

The Year's Highlights

During 1980, your Chamber

- sent a high level mission led by the Chairman to the U.K., which successfully explained recent developments and future potential in Hong Kong to senior British businessmen and Government officials.
- sent seven buying/selling missions overseas to a total of 21 countries. Firm orders for Hong Kong products worth a total of HK\$85 million were obtained, with follow-up orders assessed at HK\$91.6 million.
- made representations to Government and other appropriate authorities on a wide variety of subjects, including the Textiles Quota Control System; the Trade Descriptions Bill; the Companies Ordinance; the Prevention of Bribery and ICAC Ordinances: and the White Paper on Administration.
- met with the Rent Review Committee and put forward positive recommendations designed to ease the accommodation shortage.
- received and assisted over 50 incoming groups and several hundred personal visitors.
- processed 16,000 overseas trade enquiries and carried out feedback investigations which suggested that over 50 per cent of these
 enquiries met with a positive response.
- assisted over 4.000 local and overseas enquirers to make contact with industrial or commercial bodies in China; and established a
 register of official Chinese organizations and individuals in order to facilitate contact.
- via representation on the Japan/Hong Kong Business Cooperation Committee worked towards greater acceptance of Hong Kong products in the Japanese market, and participated in two major industrial and economic conferences.
- through personal appointments of the Director, arranged Hong Kong liaison with the Confederation of British Industry, the Pacific Basin Economic Council and the Hong Kong Association.

本年度大事便覽

一九八〇年間,香港總商會

- 曾派遣一個由主席率領之高層代表團訪問英國,向英國官商界權威人士闡述香港的近期發展,並介紹前來香港拓展市場之機會。
- 曾遗派七個採購/推銷團分訪世界廿一個國家,接獲訂單總值八千五百萬港元,續單交易額估計達九千一百六十萬港元。
- 向港府及其他有關當局提交了多份意見書,涉及的範圍包括紡織品配額管制制度;商品說明法案;公司法例;防止賄賂與飛政公署條例;及香港地方 行政模式白皮書等。
- 曾會晤租務檢討委員會,提出有關緩和居屋短缺問題的積極建議。
- 曾接待及協助五十多個訪港代表團及數百位個別訪港人士。
- 處理海外貿易諮詢數量達一萬六千宗;展開諮詢反應調查,結果顯示百分之五十以上的諮詢獲得積極反應。
- 會協助四千多位港外諮詢人士,與國內工商機構取得聯繫;編訂中國官方機構及負責人目錄,以促進聯絡。
- 通過出席港日貿易合作委員會,致力改善港貨在日本市場之銷路;並參加了鹿兒島/香港經濟交流會議及橫橫/香港工業會議。
- 因執行董事之私人任命,與英國工業聯會、太平洋地區經濟理事會及香港工商協會保持了聯繫。

Chairman's Statement



In a troubled year for world trade and the world economy, Hong Kong's economic and trade performance in 1980 must be considered highly satisfactory. Few industrialised countries experienced real economic and trade growth in 1980 of more than a few percentage points although some at least had the advantage of substantial and sometimes tariff-protected domestic markets for their industries.

Hong Kong's trade and industry, operating in a free enterprise environment had no such advantage and had to face a wide array of formidable problems in competing for its share of world markets. Exchange fluctuations, disruptive inflationary pressures, an increasing trend towards trade protectionism in many major markets and political upheavals in several key areas of the world combined to make 1980 more than usually difficult for our manufacturers and exporters reliant on external trade.

Hong Kong's well known adaptability and business flexibility were equal to the task. Exports in 1980 increased 22% in value over those in 1979 and by approximately 11% in real terms. Re-exports expanded by 50% (36% in real terms) and imports by 30% (18% in real terms). Hong Kong's robust export performance contributed to a real economic growth of 9% during 1980.

However the effects of the gathering recession in our main markets became progressively apparent in

Hong Kong during the year and a fairly significant slowdown was evident towards the year end. By the fourth quarter the rate of real export growth was down to 4% compared to 11% in the same quarter of 1979, and figures for the first three quarters of 1980 of 18%, 18% and 7% respectively.

Hong Kong's exporters met this challenge by stepping up their promotional efforts and many paid particular attention to smaller and secondary markets with good results. Clothing, toys, dolls and games. watches and textiles showed export growth of 16%, 15%, 48% and 12% respectively whilst exports to USA, Fed. Rep. of Germany and UK were at their highest ever levels. A weaker Hong Kong dollar in the closing months of 1980 against both the US dollar and the pound sterling helped our exporters, although it is to be hoped that the weakening trend of our currency will soon stabilise.

Whilst substantial imports of raw materials, semi-manufactures and

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
在世界貿易與經濟普遍不景下,香港一九八〇年 的經濟貿易業績堪稱良佳。儘管有些國家 享有職大國內市場及關稅保護的變勢,但年內 實質經濟貿易增長能逾幾個百分點的工業國爲數 極少。


香港工商業在自由企業環境下,並未享有此利益, 且還需在世界市場競爭中面臨一系列的難題。 貨幣動盪、通貨膨脹壓力、主要市場訴諮貿易 保護措施趨勢益增、世界若干主要地區政治動亂 等因素,使一向依賴對外貿易的本港製造及 出口商,經營更加困難。 香港著名的經濟適應力及貿易靈活性是經得起考驗的。以價值計,一九八〇年的出口貿易較七九年增加百分之廿二;以實質計算之增長率約爲百分之十一。轉口貿易增加百分之五十(實質增長百分之三十六),入口貿易增加百分之三十(實質增長百分之十八)。本港的堅穩出口業績使八〇年間的實質經濟增長達百分之九。


然而,由於主要市場的衰退影响漸增, 本港八〇年後期的經濟頗有放緩跡象。末季的 實質出口增長率下降至百分之四,七九年同期為 百分之十一。而八〇年首三季的實質出口增長則 分別為百分之十八、百分之十八及百分之七。 香港出口商為應付這個挑戰,正在積極加强 促進活動;其中不少尤着意拓展較小及次要市場, 成績卓越。成衣、玩具、洋娃娃、遊戲機、 手錶及紡織品的出口分別增長百分之十六、 百分之十五、百分之四十八及百分之十二; 而本港對美國、西德及英國的出口總值更創下 歷年最高紀錄。雖則一般期望港元弱勢 不久會回穩,但八〇年末期港元兌換美元及英鎊 滙率偏軟,確有助於促進出口業務。

儘管原料、半製成品及儀器的大量進口, 繼續反映側重出口的製造業對香港經濟的









machine equipment continued to reflect the importance of export-oriented manufacturing industry to Hong Kong's economy, the adverse visible trade gap was a cause of some concern during the year. However, those statistics which are available on invisible earnings suggest that Hong Kong's overall external account is more or less in balance. For this to be measured more accurately, however, an improvement in the Government's statistical information on invisibles will be necessary.

Re-exports, particularly relating to the People's Republic of China, continued to expand at a very rapid rate with an annual growth in 1980 over 1979 of 50% (36% in real terms). Hong Kong's traditional role as an entrepôt, although always significant, has been given added emphasis since China began its drive towards the 'Four Modernisations' in late 1977. In 1980 Hong Kong's exports and re-exports to China increased by 166% and 253% respectively, reflecting both the expansion of Hong Kong's trade

and industrial cooperation with China and also the development of international services in Hong Kong.

With no natural resources of its own Hong Kong cannot avoid importing inflation from the rest of the world. In recent years, as with most other oil importing countries, the escalation of oil prices has caused much concern here, particularly since Hong Kong's industrial energy is at present derived wholly from imported oil: this is also the case with most of our industrial raw materials, such as plastics. The conflict between Iran and Iraq added a new dimension to Hong Kong's concern over oil supplies and prices, and the Hong Kong Government reactivated its Oil Policy Committee to coordinate action on oil imports, storage and distribution in the event of a real emergency. Slackening worldwide demand for oil provided some assurance of supply but high prices continued to contribute to Hong Kong's imported inflation with no real relief in sight.

In December, the Oil Policy Committee was upgraded to become the Hong Kong Energy Committee on which the Chamber is represented. This body has a wide responsibility for ensuring that Hong Kong continues to enjoy an uninterrupted supply of all the energy sources it requires.

In the circumstances, it was perhaps not surprising that Hong Kong experienced an inflation rate for 1980 of approximately 15%. In a free economy such as ours with no exchange controls and an almost complete reliance on external trade. there is little that the Government can do to reduce the effect of imported inflation. The Hong Kong authorities wisely leave it to market forces to bring about the necessary adjustments which will keep Hong Kong's inflation rate in reasonable relation to that of the countries with which we are economically associated. However, when necessary it is possible to exert downward pressure on the growth of domestic expenditure and of the money supply by judicious use of the interest rate mechanism, although interest rates must ensure that Hong

八〇年間、本港的轉口貿易(尤其與中國的轉口貿易)繼續急劇增長,比七九年增加百分之五十。(以實質計算,增長率為百分之三十六)。自一九七七年底中國推行四個現代化以來,香港作為轉口港的傳統重要角色日益提高。在一九八〇年,本港對中國之出口及轉口貿易分別增加百分之一百六十六及百分之二百

五十三,足以反映中港之經濟合作加强,及本港國際性服務的發展。

由於欽乏天然資源,香港無法避免外地輸入的通貨膨脹。近年來,正如一般石油進口國一樣,油價高漲引起了港人頗大的關注;尤其因爲目前本港的工業能源全賴進口石油,且大多數工業原料如塑膠亦同樣需用石油製煉。兩伊衝突使本港對石油供應及價格問題更添一重顧應。港府石油政策委員會重新籌劃有關石油進口、儲備及緊急時期分配等各方面的行動措施。全球性石油需求放緩雖爲供應提供了若干保証,但油價高漲卻使本港續受輸入的通脹打擊,短期內情况難望好轉。

十二月間,石油政策委員會升級成為香港能源委員會,本會委有代表出席。該委員會的工作,是負責確保本港不斷擁有所需的各種能源供應。在此情况下,香港一九八〇年的通貨膨脹率約為百分之十五,並不足為奇。鑒於本港的自由經濟旣無外滙管制,且幾乎全賴對外貿易;對減低輸入通脹的影响,港府實在無能為力。當局觀市場力量帶來必要調整的明智做法,使本港的通脹率與有關經濟國家保持着合理關係。然而,在必要之時,當局亦可能對內部消費及貨幣供應增長採取抑制措施——如通過利率

Kong can continue to attract foreign funds. Throughout 1980, the Exchange Banks Association, in consultation with the Government. adjusted interest rates in line with international developments. Towards the end of the year interest rates were raised to their highest level for 1980, reflecting the very high US rates. Hong Kong trade and industry. whilst recognising the impact of US rates, anxiously hope for a reduction in the cost of borrowing in early 1981; without this investment in new plant and equipment - all important in terms of continued productivity growth and industrial diversification could be affected.

Hong Kong, for most of 1980, faced a massive problem of illegal immigration from China's Guangdong Province. This is estimated to have been not less than 34,978 in the first 6 months of the year and added further to the burden of looking after over 38,700 Vietnamese refugees who were awaiting resettlement in other countries. This problem strained Hong Kong's traditionally hospitable

policy to breaking point. It was with a general sigh of relief that we welcomed the series of measures that were announced in October 1980 following discussions between the Hong Kong and Guangdong Governments. These had the effect of making it much more difficult for would-be illegal immigrants to reach and penetrate Hong Kong's border and of denying sanctuary to those who actually manage to get through to our urban areas. By the end of the year, what had been a flood of illegal immigrants estimated at more than 449 a day at one stage had fallen to around 33 a day. Nevertheless. the problem remains potentially difficult for Hong Kong and it would be foolish to be complacent.

Another source of relief was that the anticipated rush of Vietnamese refugees towards our shores during the summer months did not materialise and the steady resettlement of Vietnamese refugees by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees reduced their number in Hong Kong to 24,045 by the year end. However this also

remains a potential threat of considerable magnitude to Hong Kong's hard pressed social services and it is to be hoped that international action will continue to restrain the Vietnamese authorities from stimulating a further massive migration of ethnic Chinese from that country.

The continuing expansion and improvement of Hong Kong's already strong economic and cultural links with the People's Republic of China was another positive development during 1980. Throughout the year. new joint venture agreements were entered into between Hong Kong companies and counterpart organisations in China covering a wide spectrum of industrial and commercial activity - hotel construction, financial services, the manufacture of industrial and consumer products to mention but a few of the categories concerned. Neither the investment involved nor the potential value of the resulting goods and services can be quantified

另一使人欣慰的,是預期於夏季乘船偷渡來港的 越南難民潮並沒有湧現,和聯合國難民專員公署 陸續安置滯港越南難民。這使年底時的留港越南 難民人數減至二萬四千○四十五名•但難民問題對 本港的迫切社會服務需求仍有重大威脅;因此, 希望國際行動能繼續壓抑越南政府,使該地的 華裔人士逃亡潮不致再次出現。

中港的經濟文化關係更趨密切是八●年另一項 積極的發展。年內,港商與國內機構達成的 新聯營企業協議包括各工商行業——例如酒店 建設、金融服務、工業及消費產品的製造等, 就是其中的合作範閱。雖然,投資額及製成品與 服務總值在現時階段尚未可衡量,但上文已提及 過的中港有形質易增長卻為未來發展動向

at this stage. However the expanded visible trade between Hong Kong and China to which I have already referred provides some indication of the potential for the future. Perhaps even more important than the value of these agreements in financial terms is the high level of confidence in Hong Kong's future that they have engendered. Taken together with the effects of increasingly close and mutually helpful contact between senior Chinese and Hong Kong officials, which have resulted in a number of assurances being given by Chinese leaders on Hong Kong's importance to China, international and domestic confidence in Hong Kong has never been higher. This in turn has fuelled a boom affecting virtually every sector of Hong Kong's internal infrastructure. Construction in both the public and private sectors was at an all time high during 1980 yet output of housing and commercial premises was insufficient to meet the demand. Inevitably, rentals and sale prices rose sharply throughout the year creating problems for many

businesses. At the year end, however, some relief was in sight with a substantially increased supply of new stock scheduled to come onto the market during 1981, particularly in the commercial sector.

In this context, the legislation at the beginning of 1980 extending rent controls to cover virtually all residential premises in general achieved the desired short term result. However whether this measure will aggravate the basic problem over the longer term by inhibiting private sector construction of domestic accommodation remains an open question.

Employment in Hong Kong during 1980 was satisfactory even allowing for the effect of a greatly increased rate of illegal immigration during most of the year. Strong demand for Hong Kong products in world markets, the very substantial public and private sector building programme, the continuing expansion of Hong Kong's financial sector and the growth of our business with China all helped to keep demand for Hong Kong labour at a high level. Employment in the

manufacturing sector improved throughout the year until the final quarter when weaker international markets began to have their effect on industrial production. Even so, the industrial workforce was higher at the end of the year than at the end of 1979 and it is likely that manufacturing industry will employ one million workers within the next few years. The fact that Hong Kong industry is currently improving its productivity at rates substantially faster than Japan, the United States and West Germany, and that Hong Kong has for some years been ranked among the world's top twenty exporters provides a sound basis for confidence in our long term prospects for employment.

Regarding 1981 most economists appear to believe that world trade will continue to suffer from the widespread recession, with possibly a very slow recovery in the United States but an almost static economic situation in other developed countries and a decline in a few. Overall the world economy is not expected to


提供了一些顯示。或者,比這些合約資金總值 更重要的,是他們對香港前途抱有强大的信心。 中港高級官員的互助密切聯繫,及中國領導人 一再提出香港對中國重要性的保証,使本地 及國際間對香港的信心大為加强,繁榮影响遍及 整個內部基礎結構。八○年間,公私營部門傾力 施工興建,工程項目創歷年最高紀錄;然而,


落成的商業及住宅樓字仍未足應付需求, 租金及物價劇升在所難免,使一般廠商經營頗感 困難。幸而,預期八一年間會有大量新樓字單位 (尤其商業櫻宇)增加推出,供不應求情况應可 緩和。

在這方面,八〇年初實行擴大住宅樓字和金管制 的法例,大致上已收到理想的短期效果。 但長期而言,此項措施會否促使基本問題加深, 抑制私人地產商興建住宅樓字,則仍是個容許 爭論的問題。

儘管年內非法移民充斥勞工市場,但八○年的 本港就業情况仍令人滿意。世界市場對港貨需求 堅穩,公私營部門的龐大興建計劃,本港金融業 的持續增長及中港的貿易發展,皆促使本港 勞工需求保持於高水平。年內,製造業的 就業情况普遍改善; 直至末季, 國際市場需求 疲弱開始對工業生產造成影响時,勞工需求 才略告放緩。雖則如此,年底時之工業勞動力仍 較七九年底之數字爲高。展氅在未來數年間, 製造業將僱用一百萬名工人。香港工業的生產力 增長率超逾日本、美國、西德、及本港若干年來 巴位居世界二十大出口圂的事實,為長期就業 展望提供了强大的信心基礎。

至於八一年的展望,一般經濟學家似乎相信 世界貿易將續受普遍衰退影响,美國復甦的進度 可能甚爲緩慢,其他先進國的經濟或會處於 靜態, 而數個國家甚或有放緩可能。整體而言, 預料八一年的世界經濟增長不會超過百分之一。 八一年上半年的情况似會比下半年更爲困難。 由於香港出口大部份集中於六個可能經歷低經濟







grow by more than 1% in 1981. The first half of 1981 is likely to be more difficult than the second and, since Hong Kong's exports are heavily concentrated on six of the developed countries likely to experience low economic growth rates, it seems likely that we shall continue to see soft markets for our exports at least until mid-1981. Slow growth in our main markets cannot be fully compensated by additional growth in smaller markets particularly since these are also likely to be adversely affected by a faltering world economy.

A matter of considerable interest and some concern will be the renegotiation in 1981 of the GATT Multi-Fibre Agreement on Textiles (M.F.A.). There now seems little doubt that the developed importing countries, which are our main markets for textiles, will press hard for inclusion of further restrictive and potentially damaging clauses in any new M.F.A. There is also no doubt that the developing exporting countries will argue strongly for the

status quo although even that has greatly reduced the rate of expansion of textile production and exports in many developing countries. It is to be hoped, therefore, that reason and good sense will prevail in these highly important negotiations.

Additionally Hong Kong, and no doubt many other exporting countries as well, might experience difficulties in trade arising from short term protectionist measures taken by countries whose industries feel threatened by imports. In these circumstances, exporters will continue to rely on the fair application of the provisions of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT), the only international instrument which can effectively help to govern the rules and conditions of world trade. Here too, the forces of protectionism are at work seeking to modify those rules which prevent the imposition of selective and discriminatory import restrictions. Hong Kong must continue to resist such modifications to the GATT.

Hong Kong has a vulnerable industrial and export market structure. Only

17 industries account for 91% of the industrial workforce and all of these are heavily export oriented. Several, in fact, export almost everything they make. Over 80% of Hong Kong's manufactured goods is exported, and only six markets account for 64% of these exports. Any serious problem in one or two of these markets would adversely affect our overall export performance.

Although there has been encouragement from the Government to diversify our industry and markets, this is taking time and garments and textiles still account for 41% of the manufacturing sector output. However, other industries such as electronics and watches are expanding steadily, and the development of the industrial estates where new industries receive advantageous terms for land has been encouraging.

Against this background, the trading prospects for 1981 give grounds for

增長的先進國家,因此,至少直至八一年中期, 出口市場的需求將續呈疲弱。較小規模市場的 額外增長並未足以補償主要市場的放慢增長, 尤其因為它們亦可能受到世界經濟不穩定的 利跌影响。

因此,我們希望這些高度重要談判能在理智及良好意識的環境下進行。

再者,香港(其他很多出口國亦然)的貿易亦可能會因那些認為國內工業受到進口威脅的國家所採取的短期保護措施,面臨困難。在此等情况下,出口商將繼續依賴關稅貿易總協定的公平實施——唯一能有效地協助管制世界貿易規則及情况的國際協定。於此,貿易保護主義力量亦企圖修訂有關禁施選擇性及歧視性入口限制的規則。香港必須繼續抗拒關貿總協定作出上述的修訂。

香港的工業及出口市場結構易受打繫, 僅十七行 工業已佔去工業勞動力百分之九十一, 它們全部都極度依賴出口。本港有超過百分之 八十的製成品是去銷外地,而六個主要市場 已佔去出口百分之六十四。因此,若然其中一兩 個市場出現任何嚴重問題,都必定會對本港的 整體出口業鍛造成不利影响。

雖則港府現正鼓吹推行工業及市場多元化, 目前紡織品佔製造業總生産仍達百分之四十一。 然而,其他工業如電子、手錶業等亦正在 穩定發展。此外,為新工業提供確價工業用地的 工業邨發展亦令人鼓舞。

基此環境下,一九八一年的貿易展宴應為審慎樂觀,並有跡象顯示下半年的業績會比上半年好。

cautious optimism with indications that the second half year should be better than the first.

There are more grounds for optimism about the prospects for Hong Kong's service industries in the immediate future, and particularly the financial sector. Only part of this sector is directly reliant on trade and, in the wider context of international finance, Hong Kong is making real headway. The recent replacement of the Exchange Banks Association by the Hong Kong Association of Banks is expected to make a significant contribution to this process. In particular the latter body's improved organisational structure should enable more effective consultation and coordination both among authorised banks and also between them and the Government.

Other service industries such as insurance, shipping, air transport and data processing have all benefitted from Hong Kong's increasing role as an international business centre. This in turn is giving rise to further

improvements in the training, systems, and management efficiency guiding the growth of these industries.

Despite the problems of industry and trade, the rate at which Hong Kong's infrastructure is being developed is unlikely to slacken in 1981. If anything an increase in the pace seems desirable. Notwithstanding the remarkable rate at which new flats are now being built -- over 60,000 units in 1980 between the public and private sectors — it seems unlikely that we will have caught up with the underlying demand for housing before the mid to late 1980s. Another vital priority is the provision of adequate transport facilities both within Hong Kong and linking it with the outside world so as to enable it to grow and function efficiently without strangling itself. In this context the Government's recent decision in favour of the Island extensions of the Mass Transit Railway is to be particularly welcomed.

Whatever the immediate prospects for Hong Kong's economy I believe

that the energy, initiative and ingenuity of the commercial and industrial sector will again overcome the challenges of worldwide economic and political uncertainty. We have generally good industrial relations and a workforce which is continually upgrading its skills; a vital requirement if Hong Kong is to maintain its position against competitors with lower costs in terms of land, raw materials and labour.

In closing I should acknowledge the hard work and dedication of Jimmy McGregor, the Chamber's Director, and his staff both in administering the Chamber's day-to-day operations and in arranging a series of successful trade and industrial promotions in Hong Kong and overseas in 1980.

Finally, I must pay tribute to my predecessor, Nigel Rigg, for maintaining the Chamber on a steady path of development and service to its members during his two years of Chairmanship.

香港服務行業的眼前展望有更多樂觀的根據, 其中尤以金融業為然。只有部份服務行業需直接 依賴貿易。就較廣泛的國際金融業務而言, 香港已取得實質進展。最近外滙銀行公會由 香港銀行公會取代,預料必可助長這個進展過程。 特別是後者組織結構的改善,應使持牌銀行間 及其與港府之間達致更佳的諮詢及協調關係。 其他服務行業如保險、船務、空運及電腦數據



Chamber Review

1980 was another year of substantial progress for the Chamber, both in the development of routine activities, and in a variety of more specific innovations.

The Chamber's performance is perhaps best summed up in the fact that membership at the end of the year had reached an all-time high of over 2,500 companies. 304 new members joined the Chamber during 1980.

The financial outcome for the year, shown in the attached accounts, reflected the healthy state of membership, together with a continued high level of earnings from the other principal revenue raising activity, certification of export documents. Nonetheless, increasing costs, following the general trend of inflation in Hong Kong, and particularly in rentals, obliged the General Committee to

authorise a 25 percentage increase in subscriptions for 1981. As subscriptions were last raised in 1978, this percentage increase was still below the rate of inflation that had taken place over the past three years.

Highlights of the year included a top level mission to the U.K. led by the Chairman in November: considerable development of support services for members of the Chamber — and others dealing with the People's Republic of China: continued efforts to improve our economic ties with Japan both via the Hong Kong/ Japan Business Cooperation Committee and at Chamber Directorate level: the organization of trade promotional missions to 20 countries, giving rise to some \$85 million worth of firm export orders: sponsorship and participation in the Expoship 1980 Exhibition; and a particularly heavy year at

committee level for consideration of both current and proposed legislation, ranging from the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance to the operation of the Textiles Export Control System.

General Committee and Council

The General Committee met six times during the year (excluding a short post AGM meeting at which the Hon. D.K. Newbigging and Mr. John Marden were elected as Chairman and Vice-Chairman respectively). Among matters considered were the Report of the Advisory Committee on Diversification: Rent Control of Domestic Premises: Chamber Representation on Government Boards and Committees: Amendments to the ICAC and Prevention of Bribery Ordinances; in addition to a variety of more routine matters. Especially





important among the latter was a detailed consideration of the Chamber's financial position over the coming few years, resulting from a study commissioned from the Chamber's Treasurers.

Opportunity was taken during the year to increase the number of representatives on the General Committee to the permitted maximum of 20. Several long serving members retired at the Annual General Meeting, but remained on the Chamber's Council.

In accordance with the custom established last year, the Council met formally only once and considered its future role and composition. It was confirmed that the Council should continue to have an advisory function and should meet formally only once each year with other meetings being called when circumstances warranted.

Although formal Council meetings are infrequent, individual councillors continue to play an active and important role in many aspects of Chamber work.

Other Committees

Four ad hoc committees were active during 1980, those considering legislation affecting rentals, the Trade Descriptions Bill, liaison with the Standing Commission on the Civil Service, and in defining contact organisations in the People's Republic of China. All carried out a full programme of work.

The Industrial Affairs Committee met five times during 1980 to discuss, inter alia, industrial training, environmental protection and controls, industrial safety, the oil supply situation and proposed labour legislation.

The Home Affairs Committee met formally four times during the year, as well as considering a number

of matters circulated in papers. Subjects of full meetings included revisions to the Prevention of Bribery and ICAC Ordinances (considered in conjunction with the Legal Committee); the operation of the Prisons Service; the Green Paper on District Administration; and the developing pattern of Hong Kong's transport services.

The China Committee met five times during 1980 to advise the Chamber on important issues affecting trade with China and liaison between the Chamber and PRC organizations.

In view of the satisfactory work being carried out by individual Trade Area Committees, the International Trade Committee was formally disbanded.

Trade Area Committees met regularly throughout the year and, among other work, made a

substantial contribution to the success of the Chamber's various overseas missions.

The Shipping Committee, the Textiles Committee and the Legal Committee also had a busy year, and other committees met as and when required.

Representation on Non Chamber Committees

Altogether some 36 Chamber members, including members of the Directorate, were active on 58 non-Chamber committees, ranging from official Government advisory boards, and their working subcommittees, to projects associated with community development. Following the disbandment of the Trade and Industry Advisory Board, the Chairman, the Hon. D.K. Newbigging was appointed ad personam to the Trade Advisory Board, and the Vice-Chairman, Mr.

John Marden, was appointed as the Chamber representative to the Industry Advisory Board.

Directorate and Divisions

In general, it was a year of both innovation and consolidation of past services for the Director, J.D. McGregor, and the three Divisions, headed by Harry Garlick, Cecilia Fung and T.L. Tsim, although the latter resigned at the end of the year to take up appointment with a member company.

In accordance with the practice set in recent years, the Directorate continued to maintain close watch over working methods and to introduce improvements wherever scope is available. This was most obvious in an increased degree of mechanization of basic services, including a study of the advantages of computerization, which is planned to be introduced on a limited scale early in 1981.

Industry Division

In the field of investment promotion the Division assisted many industrial potential investors visiting Hong Kong, or making enquiries from other countries.

Other Industry Division work included examination of legislation having significance for labour and industry generally, representation to the Government where necessary on industrial matters, detailed consideration of the Government's textiles quota control system, support services for those members of the Chamber dealing with the People's Republic of China and the provision of information on industry to local and overseas enquirers. During 1980 senior executives of the Chamber attended several meetings of the Hong Kong/Japan **Business Cooperation Committee**

按照近年釐定的慣例,董事會繼續密切注視 行事方法,力求改善工作效率。其中尤為 明願的,是基本服務加强機械化,包括業務 電腦化之優點研究。電腦化計劃預定由八一年初 開始作有限度推行。

工業部

在投資促進方面,工業部協助了多位訪港及 從海外諮詢有關本港工業投資情况的外國廠商。 該部門其他工作包括:考慮各項與勞工及工獎 有關之法例;就工業事宜向港府提交悉見書; 對當局現行之紡織品配額管制制度作詳細研究; 為從事中國貿易的會員公司提供輔助服務; 及處理港外人士提出之工業諮詢。 in Hong Kong and Japan, and participated in the Kagoshima/Hong Kong Economic Conference and the Yokohama/Hong Kong Industrial Conference.

Incoming groups included those organized by the North of England Development Council, the Lesotho National Development Council, the South Carolina Port Authorities, the Republic of Panama, Baja California Mexico, and a study mission from Singapore.

The Certification Branch of the Division issued 154,701 certificates of origin and 586 carnets during the year, representing an increase of about 5.15 per cent and 24.68 per cent over 1979.

Trade Division

Aside from firm orders which were generated directly from trade promotional efforts, additional business also accrued from trade enquiries which came in from all over the world and which have continued to increase year after year. In 1980, over 16,000 trade enquiries were dealt with by the Trade Enquiries Branch of the Trade Division.

The number of trade complaints showed a big increase in 1980, almost double that of the previous year, and the number of arbitration cases maintained its 1979 level. The Chamber's role in commercial arbitration has been brought to the attention of the Law Reform Commission which is looking into the provision for arbitration services in Hong Kong.

Elsewhere, in trade facilitation, the Trade Division continued to give support to these worthwhile causes not only in the form of direct representation on the Trade Facilitation Committee but also through the gathering and dissemination of information.

Administration Division

Five major Good Citizen Award presentations were held during the year. Since this scheme started as part of the original Fight Violent Crime campaign in 1973, over \$1 million has been distributed to about 1,000 local people for their efforts towards making life difficult for the criminal.

The Bulletin continues to hold its established place as a leading local business magazine, and advertising support was sufficient to allow it to cover direct production costs. The publications programme and associated PR and publicity activities were maintained despite a continued high-rate of staff turnover.

年內,本會行政要員出席了數個分別在香港及 日本舉行的港日貿易合作委員會會議, 並亦參加了應兒島/香港經濟交流會議及橫濱/ 香港工業會議。

在八〇年間訪港的外國工業團計有由北英格蘭 發展局、萊索托國家發展局、南卡繼來納州 港口局、巴拿馬共和國、墨西哥下加州組織的 各個代表團,及新加坡考察團。

工業部屬下簽証處在年內共簽發了十五萬 四千七百零一份產地來源証,及五百八十六份 爾業樣品臨時入口免稅特許証。此數字與七九年 比較,分別增加5.15%及24.68%。

貿易部

除積極推行貿易促進活動帶來可觀訂單外,來自 世界各國之貿易話詢亦產生了不少額外交易。 年內,貿易語詢科的工作量繼續增加,處理 貿易諮詢數量逾一萬六千宗。

在八〇年間,貿易部處理之商業投訴案較七九年增加幾達一倍,而年內聆聽之仲裁案件則維持去年水平。本會在商業仲裁所担任之角色已引起法律改革委員會的注意,該委員會現正對本港之仲裁服務規則進行探討。

在貿易協進方面,貿易部繼續對此項有價值工作給予大力支持。除正式委有代表出席貿易協進委員會外,本會還協助搜集及宣傳有關的資料。

行政部

年內,本會共舉辦了五次好市民獎頒獎大會。 自一九七三年好市民獎計劃成立以來,迄今 已有約一千名協助撲滅罪行的市民榮獲此獎, 頒發獎金總額逾一百萬元。

「工商月刊」繼續保持本港著名經濟刊物的美譽。 廣告收入已足夠支付直接出版成本。雖然, 負責出版及公關工作的人事頗有變動,但本會 各刊物均能依期出版。




