事會(太經理事會)第38屆國際年會,是國際商務部去年工作重點所在,來港出席年會的太平洋地區代表逾500人。為會議作演説的國際知名人士包括中國副總理吳儀女士、馬來西亞總理巴達維、前世界貿易組織總幹事索帕猜博士、馬來西亞國際貿易及工業部長拉菲達及美國前國務卿鮑威爾將軍。是次為期兩天的年會以「太平洋地區:引領環球經濟發展」為主題,呼籲亞太各國加強合作,以消除糾紛及促進區內和全球貿易。

CEPA 及珠江三角洲(泛珠三角)

2005 年是 CEPA 實施的第三年,年內國際商務部 繼續監察協議的推行進度,並就某些行業的進一步 開放向港府提交建議。

珠三角是本會策劃2005年工作時著重的一個課題。 年內香港總商會繼續參與大珠三角商務委員會(請參 閱工商政策部之報告)的工作,並於9月在廣州舉行 題為「增長、發展與其影響」的第四屆珠三角會議。 此外,國際商務部曾率團赴佛山和江門考察,及舉 辦小型午餐會探討與珠三角有關的議題。

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Setting the Pace for the Global Economy," the conference called for closer cooperation to eliminate disputes and enhance regional and global trade.

CEPA & the Pearl River Delta (Pan-PRD)

2005 marked the third year of CEPA's implementation, and the Division continued to monitor the progress of the agreement. It also continued to provide valuable input to the Hong Kong Government on further liberalization of certain sectors.

The PRD was a major element in the Chamber's work plan in 2005. HKGCC continued to provide input on the Greater Pearl River Delta Business Council (see the Business Policy Division's report), and organized the Fourth Pearl River Delta Conference, entitled "Growth and Its Consequences," held in Guangzhou in September. The Division also led a study mission to Foshan and Jiangmen in the PRD, as well as organized roundtable luncheons on the PRD throughout the year.

With regard to the Pan-PRD, a Chamber delegation attended the Economic Forum, and the Pan-PRD Joint Associations Annual meeting of the 2nd Pan-PRD Regional Cooperation and Development Forum on July 25 in Chengdu. During the meeting, the Chamber explored ways to enhance cooperation with other chambers of commerce in the region.

外地考察團及到訪代表團

年內國際商務部籌辦了8個考察團,分別訪問中國 東北部、北京、天津、成都、廈門、珠三角、新加 坡及馬來西亞和杜拜及德黑蘭,助會員瞭解內地和 環球市場·擴展視野·發掘商機。

該部去年接待了110組來自世界各地的代表團和 前客,其中包括國家元首,如巴基斯坦總理肖卡 特•阿齊茲,以及各國政府部長和多個內地省份的 省長。

商員資訊、聯繫及機遇

去年國際商務部曾舉辦多個講座、工作坊、小型會 議及午餐會·助會員瞭解與其業務息息相關的最新 商貿課題。該部還舉辦酒會,招待亞洲,非洲和歐 美國家總領事・為會員提供拓展人脈的良機・並協 助安排會員與歐洲貿易專員個別面談。此外,本會 與各地組織簽訂了7項「合作協議備忘錄」。

Outgoing missions and incoming delegations

During the year under review, the Division organised eight missions to expand members' outreach to Mainland and global markets. Missions were organized to: North East China, Beijing, Tianjin, Chengdu, Xiamen, PRD, Singapore & Malaysia, and Dubai & Tehran.

In terms of incoming delegations and visitors, the Division received 110 groups from around the world in 2005, including a head of state, Shaukat Aziz, the Prime Minister of Pakistan. The Division also received government ministers from around the globe as well as provincial governors from Mainland China.

Business information, networking and matching

During the year under review, the Division organized seminars, workshops, roundtable discussions and luncheons to keep members abreast of the latest issues affecting their business. It also organized networking opportunities through cocktail receptions for Consuls General of Asian/African, Americas and European countries, as well as individual meetings with Trade Commissioners from Europe. The Chamber also signed seven Memorandums of Understanding with organizations around the world in 2005.

Trade conflicts arising from textile quotas being imposed by the United States and the European Union on Chinese

In 2005, HKGCC signed Memorandums of Understanding with:

- The Federation of Bangladesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FBCCI)

Members also made good use of the business inquiries and matching services to enlarge their client base and to solve rudimentary business questions. Over 300 business inquiries were handled by the Division in 2005.

The Hong Kong-Mainland Joint Business Liaison Committee (JBLC)

The Chamber took on the role of Committee Secretariat of the JBLC at the committee's 5th Annual General

Meeting in Chengdu on July 26. During the meeting, the committee agreed to enhance the flow of information and exchanges between Hong Kong and the Mainland to better resolve problems faced by Hong Kong companies doing business in the Mainland.

Pacific Basin Economic Council (PBEC)

The direct membership recruitment policy adopted by PBEC International has rendered the role of regional PBEC committees obsolete. Therefore, at the 16th Annual General Meeting of PBEC Hong Kong Member Committee on September 30, members needed to consider what will be the future role of the committee.

Business Policy Division



工商政策部

工商政策部主要負責促進、代表及捍衛商界利益,就公共政策,特別是有關中小型企業、環境保護、工業和科技、服務業等事務,制定及倡議總商會的意見和立場。

The primary function of the Business Policy Division is to promote, represent and safeguard the business sector's interest through formulating and advocating Chamber views and positions on public policies, especially those relating to small- and medium-sized enterprises, environment, industry & technology, and service industries.

Business policies overview

The Business Policy Division handled a diverse range of policy issues and activities during the year under review, with competition policy continuing to be a major focus of the Division. The Expert Group on Competition Policy, convened by the Chamber under the auspices of its service policy think tank, the Hong Kong Coalition of Service Industries (HKCSI), concluded its report and submitted it to the Financial Secretary. The report,

compiled over two years, provides substantive input into the government's ongoing review on the reform of Hong Kong's competition policy.

In addition to supporting the "No Fakes" campaign, the Chamber continued to discuss with government proposals to amend the Copyright Ordinance, an issue which would affect every business.

WTO MC6

One of the highlights of the Division's activities in 2005 was the Sixth Ministerial Conference (MC6) of the World Trade Organization. In preparation for MC6, the Chamber, through the HKCSI, advocated to government greater business representation during the WTO negotiations. It also outlined the business position on negotiations, organized meetings among members and government officials, and conferred with CSIs internationally on safeguarding the private sector's interests in the negotiations, as well as coordinated joint statements of the Global Services Coalition (GSC) on the WTO negotiations.

The Division also organized dozens of activities prior to MC6, including roundtable luncheons, press commentaries and

The Chamber was very active before the WTO's 6th Ministerial Conference organizing talks, including with Raymond Young, Director-General of Trade and Industry, with ministers during the ministerial and also hosted a cocktail reception to welcome NGO delegates.

此外,該部透過圍繞世貿主題的小型午餐會、傳媒評論和演說,增進會員對世貿會議的認識。在MC6舉行期間,本會派出6名認可代表全程參與其中,積極表達香港商界的訴求,並協助環球服務業聯盟

環境委員會去年忙個不休,期間尤其關注淨化海港計劃和都市固體廢物處理策略等重大環境政策。委員會亦代表本會支持「環保產品獎」和「環保企業獎」等商界表揚計劃,以及政府可持續發展委員會發起的社會參與過程,以提高社會各界的環保意識。

During the conference itself, HKGCC's six accredited representatives to MC6 worked hard representing the Chamber as well as coordinating the lobbying work of the GSC. HKCSI chaired a seminar with WTO Director General Pascal Lamy, and also hosted a "Business@MC6" welcome cocktail reception for overseas business NGOs with Invest Hong Kong.

Environment Committee

The Environment Committee was extremely busy during the year under review monitoring key policy issues, especially the Harbour Area Treatment Scheme and municipal solid waste disposal. It also represented the Chamber in a number of green business campaigns, including the "Eco-Products Award," and the "Eco-Business Award," as well as a stakeholder engagement programme spearheaded by the Council for Sustainable Development.

The most important environmental initiative for the committee in 2005 was "Project Clean Air." The ongoing project aims to improve air quality in the Pearl River Delta and was established under the auspices of the Business Coalition on the Environment (BCE) with its 31 constituent bodies. The project also had the endorsement of Chief Executive Donald Tsang, who mentioned the Clean Air Charter – the project's centerpiece – in his Policy Address. The Clean Air Charter is also supported by the Greater Pearl River Delta Business Council, including, the Guangdong side of the PRD Business Council.

Mainland China

The Division continued to support the Chamber's work on CEPA and the Pearl River Delta during the year under review. It also led a delegation to participate in the Greater PRD Council's Joint Investment and Trade Promotion Subgroup, chaired by former HKGCC Chairman Anthony Nightingale.

The subgroup held several joint meetings with its Guangdong counterpart during the year, both in Hong Kong and across the border. Both sides also cooperated on a HKSAR Government-funded study on attracting Mainland enterprises to Hong Kong, and an investment seminar held in Guangzhou in September to promote investment in Hong Kong by Guangdong enterprises.

Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce

Economy – Society – Environment: Achieving Harmony

The Chamber is a firm believer in sustainable development. We strive to put sustainable development principles into practice in our daily operation. In 2003 the first of our biennial Sustainability Reports was published as part of the Annual Report. This, the second Sustainability Report by the Chamber, covers the years 2004 and 2005.

Environment: A green Chamber

Our most significant environment initiative in 2004/05 was the launch of Project Clean Air, a business-wide effort to help clean up the air in Hong Kong and the Pearl River Delta. The project was initiated by the Chamber and conducted under the auspices of the Business Coalition on the Environment, for which the Chamber provides the secretariat.

Besides promulgating a Clean Air Charter for the business sector – to which some 200 companies have signed up – Project Clean Air also included public campaigns to bring the clean air message to ordinary people. A highlight of the project was the Clean Air Day on November 20, 2005, which the Chamber organized jointly with the Environment Campaign Committee at the public square of the Museum

of Science. It was on the Clean Air Day that the Clean Air Charter was formally announced. Also launched on that day was the "7-7-7 Care for Air Guidelines" for the general public, as well as a variety of activities such as children's play and educational game stalls, which attracted over 2,000 people.

Internally, the Chamber secretariat continued to exercise environmental stewardship such as cutting down paper usage and encouraging recycling. In 2004 and 2005, we collected a total of 18,663kg of paper for recycling, equivalent to more than 300 trees saved. We spent almost \$60,000 to install

energy saving neon ballasts and halogen lamps for our offices and meeting rooms.

Economy: Young people are our business

As a business association, the Chamber's primary role is to help Hong Kong's economy prosper. This Annual Report is itself a record of our achievements in promoting the "economy" side of sustainable development.

Since sustainability is about the future generations as well as the present, one aspect of our activities is particularly meaningful, namely, the Chamber's work in helping young people relate to the business sector. Our

The Chamber launched its "Clean Air Charter" in 2005 and a series of events to encourage businesses and individuals to lessen their impact on air pollution.

經濟:助年青人認識商界,拓關視野

作為商會,協助促進香港經濟繁榮發展是我們的首要 工作,本年報亦記載了我們推動「經濟」可持續發展 之成績。

可持續發展關乎我們的後代和現時社會上的年青人,故本會其中一項饒有意義的行動,是協助年青人瞭解商業和投身商界。本會主辦的大型商業項目及會議,經常會安排年青人免費參加,除此以外,我們的支援行動還有:

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youth-assistance programme goes well beyond offering regular free-of-charge seating to them in the Chamber' major business programmes and luncheons, and includes the following.

- In 2004 the Chamber collaborated with the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups and Standard Chartered Bank to undertake a youth project entitled "Looking Northward – Mainland Career Prospect for Hong Kong Youth," to help Hong Kong youth explore career opportunities in the Mainland. The project consisted of a range of activities in 2004 such as career expo with the Labour Department, career seminars, and a 100-delegate mission to the Pearl River Delta. In addition, a Guidebook on Working in the Yangtze Economic Region was published in 2005.
- The Chamber supported the Youth Learning Project on Pacific Economic Cooperation jointly organized by the Federation of Youth Groups and the Hong Kong Committee for Pacific Economic Cooperation.
- The Chamber was a Partner organization of the "Youth Business Hong Kong" established by the Federation of Youth Groups in July 2005. The scheme sought to assist business start-ups by young people through providing business mentoring and financial backing.
- We have been a supporting organization of the "Soar Over Hong Kong Campaign" jointly organized by the Commerce, Industry and Technology Bureau and Ming Pao since 2003 to

 The Chamber initiated the Business-School Partnership Program to develop better linkage between schools and business through various activities such as internships and office/school visits. For the school years of 2004 and 2005, a total of 52 companies and 59 schools participated in the programme.

Society: A caring Chamber

The Chamber is a long-time supporting organization of the Caring Company Scheme organized by the Hong Kong Council for Social Service. Through the Scheme, qualified companies are awarded "Caring Company" logos in recognition of good corporate citizenship. In



2005, the scheme was extended to non-profit making "Caring Organisations." The Chamber was nominated and was duly awarded the Caring Organisation logo.

The Chamber is a supporter of the Consumer Council's Good Corporate Citizen's Guide launched in March 2005. We are also a partner organisation of the Social Welfare Department's "Partnership Fund for the Disadvantaged" launched in March 2005, with our then Chamber Chairman Mr Nightingale as an Honorary Adviser to the fund.

Though only a medium-sized, non-profit organization, the Chamber makes substantial contributions to charitable causes that call for financial support. In December 2004 the Chamber donated HK\$1 million on behalf of our members to the Hong Kong Red Cross for the Tsunami Disaster Relief in South Asia. In October 2005, HK\$100, 000 was donated to the Pakistan President's Relief Fund for Earthquake Victims. We also sponsored a School Volunteer Corp of the Heart to Heart Project organized by the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups in 2005.

Since 1973 the Chamber has been the sole sponsor of the Good Citizen Award, a scheme jointly organized with the Police to encourage citizens to assist in fighting crime. In 2004 and 2005, a total of HK\$326,000 was awarded to 162 Good Citizens.

Besides, the Chamber regularly provides the business sector's input on various matters of public interest, through the participation of its members and senior executives in more than 60 public sector advisory bodies – a significant contribution to public affairs.

Economic and Legal Affairs Division



經濟及法律事務部

經濟及法律事務部專責經濟政策及研究,並處理税務和法律事宜,以及與地產、建築、基建、運輸、船務等主要行業相關的事務。該部設有五個委員會,負責管理這些政策範疇,分別為經濟政策委員會、法律委員會、稅務委員會、船務及運輸委員會和地產及基建委員會。

The Economic and Legal Affairs Division is responsible for economic policy and research, as well as taxation and legal issues and the major industries of real estate, construction, infrastructure, transport and shipping. These policy areas are managed under five committees within the Division: Economic Policy, Legal, Taxation, Shipping & Transport, and Real Estate & Infrastructure.

Two thousand and five proved to be a challenging year for the Division due to the change of leadership in the government in the first half of the year under review which sidetracked some of the policy issues that were expected to be presented earlier. The survey on civil service compensation and how it compares to similar private sector jobs and the long awaited consultation on the prospect and nature of a goods and services tax (GST) are the two most pressing policies put on hold.

The Division received a very diverse range of visitors in 2005, and also drafted many position papers to reflect the Chamber's views on the issues of the day to government. In early 2005, the Chamber submitted its views strongly endorsing anti-racial discrimination legislation, but cautioned that compliance should not bring unnecessary burden on responsible companies. Various observers such as the World Economic Forum, the Heritage Foundation and the Fraser Institute consider

經濟及法律事務部2005年面對不少挑戰。上半年政府 領導層出現人事變動,以致部分政策工作被耽擱了。 期間兩項最迫切的政策工作:公務員與私人機構同類 職位的薪酬比較調查,與及計劃多時,有關開徵商品 及服務稅(銷售稅)及其細節的公眾諮詢,亦被擱置。

去年該部接待來自不同地區和各行各業的訪客,也 為本會草擬多份意見文件,向政府反映本會對熱門 議題的看法。本會年初向政府提呈建議書,表明非 常支持反種族歧視立法,但強調有關法例應避免對 企業造成不必要的負擔。香港獲世界經濟論壇、美 國傳統基金會和費沙爾學會等組織評定為全球最自 由的經濟體系,適當立法禁止種族歧視,應會增進 國際對香港經濟自由度的評價。

本會每年都會進行「商業前景問卷調查」,以瞭解會 員對各種題目的看法,並於年底公佈有關結果。去年 調查反映商界對2006及2007年前景的看法審慎,鑑 於香港已連續兩年錄得超過7%的實質經濟增長(自80 年代後期以來最強勁之增幅),預料來年經濟表現仍 佳,但增長會放緩。本會首席經濟師歐大衛在11月舉 行的香港商業高峰會上,亦提出同樣的預測觀點。

DIVISIONAL REPORTS

Hong Kong to be among the freest economies on earth, and such legislation simply enforces that perspective.

The annual Business Prospect Survey, which polls members' views at the end of each year on a range of subjects, pointed a cautious finger at 2006 and 2007. After two sterling years of better than 7% real economic growth (the strongest since the late 1980s), the prospect of a good, but slower period loomed. Chamber Chief Economist David O'Rear presented similar views in his forecast at the Annual Business Summit in November.

Committee work

The five committees which the Division looks after meet regularly to address members' concerns and consider

policy perspectives to be forwarded to the General Committee or, in some cases, directly to government. Briefings from experts and officials help members understand the complexity of issues such at the electric power scheme of control or the ins and outs of healthcare reform.

Active members contribute generously in terms of time and talent, and bring with them extensive experience in both business and public affairs. Without their drive and determination to ensure that Hong Kong has the best possible policies, the work of the Chamber would indeed suffer.

經濟政策委員會

年內經濟政策委員會為本會提呈行政長官的《施政報告》建議書和提呈財政司司長的《財政預算案》建議書提供了具體意見。去年委員會會議不時邀得政

府官員和專家出席,例如財經事務及庫務局副秘書長 郭立誠和醫院管理局主席胡定旭,聽他們講解及分析 當前熱門議題。

委員會去年也多次提交建議書,回應當局就公共醫療改革、最高工時及最低工資、機場管理局局部私營化等題目展開的公眾諮詢。

法律委員會

法律委員會去年工作非常繁忙,包括就反種族歧視立法,中醫發放病假證明、避免雙重課稅協議下的資料共享、上市規則、《施政報告》及《財政預算案》等一連串關係營商和商業法規的題目,向政府提出建議。

Economic Policy Committee

During the year under review, the committee made substantial contributions to the Chamber's submissions to government on the Chief Executives' Policy Addresses and the Financial Secretary's annual Budget. The committee received briefings from government officials and other experts on topical issues during the year. Among the guests were Deputy Treasury Secretary Martin Glass and Hospital Authority Chairman Anthony Wu.

Submissions were made in response to public consultations on reforms to public healthcare, maximum working hours and minimum pay, and partial privatisation of the Airport Authority, among others.

Legal Committee

The Legal Committee had a very active year, with recommendations being made to government on a range of issues impacting business and commercial law. Among the most important of these were views on antiracial discrimination legislation, sick leave certification by Chinese medicine practitioners, the sharing of information under double taxation agreements, listing rules, and the Policy Address and Budget.

Taxation Committee

The main foci of the committee in 2005 were on proposals for a partial review of the Inland Revenue Ordinance and recommendations for the annual Budget submission. The committee also lobbied LegCo and

government vigorously on the potentially adverse impact arising from a shift in taxation principles as a result of proposals related to the exemption of offshore funds from profits tax. To enhance Hong Kong's attractiveness to investors, the committee made a submission to government on the introduction of group tax relief and the elimination of the estate duty.

Shipping and Transport Committee

During the year under review, the committee provided input to a government-sponsored study on competition in the local fuel market, and commented on such initiatives as the proposal to reduce fees to attract more cargo. The Port Affairs Working Group, a sub-committee of the Shipping and Transport Committee, worked with the Chamber's Travel and Tourism Committee on possible measures to further develop the cruise ship market in Hong Kong. The Working Group also drew up the 2006 schedules for the Tramp Agency Fees and Mooring and Un-mooring Charges.

Real Estate and Infrastructure Committee

The committee submitted comments on a wide range of issues in 2005 that included the development of a government green building assessment scheme, Kai Tak Review Stage 2 Consultations, Building Height Restriction at Wong Chuk Hang and the Mandatory Building Inspection Scheme. A Working Group was also set up with the brief of reviewing existing land policy on possible enhancements for submission to the authorities.

地產及基建委員會年內就多個議題表達意見,包括 政府制定環保樓宇評估計劃、啟德規劃檢討第二階 段公眾諮詢、黃竹坑建築物高度限制、強制性驗樓 計劃等。委員會亦成立了工作小組,檢討現行土地 政策並向當局提出改善建議。

members. During the year under review, members made 2,542 on-line bookings for Chamber events. They also made 833 updates to their membership records online, using COMIUS, a system developed by the Chamber's inhouse IT team to replace the paper updating process, which was clumsy, time consuming and prone to errors. As for the Chamber e-Club — an online version of a personal post office box dedicated exclusively for Chamber information which members choose to receive — there are now around 700 active users. Over 1,400 member representatives had activated their e-Club accounts by the end of 2005.

In the fourth quarter of 2005, the Division began a trial run of 'Chamber Chambo' – a free online service for users to buy/sell their new/second-hand goods, surplus stocks

and rejects. By the end of 2005, more than 500 people had registered to use the service, and over 600 items were listed for sale. As of last year, the service averaged over 80,000 page views per month.

DIT Committee

The Digital, Information and Telecommunications (DIT)
Committee gives advice on DIT related policy issues as well as promoting IT usage in business. Jack So, Deputy
Chairman and Group Managing Director of PCCW, was
Chairman for a second term in 2005 and he is supported by four Vice Chairmen – two focusing on policy and two on programmes. Under the auspices of the DIT Committee, the Division organized 16 roundtables and workshops during the year under review. It also organized a cocktail

會員事務

Membership

retention and recruitment initiatives had some as the membership renewal rate for the ear reached just under 88%, the highest rate for the past th years. The successful Member-get-Member and Staff-Member programs continued to recruit more members ughout the year, and together with a membership sales strengthened HKGCC's position as the largest business organization in Hong Kong.

membership team also continued to build on events with members to expand fellowship, and organized age followship events during the year. The popular Chamber Hour, held every last Thursday of each month, is hosted General Committee members and provides a good opportunity for members to meet and chat with members of and other members. The monthly Members' Lunch mar with a senior member of the Chamber, as well as golf and cocktails continue to be welcome by members. 2006, the membership team plans to expand the variety Meanship events that the Chamber organizes to provide members with a wider selection of activities to choose from.

Chamber finances

Chamber's finances performed reasonably well in The surplus for the year increased by about 6.9% 2004 to \$11.8 million. The surplus came from strong

operational performance (\$6.2 million), a better realized gain on the Chamber General Fund (\$1.26 million) and dividends received from Tradelink (\$4.3 million). If Tradelink dividends were to be excluded, the Chamber's total operational income would be about the same as in 2004. However, total expenditure increased by 2% over 2004

During the year, the Chamber's assets recorded an exceptional increase of about \$41 million. This is due to the value of the shares that we hold in Tradelink. The Chamber is one of the founders of Tradelink, which was established in 1989. We invested about \$5.8 million in Tradelink and have received more than \$10 million in dividends from it so far. Tradelink successfully launched its IPO in Hong Kong in October 2005. Our share holding in Tradelink at the end of the year was worth about \$47 million.

In spite of the satisfactory surplus, we have to look ahead and meet challenges which may be lurking on the horizon. During the year in review, membership seemed to be at best stagnating. Bureau service for electronic trade declaration submissions dropped quite sharply, although its loss was partially offset by a slight increase in other CO incomes. Program income also experienced a decrease, which was mainly due to higher operating costs. As expenditure has been kept to a minimum for many years and if an increase in fees and charges is not the preferred option, we will have to rely more on other sources of income, which will be a challenge for the years to come.

Human Resources Division



人力資源部

人力資源部負責管理會內人力資源事務,支援人力委員會探討人力資源相關議題,並透過舉辦會議、研討會和工作坊,為會員提供各類培訓和發展服務。

The Human Resources Division manages the Chamber's corporate human resources, serves the Manpower Committee to examine issues relating to manpower and human resources, and provides training and development services to members by organizing conferences, seminars and workshops.

Manpower Committee

the committee convened regular meetings to discuss key issues facing Hong Kong wage and maximum wage and maximum working and-racial discrimination, education and personal series, among others. It also arranged roundtable landbooks, training, and workshops, with the largest proceed for the committee in 2005 being the first "CEO Management Conference" in May.

Under the banner "Human Capital: Hong Kong's Future," the conference, which was closed to the media to encourage an uninhibited exchange of ideas, saw almost 100 CEOs and human resources heads deliberate Hong Kong's future manpower challenges. As a result of the conference, the Chamber advocated reforms in education and immigration policies to maintain Hong Kong's competitiveness.

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Programs & training

The Division continues to emphasize the benefits of training and development to help enhance the overall standard of employees as well as the need for continuous learning. During the year under review, the Division organized 97 training courses for almost 1,000 participants covering HR, general administrative and customer service skills, strategic management skills, finance, languages and many other practical soft business skills. The Division also partnered with various professional bodies and universities to increase the scope and variety of training programs offered to businesses, as well as organized tailor-made training courses at the request of members. In addition to its current training services, the Division will continue to

expand the variety of topics covered in courses to meet members' needs.

To encourage more members to use the Division's training services, the Chamber, in cooperation with the Bank of China, administers one of the Chamber's member benefits programs – BOC HKGCC Visa Card Training Fund – which offers rebates to members' staff enrolling in Chamber training programs.

The Division strives to provide first-hand human resources and management related information to members by organizing roundtables and seminars. During the year under review, the Division organized 16 roundtable luncheons and seminars on various topical issues, and

At the community level, the Division participates in a variety of activities. The longest-running of these is the "The Good Citizen Award." The award is organized by the Hong Kong Police and sponsored solely by the Chamber. Since its launch in 1973, the scheme has commended over 3,300 citizens. The Division also coorganized "The Hong Kong Occupational Safety & Health Award," and supported the "Territory-wide Health Campaign," the Community Chest, and "Business-School Partnership Program," which could be expanded to

During the year under review, the Chamber provided internships to five university students, both from local and overseas universities, to provide them with practical on-the-job experience.

Corporate Human Resources

With the economy improving, and increased demands being placed on Chamber employees, staff turnover in 2005 was higher than in previous year, but on the whole the workforce remained stable and committed to serving members' needs. Overall headcount continues to be closely watched to control costs, and stood at 126 at the end of 2005.

As a caring organization, the Chamber organized a number of activities to promote a healthy, harmonious working environment in 2005. These included a staff outing to Hong Kong Disneyland prior to its official opening, a year-end staff dinner, and a series of health talks on "Healthy Lifestyle" to encourage staff and their family to eat a healthy diet and to exercise regularly.

The Division also organized staff training and development programs to upgrade staff's language, customer service, and time management skills, in addition to two workshops on image enhancement.

Certification Division



簽證部

簽證部簽發產地來源證和其他貿易文件,服務快捷,收費相宜,會員享有特別優惠。本會設有6個簽證辦事處,分佈全港,便利用戶。

The Certification Division provides quality and efficient certificate of origin (CO) and electronic trade documentation services at various rates to Chamber members and non-members. It operates six offices throughout the Hong Kong SAR to ensure easy access to its services by all prospective clients.

Good results

The year under review was a busy year for the Division. In 2005, the Chamber processed and issued 634,402 trade documents, which included 4,166 CEPA certificates of origin (CO), 234,997 certificates of origin, 394,431 import and export trade declarations (TDEC) and 808 production notifications (PN). The total number of documents processed showed a drop of 7% compared with the figure of 685,931 processed

in 2004. The drop was mainly in TDEC (-12.6%) as more traders switched to using electronic means to lodge their applications and the introduction of a new service provider.

The Chamber's smart card payment system has been well received as a substitute for cumbersome cash payment. By the end of the year, over 897 smart cards

CO processing time, including the time required for the CO correction process, has also been further reduced and the Chamber now provides an expeditious service in all its certification branch offices which are strategically located in Hong Kong, Kowloon and the New Territories. Certification Division staff members worked hard throughout the year to provide a superior service to all members and non-members.

Investigation

To uphold the integrity of the certification system, over 2,814 consignment checks on certificate applications were made. As a result, 177 applications were refused

and 22 certificates of origin were referred to the Trade Investigation Bureau of the Customs and Excise Department for further investigation and prosecution.

ATA Carnet

The Chamber is the sole body in Hong Kong approved to issue ATA carnets. These are international customs documents which permit trade samples, exhibition goods and professional equipment to be taken across national frontiers without payment of duty. In 2005, a total of 4,519 carnets were issued, an increase of 12% over the figure for 2004. These covered goods totalling \$6,368 million. During the year, 419 disputes arising out of the functioning of the carnet system were settled. Among these disputes, 13 cases resulted in payment of customs duties.

Notes to the financial statements

(Expressed in Hong Kong dollars)

1 Principal place of business

The Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce is a company limited by guarantee and incorporated and domiciled in Hong Kong and has its registered office and principal place of business at 22/F United Centre, 95 Queensway, Hong Kong.

2 Significant accounting policies

(a) Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with all applicable Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("HKFRSs"), which collective term includes all applicable individual Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards, Hong Kong Accounting Standards ("HKASs") and Interpretations issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA"), accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong and the requirements of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. A summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the company is set out below.

The HKICPA has issued a number of new and revised HKFRSs that are effective or available for early adoption for accounting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2005. Information on the changes in accounting policies resulting from initial application of these new and revised HKFRSs for the current and prior accounting periods reflected in these financial statements is provided in note 3.

(b) 編製財務報表準則

本財務報表採用歷史原值基準為衡度基準, 只有按公平價值列賬的可出售證券之部分除 外,解釋見附註2(d)。

為使財務報表之編制符含香港財務報告準則 之要求,管理層需要作出可影響政策運用和 已報資產、負債、收支金額的判斷、估計及 假設。管理層作出之估計及相關假設乃建基 於以住經驗及適用於當時情況而合理考慮之 其他因素,以判斷未能從其他來源其體得知 的資產及負債販面值。惟估計之數值有可能 與直倉值有所出入。

估計數值及有關之假設會持續予以審核。若 有關修訂只影響當時之會計期, 經修訂之會 計估計數值會於該會計期內列賬:若有關修 訂會影響當時及未來會計期,則於該會計期 及未來會計期內列賬。

(c) 附屬公司

香港《公司條例》規定、若集團直接或間接 持有一家公司多於半數已發行股本,或控制 多於半數投票權,或控制董事局的組成,該 公司即為附屬公司。若總商會有權直接或間 接號過管控公司的財務及營運政策以從其業 務中獲利,該公司被視為受總商會控制之附 屬公司。

於管控開始以至結束期間,在附屬公司的投資已在綜合財務報表入賬。

所有公司內部編餘及交易活動 和公司內部 交易所產生的任何未變現盈利,已於編製綜 合財務報表時略去。同樣,公司內部交易所 產生的任何未變現虧損亦會踏去,惟只在不 出現遊桐之情況下才會作出。

在附屬公司的投資以成本扣除減損的方式列 入資產負價表 (附註 2(h))。

(d) 於債務及權益證券的投資

集團於價務及權益證券的投資(不包括在附 屬公司的投資)政策如下:

集團有能力並打算持至到期日之有期限債券 被歸類為持至到期證券,最初會按公平價值 連同交易成本列入資產負債表,其後按攤銷 後成本減去減損呈列於資產負債表內(見附 註 2(h))。

若在權益證券的投資沒有活躍市場報價,亦 不能計算出可靠之公平價值,則有關投資會 按原值減去減損於資產負債表列股(見附註 2(hi)。

於其他證券的投資歸類為可出售證券,最初 按公平價值加交易成本列賬·在資產負價表 結算日,公平價值會被重新計量,得出之減 (見附註 2(h))。由於這類投資附帶利息,故 實際利息方法計算的利息於 收支結算表以 賬。當要剔除這些投資,先前直接計入股本 的累積收益或虧損將於收支結算表入 於服日中離認或剔除投資,均於集團承諾 買或售出投資當天,或投資到期當天作出。

(b) Basis of preparation of the financial statements

The measurement basis used in the preparation of the financial statements is the historical cost basis except that financial instruments classified as available-for-sale securities are stated at their fair value as explained in note 2(d).

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with HKFRSs requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances, the results of which form the basis of making the judgements about carrying values of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised if the revision affects only that period, or in the period of the revision and future periods if the revision affects both current and future periods.

(c) Subsidiary

A subsidiary, in accordance with the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance, is a company in which the group, directly or indirectly, holds more than half of the issued share capital or controls more than half the voting power or controls the composition of the board of directors. Subsidiaries are considered to be controlled if the Chamber has the power, directly or indirectly, to govern the financial and operating policies, so as to obtain benefits from their activities.

An investment in a controlled subsidiary is consolidated into the consolidated financial statements from the date that control commences until the date that control ceases. Intra-group balances and transactions and any unrealised profits arising from intra-group transactions are eliminated in full in preparing the consolidated financial statements. Unrealised losses resulting from intra-group transactions are eliminated in the same way as unrealised gains but only to the extent that there is no evidence of impairment.

In the Chamber's balance sheet, an investment in a subsidiary is stated at cost less any impairment losses (see note 2(h)).

(d) Investments in debt and equity securities

The group policies for investments in debt and equity securities other than investment in a subsidiary are as follows:

Dated debt securities that the group has the positive ability and intention to hold to maturity are classified as held-to-maturity securities. Held-to-maturity securities are initially recognised in the balance sheet at fair value plus transaction costs. Subsequently, they are stated in the balance sheet at amortised cost less impairment losses (see note 2(h)).

Investments in equity securities that do not have a quoted market price in an active market and whose fair value cannot be reliably measured are recognised in the balance sheet at cost less impairment losses (see note 2(h)).

Other investments in securities are classified as available-for-sale securities and are initially recognised at fair value plus transaction costs. At each balance sheet date the fair value is remeasured, with any resultant gain or loss being recognised directly in equity, except for impairment losses (see note 2(h)). Where these investments are interest-bearing, interest calculated using the effective interest method is recognised in the income and expenditure statement. When these investments are derecognised, the cumulative gain or loss previously recognised directly in equity is recognised in the income and expenditure statement.

Investments are recognised or derecognised on the date the group commits to purchase or sell the investments or they expire.

(e) 投資物業

(f) 固定資產

(g) 租賃資産

(1)出租予集團的資產歸類

集團透過租賃持有資產,而資產擁有權的 風險及回報幾乎全轉移至集團,這類資產 租賃歸類為融資租賃。資產續有權的風險 及回報並非大部分轉移至集團的資產租賃 歸類為營連租賃,除了以下情況;

- 透過營達租賃持有並符合投資物業定 裁之物業、會視乎個別情况被額類為 投資物業,並當作融資租賃持有物業 入賬(見附註2(e)):及
- 透過營運租賃持有作自用之土地、然而 該土地及其上樓字之租賃權益的公平價 值於租賃安排開始時未能分別計量、故 被當作融資租賃持有土地入賬。故此租 資安排應自集團首次營署租契、或從前 度出租者被爭和賃之時開始。

(ii)透過融資租賃購入資產

當集團透過融資租賃購入資產使用權,固 定資產會計入相當於租賃資產公平價值之 數額。

(iii)營運租賃收費

當集團透過營퉬租貸使用的資產,租金乃 於租期覆蓋的會計期內,以平均分期方式 列入收支結算表,惟另有更佳方式顯示藉 租賃資產所得收取者除外。租務優惠以總 淨租金於收支結算表入賬。或然租金於產 生之會計期內列入收支結算表。

(e) Investment property

Investment properties are land and buildings which are owned or held under a leasehold interest (see note 2(g)) to earn rental income and/or for capital appreciation. Investment properties are stated in the balance sheet at cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses (see note 2(h)). Rental income from investment properties is accounted for as described in note 2(o)(v).

When the group holds a property interest under an operating lease to earn rental income and/or for capital appreciation, the interest is classified and accounted for as an investment property on a property-by-property basis. Any such property interest which has been classified as an investment property is accounted for as if it were held under a finance lease (see note 2(g)), and the same accounting policies are applied to that interest as are applied to other investment properties leased under finance leases.

(f) Fixed assets

The following fixed assets are stated in the balance sheet at cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses (see note 2(h)):

- land held under operating leases and buildings thereon, where the fair values of the leasehold interest in the land and buildings cannot be measured separately at the inception of the lease; and
- other fixed assets.

Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, if any, using the straight line method over their estimated useful lives as follows:

- Leasehold land is depreciated on a straight-line basis over the remaining periods of the respective leases.
- Buildings situated on leasehold land are depreciated over the shorter of the unexpired term of lease and their estimated useful lives, being no more than 40 years after the date of completion.
- Furniture, fittings and office equipment

10% - 20% per annum

Motor vehicles

20% per annum

- Computer systems

331/₃% per annum

Gains or losses arising from the retirement or disposal of a fixed asset are determined as the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the carrying amount of the fixed asset and are recognised in profit or loss on the date of retirement or disposal.

(g) Leased assets

(i) Classification of assets leased to the group

Assets that are held by the group under leases which transfer to the group substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership are classified as being held under finance leases. Leases which do not transfer substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership to the group are classified as operating leases, with the following exception:

- property held under operating leases that would otherwise meet the definition
 of an investment property is classified as an investment property on a propertyby-property basis and, if classified as an investment property, is accounted for
 as if held under a finance lease (see note 2(e)); and
- land heldfor own use under an operating lease, the fair value of which cannot be measured separately from the fair value of a building situated thereon at the inception of the lease, is accounted for as being held under a finance lease. For these purposes, the inception of the lease is the time that the lease was first entered into by the group, or taken over from the previous lessee.

(ii) Assets acquired under finance leases

Where the group acquires the use of assets under finance leases, the amounts representing the fair value of the leased asset are included in fixed assets.

(iii) Operating lease charges

Where the group has the use of assets held under operating leases, payments made under the leases are charged to the income and expenditure statement in equal instalments over the accounting periods covered by the lease term, except where an alternative basis is more representative of the pattern of benefits to be derived from the leased asset. Lease incentives received are recognised in the income and expenditure statement as an integral part of the aggregate net lease payments made. Contingent rentals are charged to the income and expenditure statement in the accounting period in which they are incurred.

(h) 資產減值

(h) Impairment of assets

- (i) Impairment of investments in debt and equity securities and other receivables Investments in debt and equity securities and other current and non-current receivables that are stated at cost or amortised cost or are classified as availablefor-sale securities are reviewed at each balance sheet date to determine whether there is objective evidence of impairment. If any such evidence exists, any impairment loss is determined and recognised as follows:
 - For unquoted equity securities and current receivables that are carried at cost, the impairment loss is measured as the difference between the carrying amount of the financial asset and the estimated future cash flows, discounted at the current market rate of return for a similar financial asset where the effect of discounting is material. Impairment losses for current receivables are reversed if in a subsequent period the amount of the impairment loss decreases. Impairment losses for equity securities are not reversed.
 - For financial assets carried at amortised cost, the impairment loss is measured
 as the difference between the asset's carrying amount and the present value
 of estimated future cash flows, discounted at the financial asset's original
 effective interest rate (i.e. the effective interest rate computed at initial
 recognition of these assets).

If in a subsequent period the amount of an impairment loss decreases and the decrease can be linked objectively to an event occurring after the impairment loss was recognised, the impairment loss is reversed through the income and expenditure statement. A reversal of an impairment loss shall not result in the asset's carrying amount exceeding that which would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognised in prior years.

For available-for-sale securities, the cumulative loss that had been recognised directly in equity is removed from equity and is recognised in the income and expenditure statement. The amount of the cumulative loss that is recognised in the income and expenditure statement is the difference between the acquisition cost (net of any principal repayment and amortisation) and current fair value, less any impairment loss on that asset previously recognised in the income and expenditure statement.

Impairment losses recognised in the income and expenditure statement in respect of available-for-sale equity securities are not reversed through the income and expenditure statement. Any subsequent increase in the fair value of such assets is recognised directly in equity.

(ii) Impairment of other assets

Internal and external sources of information are reviewed at each balance sheet date to identify indications that the following assets may be impaired or, an impairment loss previously recognised no longer exists or may have decreased:

- investment properties;
- fixed assets; and
- investment in a subsidiary

If any such indication exists, the asset's recoverable amount is estimated.

- Calculation of recoverable amount

The recoverable amount of an asset is the greater of its net selling price and value in use. In assessing value in use, the estimated future cash flows are discounted to their present value using a pre-tax discount rate that reflects current market assessments of time value of money and the risks specific to the asset. Where an asset does not generate cash inflows largely independent of those from other assets, the recoverable amount is determined for the smallest group of assets that generates cash inflows independently (i.e. a cash-generating unit).

- Recognition of impairment losses

An impairment loss is recognised in the income and expenditure statement whenever the carrying amount of an asset, or the cash-generating unit to which it belongs, exceeds its recoverable amount. Impairment losses recognised in respect of cash-generating units are allocated to reduce the carrying amount of the assets in the unit (or group of units) on a pro rata basis, except that the carrying value of an asset will not be reduced below its individual fair value less costs to sell, or value in use, if determinable.

- Reversals of impairment losses

An impairment loss is reversed if there has been a favourable change in the estimates used to determine the recoverable amount.

A reversal of an impairment loss is limited to the asset's carrying amount that would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognised in prior years. Reversals of impairment losses are credited to the income and expenditure statement in the year in which the reversals are recognised.

(m) 所得税

當期稅項乃年內應課稅收入的預期應繳稅款 (按資產負債表結算日稅率或卸將生效的稅率 計算)及過往年度應繳稅款的任何調整。

在每個資產負債表結算日均會審核透延税 項資產的賬面值,若預期應課稅溢利不足 以利用相關稅務利益,賬面值便會調低。 倘日後可能有足夠的應課稅溢利,有關波 密便會回榜。

(n) 撥備及或有負債

若需要付出經濟利益的可能性較低,或有關金額不能可靠估計,有關責任便按釋為或有負債,惟若需要付出經濟利益的可能性極低,則作別論。因某宗或多宗未來事件發生與否而產生的潛在責任,亦按舊為或有負債,惟若需要付出經濟利益的可能性極低,則作別論。

(i) Trade and other receivables

Trade and other receivables are initially recognised at fair value and thereafter stated at amortised cost less impairment losses for bad and doubtful debts (see note 2(h)), except where the receivables are interest free loans without any fixed repayment terms or the effect of discounting would be immaterial. In such cases, the receivables would be stated at cost less impairment losses for bad and doubtful debts (see note 2(h)).

(j) Trade and other payables

Trade and other payables are initially recognised at fair value and thereafter stated at amortised cost unless the effect of discounting would be immaterial, in which case they are stated at cost.

(k) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash at bank and on hand, demand deposits with banks and other financial institutions, and short-term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible into known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value, having been within three months of maturity at acquisition.

(I) Employee benefits

Salaries, annual bonuses, paid annual leave, contributions to defined contributions plans and the cost of non-monetary benefits are accrued in the year in which the associated services are rendered by employees. Where payment or settlement is deferred and the effect would be material, where amounts are stated at their present values.

(m) Income tax

Income tax for the year comprises current tax and movements in deferred tax assets and liabilities. Current tax and movements in deferred tax assets and liabilities are recognised in the income and expenditure statement.

Current tax is the expected tax payable on the taxable income for the year, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date, and any adjustment to tax payable in respect of previous years.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities arise from deductible and taxable temporary differences respectively, being the differences between the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities for financial reporting purposes and their tax bases. Deferred tax assets also arise from unused tax losses.

All deferred tax liabilities, and all deferred tax assets to the extent that it is probable that future taxable profits will be available against which the asset can be utilised, are recognised.

The amount of deferred tax recognised is measured based on the expected manner of realisation or settlement of the carrying amount of the assets and liabilities, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date. Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

The carrying amount of a deferred tax asset is reviewed at each balance sheet date and is reduced to the extent that it is no longer probable that sufficient taxable profit will be available to allow the related tax benefit to be utilised. Any such reduction is reversed to the extent that it becomes probable that sufficient taxable profit will be available. Current tax balances and deferred tax balances, and movements therein, are presented separately from each other and are not offset.

(n) Provisions and contingent liabilities

Provisions are recognised for liabilities of uncertain timing or amount when the group has a legal or constructive obligation arising as a result of a past event, it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made.

Where it is not probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required, or the amount cannot be estimated reliably, the obligation is disclosed as a contingent liability, unless the probability of outflow of economic benefits is remote. Possible obligations, whose existence will only be confirmed by the occurrence or non-occurrence of one or more future events are also disclosed as contingent liabilities unless the probability of outflow of economic benefits is remote.

(o) 收入確認

(q) 關連方

就本財務報表而言、若集團有能力直接或間接控制一方,或在一方作出財政及營運決策時行便重大影響力,或在相反情况下亦然,又或集團及一方受到共同控制或共同重大影響,則該方便強佔為與集團有關。關連方可以是個人(主要管理層成員及/或其直系親屬)或其他固體,亦包括受集團關連人士重大影響的個體,及為集團員工提供福利的聘後福利計劃或屬於集團關連方的任何個體。

3 會計政策的變動

香港會計師公會已頒佈多項新增及經修訂的香港財務報告準則·通用於2005年1月1日或以後開始的會計期。

(o) Income recognition

Provided it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the group and the income and costs, if applicable, can be measured reliably, income is recognised in the income and expenditure statement as follows:

(i) Members' subscriptions

Members' subscriptions are recognised on an accruals basis.

(ii) Fees and commission income

Fees and commission income are recognised as income when the services are rendered.

(iii)Interest income

Interest income is recognised as it accrues using the effective interest method.

(iv) Dividends

Dividend income from unlisted investments is recognised when the shareholder's right to receive payment is established.

Dividend income from listed investments is recognised when the share price of the investment goes ex-dividend.

(v)Rental income from operating leases

Rental income receivable under operating leases is recognised in the income and expenditure statement in equal instalments over the accounting period covered by the lease term, except where an alternative basis is more representative of the pattern of benefits to be derived from the leased asset. Lease incentives granted are recognised in the income and expenditure statement as an integral part of the aggregate net lease payments receivable.

(p) Translation of foreign currencies

Foreign currency transactions during the year are translated at the foreign exchange rates ruling at the transaction dates. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated at the foreign exchange rates ruling at the balance sheet date. Exchange gains and losses are dealt with in the income and expenditure statement.

(q) Related parties

For the purposes of these financial statements, parties are considered to be related to the group, if the group has the ability, directly or indirectly, to control the party or exercise significant influence over the party in making financial and operating decisions, or vice versa, or where the group and the party are subject to common control or common significant influence. Related parties may be individuals (being members of key management personnel and/or their close family members) or other entities and include entities which are under the significant influence of related parties of the group where those parties are individuals, and post-employment benefits plans which are for the benefit of employees of the group or of any entity that is a related party of the group.

3 Changes in accounting policies

The HKICPA has issued a number of new and revised HKFRSs that are effective for accounting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2005.

The accounting policies of the group after the adoption of these new and revised HKFRSs have been summarised in note 2. The following sets out information on the significant changes in accounting policies for the current and prior accounting periods reflected in these financial statements.

(a) Financial instruments (HKAS 32, Financial instruments: Disclosure and presentation and HKAS 39, Financial instruments: Recognition and measurement) With effect from 1 January 2005, in order to comply with HKAS 32 and HKAS 39, the Chamber has changed its accounting policies relating to financial instruments to those set out in notes 2(d), (h), (i) and (j). Further details of the changes are as

In prior years, investments in securities held for non-trading purposes were stated at fair value with changes in fair value recognised in equity, with the exception of dated debt securities being held to maturity which were stated in the balance sheet at amortised cost less impairment losses.

With effect from 1 January 2005, and in accordance with HKAS 39, the Chamber has elected to designate all previous investments in securities held for non trading purposes as available-for-sale securities. Further details of the new policies are set out in note 2(d).

There are no material adjustments arising from the adoption of the new policies for held-to-maturity securities, available-for-sale securities and investments in equity securities whose fair value cannot be reliably measured.
