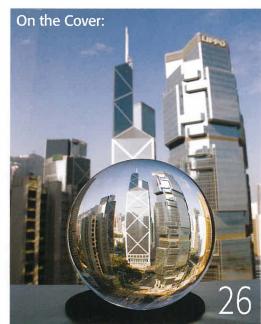

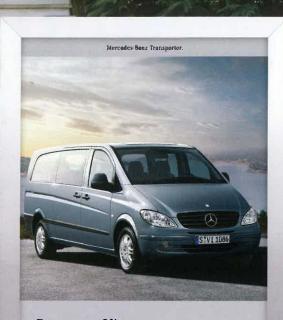
馬錫坤先生辭世

# **Restructuring the Tax System**

ext year, we are scheduled to take a good, hard look at our Hong Kong tax system, through the government's consultation document on the feasibility of introducing a Goods and Services Tax (GST). The Chamber has long supported the need to reduce our fiscal dependence on a small number of companies and salaried workers by broadening the tax base, and so this is indeed a welcome step forward. Our committees have been studying various options for some time, and at the appropriate juncture we will weigh into the public debate. We do, of course, welcome additional input from members.

Two other issues also need to be considered, in conjunction with a possible GST. The first is reducing government spending, which as you know your Chamber has been championing for some time. In the current fiscal year, operating expenditure is budgeted to rise by \$5.5 billion, slightly more than last year, to a record high \$212.2 billion. It will be the fifth straight year of increased spending.

We well understand that declining revenues have been the main source of our recent large fiscal deficits. Declining land sales, salaries, profits and overall prices have exposed a serious structural flaw in our revenue regime. However, the average 3.8 percent per annum increase in operating expenditure over the five years to next March – at a time when our economy grew in nominal terms by perhaps 1 percent a year – is also a serious structural problem.

To reduce our operating expenditure to the level of 2000/01 (when the economy was roughly the same size it is this year) would require Antt trimming about \$13 billion off annual spending. Obviously, such belt-tightening should not be achieved in one go, but just as clearly this is an area of critical

importance to our long term economic health, and one that needs constant attention.

The second consideration is the tax base itself. Three and a half years ago, the Advisory Committee on New Broad-based Taxes pointed out that Hong Kong has a "noticeably heavy reliance on taxation from corporate profits" as a percent of tax revenue. Even if we were successfully to reduce our operating expenditure to the reasonable 14-15 percent of GDP that prevailed in the 1998/99-2001/02 fiscal years, broadening the tax base would still be both necessary and useful. And so, revenue considerations aside, the question is how to broaden the tax base.

The GST is not the only option being contemplated, but merely the one furthest along the process toward public consultation. Several trial balloons are also being floated, most of which would not be appropriate for our economy.

Recently, ideas about taxes on capital gains taxes on dividends, interest and even individuals' global incomes have

been suggested. Each of these was examined by the Advisory Committee noted above, and their merits weighed for efficiency, effectiveness, revenue generation and the impact on Hong Kong's competitiveness. The Advisory Committee's study pointed out that "capital

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gains taxes are relatively inefficient taxes for governments and taxpayers alike." Such taxes would encourage residents to invest offshore, "may also have a detrimental effect on Hong Kong as a destination for regional share listings and as a regional financial centre," and "could adversely affect the property and stock markets." Clearly, such a tax would be counterproductive in an economy like ours.

A tax on interest was also deemed to be inefficient, easily avoided and to have potentially adverse effects on the monetary system. Dividend taxes were deemed to be an inappropriate type of double taxation. As for taxing world wide income, such a move would likely generate no new revenue, as

> Hong Kong taxes are lower than those in most other jurisdictions, and taxes paid to other governments would have to be deductible from tax paid in Hong Kong.

> We believe that the findings of the Advisory Committee are equally valid today.

In contrast to these possible new taxes, there is one existing tax which does not raise much revenue and whose abolition would bring significant benefits to one important sector of the Hong Kong economy, financial services. This is estate duty and the Chamber has answered the recent request for consultation by putting in a submission to government arguing for doing away with this. We believe this would greatly

enhance the private wealth management business in Hong Kong, increasing greatly activity and employment in this sector.

But to return to the subject of broadening our tax revenues, the Advisory Commission determined in 2001 that a broad-based consumption tax was fair, effective, efficient, flexible, in line with international norms and quite profitable as a source of revenue. It is of course essential that it is well designed and with appropriate exemptions. It should also on inception be accompanied by some reductions in income and corporation taxes.

In closing, let me just add that I have been heartened and encouraged by the rapid recovery in our economy this year. Our government revenues are improving, of that there is no doubt. What remains is the hard work of reducing government expenditure and devising a fair and efficient means of broadening the tax base to make our economy more robust to deal with the ups and downs which the future will undoubtedly bring.

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年,我們計劃透過開徵商品及服務税(銷售税)之 可行性的政府諮詢文件,認真、深入檢討本港税 制。我們一向支持擴闊税基,減少對少數企業及 受薪階層税收的依賴。本會委員會研究不同税制方案已有 一段時間,在適當時候,我們會參考公眾論點,當然也歡 迎會員給予意見。

談到應否開徵銷售税,須連帶考慮兩點。第一點是減 低政府開支,這是本會提出多時的主張。在今個財政年 度,預算營運開支將上升55億元至2.122億元,略高於去 年增幅,也是政府開支連續第5年增加。

我們深明近年財赤高企,主要因為政府收入下降。 出現重大結構性失衡。然而,至明年3月為止的5年 內,政府營運開支每年平均增加3.8%,但本港經濟每 年名義增長或許只有1%,反映當中存在著嚴重的結構 性問題。

若要把營運開支降至 2000/01 年度水平 (當年經濟表現 與今年相若),全年開支需要減少130億元。顯然,這不能 一促而蹴,但政府開支與本港長遠經濟健康有密切關係, 必須時刻留意。

第二點乃關於税基本身。三年半前,税基擴闊新税項 事宜諮詢委員會指出,本港税收「明顯高度依賴企業盈利 帶來的税收」。即使我們能令營運開支回降至 1998/99 至 2001/02 年間的合理水平 (即佔本地生產總值 14-15%),本 港依然有擴闊税基的需要。因此,除了設法增加收入,還 要考慮怎樣擴闊税基。

開徵銷售税並非本港唯一的選擇,卻是唯一能進展至 公眾諮詢階段的建議。社會上雖亦有提出其他方案,不過 大部份並不適合香港經濟。

最近,有人建議開徵資本增值税、股息税、利息税甚

至個人海外收入税。上文提及的諮詢委員會曾分別評估這 些建議的效率、效益、税收及對香港競爭力的影響。

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諮詢委員會的研究指出,「對政府及納税人而言,資本 增值税的效益較低」。這類税項會促使本地居民作離岸投 資,「不利於香港的區域股票上市及金融中心地位」,以 及「對地產及股票市場帶來負面影響」。可見開徵資本增 值税對本港經濟弊多於利。

至於利息税,委員會認為其效率低、容易逃過,而且對 金融體系有潛在負面影響;股息税則有重覆徵税之嫌;而 就個人海外收入徵税,亦未必會帶來新收入,因為香港税 率普遍低於其他地區,支付予其他政府的税款,可能會從 付予香港的税款中扣除。

在今天,我們認為諮詢委員會的研究結論依然正確。

其實,在香港現行税制下,有一類税收對庫房貢獻不 多,但若能取消,定對本港經濟重要一環——金融服務業 的發展有莫大裨益。我們指的是遺產税,總商會已就政府 最近發出的諮詢文件提交回應,詳述有關理據。我們認為 取消遺產税,將大大促進本港私人資產管理行業發展,刺 激行內活動及就業。

回到擴闊税基的議題上,諮詢委員會 2001 年的結論認 為,開徵税基廣闊的消費税是公平、有效益、高效率、靈 活和符合國際慣例,而且可帶來可觀收入。當然,政府必 須擬定完善的徵收辦法,及界定豁免細則,並在推出的同 時,酌量減低入息税及公司利得税率。

最後想一提的是<sup>,</sup>我對本港經濟今年迅速復甦感到鼓舞 和欣慰。政府收入既已得到改善,下一步,我們需要致力 減低政府開支,以公平、有效的方法來擴闊税基,促進本 港經濟蓬勃發展,以迎接未來的各種挑戰。<br />

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# **Widening the Tax Base**

We all would like the government to spend more on education, healthcare and boosting the economy, but to finance this we need to widen the currently very narrow tax base, and a goods and services tax may be a possible solution, writes the Chamber's Legco Rep, The Hon JEFFREY LAM

ong Kong is a highly open and free economy, which leaves it vulnerable to outside forces if it cannot maintain a stable and healthy financial base. Following changes in our economic environment and adjustments to public expenditure, the need for the Hong Kong SAR Government to balance the budget is a problem that will impact our long-term wellbeing.

Hong Kong's taxation system is simple and the rate is low. However, if we wish to increase our revenues, we need to seriously review how we can broaden our tax base.

Currently, we rely heavily on a small group of taxpayers for

direct tax. Among the 3.2 million jobholders in Hong Kong, only 1.2 million pay any tax; and nearly 60 percent of profit tax comes from less than 1 percent of companies in Hong Kong. When we urge our government to improve social welfare, and complain that our medical and education resources fall behind other countries' standards, do we bear in mind that other countries' citizens also envy us for not having to pay on average a quarter of our salaries in taxes?

Few would disagree that our tax base is too narrow, yet some worry if we broaden it through a (goods and services tax) GST, it will impact Jeff Hong Kong's reputation as a shopping paradise, reduce consumption, and widen the rich-poor gap. SMEs are also afraid that the introduction of a GST might raise their operating costs and add to their administration work.

Our Financial Secretary has vowed that if a GST is to be introduced, it will go in parallel with subsidies to low-income families, and tax concessions to the middle-class. As our population ages, future expenses on welfare for the elderly will be huge. Moreover, there have been recent reports that over 200,000 Hong Kong children are living in poverty and need help from the government. If the administration can utilise its revenues wisely, perhaps more can be done to improve the lives of the unprivileged by effectively re-allocating the wealth of our society.

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More than 100 countries have implemented a GST. Some may have got off to a bumpy start, but in general most are a success. Like Australia, the country successfully reformed its taxation system without any adverse effect on its economy. In fact, its domestic economy even recovered soon after a GST was introduced.

Indeed, based on the taxation study, a GST can bring many advantages if it is handled correctly. Whether it can win public

support depends very much on the methodology of implementation which includes measures to relieve the burden on the grass roots sector and SMEs.

Based on other countries' experiences, it is important to educate people about the workings of a GST, as well as giving them ample time for consultation, to prepare for the new tax.

The Financial Secretary has said that even if Hong Kong decides to implement a GST, it would not come into effect until 2009 at the earliest. This gives different sectors ample time to conduct indepth reviews and studies on a GST when the consultation document is released, and sufficient time to discuss the details.

The government has made a good first move. The next step will depend on whether our Financial Secretary is strong enough to finalise a GST plan that will have minimal impact on the general public. It is important that he strikes a balance between reforming our taxation system and protecting the interests of the business community and the general public.

我們都希望政府增撥更多資源,用於教育、醫療和刺激經濟。但要增加政府收入,我們 需要擴闊税基,引入銷售税也許有助開源。 林健鋒

港是一個高度自由和開放的經濟體系,要是沒有 一個穩健的財政作為後盾,我們的經濟將會變得 很脆弱。隨着香港經濟情況的轉變和公共開支的 調整,政府應如何確保收支平衡,是一個關乎我們長遠福 祉的問題。香港税制的優點是簡單、低税率,但要增加收入,擴闊税基便值得深入探討。

在直接税的分佈內,本港比較偏重由小部份納税人支 付,全港320萬就業人士之中,只有120萬人繳税;不足 1個百分點的公司,繳交了近六成的利得税。當大家要求政 府改善福利,及埋怨醫療和敎育資源不及人家的時候,我 們不要忘記,其他國家的國民同樣羨慕香港人,不用將四 分一薪金上繳政府。

本港税基**教**窄,不少香港人都同意,但同時間,部份行 業擔心一旦開徵銷售税去擴闊税基,會帶來負面影響,例如 零售業憂慮香港購物天堂的美譽會因此而毀於一旦,市民消 費意慾亦大大下降,隨之令貧富懸殊問題日益深化;中小企 業亦怕開徵銷售税增加經營成本,令經營倍添困難。

財政司司長已「拍心口」保證,如果實施銷售税,不但 會補貼低收入家庭,亦會為中產人士提供其他税務寬減。 香港正面對人口老化的問題,將來的老人福利將會是一個 龐大的財政開支,最近又有報導指目前有 20 萬名赤貧兒 童,需要政府增加援助。政府若能好好利用銷售税得來的 款項,改善香港弱勢社群的生活,同樣能達到財富再分配 的效果。

全球有上百個國家實行銷售税,有的國家在推行初期遇 到困難,但大部份國家也能成功實施<sup>\$</sup>如澳洲,便成功改 革税制,並沒有對當地經濟造成任何負面影響。事實上, 該國引入銷售税不久,其國內經濟已好轉。

其實銷售税在税務學上,是一個具備多種良好質素的税 項。它是否能得到市民的支持,關鍵在於如何落實各項細 節,包括減輕低下階層負擔和中小企營運成本的措施。前 車可鑑,當中的要訣是諮詢時間足夠,讓市民有充份的心 理準備。

財政司司長已表明,如果落實,最快也會在 2009 年才推 行銷售税。因此,社會各階層仍有機會作更深入討論,到日 後發表諮詢文件後,各界也有充裕的時間去商討各項細節。 政府已走對了第一步,其後,便要看財政司是否有足夠的魄 力,落實一個對市民影響最小的銷售税方案,在改革香港税 制,與保障商戶生計、市民生活之間,找到一個平衡點。

# A Booming Year Comes to an End for Hong Kong and the Chamber

2004 year has turned out to be a very good year for Hong Kong, statistically and feelings wise. After the devastating impact of SARS for several months in 2003, it was a relief that the disease did not return, but that economic prosperity did return.

Similarly, the Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce had a very good 2004. Our projected surplus for this year is at a record high, despite that we ran more programs than ever, participated in more policy debates than ever, and helped more

members than ever in doing business. Let me highlight a few of the things that we did this year for you and for Hong Kong:

 We participated in an extremely constructive way in the all-important discussion on the political future of Hong Kong. Through Op-Eds, public statements, and through our input to the constitutional development consultation – which can be viewed on our Web site (www.chamber.org.hk) – the Chamber contributed to the discussion by being a voice of progressive thinking and reason. As a result, we believe that this process is on track, with the community

focusing on the things we believe important: stability and economic prosperity, political parties, think tanks, tax base, public education, political participation, etc.

We are making our views known to the government on racial discrimination legislation, with cautious advice on making sure that the cost of doing business does not rise while fighting against discrimination, and that the difficult situations the SMEs could find them in are taken care of through very careful wording of the legislation. We are on the forefront once again of alerting the government about the urgency of the air pollution problem in Hong Kong and the Pearl River Delta. This problem is reaching critical condition and harms Hong Kong's reputation as Asia's World City. Through seminars and through discussions with the government, including in the Policy Address submission we gave the SAR Chief Executive, we highlighted the urgent need to do something about Hong Kong's air pollution.

We worked hard with both the SAR and Central governments on the economic positioning of Hong Kong vis a vis China's rapid economic development. Through monitoring of CEPA's first year of implementation, to expanding CEPA's contents, to preaching the worth of CEPA to foreign investors overseas, to supporting China's "Going Out" policy both inside and outside China, to working with Pearl River Delta cities on PRD integration and Pan-PRD expansion, to trying to identify new Beijing policies which can enhance Hong Kong's value, the Chamber has helped Hong Kong's economic positioning,

 Finally, through programs, networks, trips, and visitors, the Chamber has helped our members do business all year round. We hope that we have been helpful to your business. 2004年香港營商數據及氣氛相當理想。去年沙士肆 虐本港數月,對本地各行各業帶來重大打擊。今 年,沙士沒有重現,令大家都鬆一口氣,本港經濟 亦明顯好轉。

香港總商會在 2004 年也有極佳表現。今年,我們雖比 往年籌辦更多活動,參與更多政策辯論,及協助更多會員 營商,但預料本會今年的盈餘數字,將創出新高。讓我在 此簡述總商會今年為會員及香港所做的一些工作:

我們以極具建設性的方式,就多個對本港未來政治發展
 舉足輕重的議題發表意見。總商會透過發表專稿、公開
 聲明及回應政制發展諮詢(有關內容請瀏覽本會網頁:
 www.chamber.org.hk),在社會議論中,提出積極而理
 智的觀點。我們相信,本會的意見已受到社會重視,社
 會各界亦正投放焦點於本會關注的事宜上:如社會穩
 定、經濟繁榮、政黨、智囊團、税基、公眾教育、政治
 參與等。

一本會就種族歧視法例向政府提出審慎建議,務求能打 擊歧視,而不會增加營商成本。建議書內的行文用字 亦非常謹慎,因本會亦充份考慮到中小企可能面對的 困境。 本會再次走上前線,促請政府盡速正視香港及珠三角的 空氣污染問題。現時空氣污染問題非常嚴重,有損香港 「亞洲動感之都」的美譽。本會通過研討會,與政府官 員討論,以及提交予特區行政長官的施政報告建議書等 各個渠道,多番強調本港空氣污染問題已刻不容緩,急 需政府正視和處理。

- 面對內地經濟高速發展,香港經濟需要重新定位,本會 在這方面與特區及中央政府一起做了不少工作:包括監 察「緊貿安排」首年的推行情況、擴充「緊貿安排」內 容、向海外投資者推介「緊貿安排」的價值、協助內地 企業「走出去」、與珠三角其他城市緊密合作,務求達 致區內融合、並向「泛珠」擴張、並留意有助香港增值 的北京新政策等。總括而言,本會的工作有助香港經濟 定位,開創更多就業機會及令市民及投資者回復信心。
- 最後,本會的活動、網絡、考察團及訪客,在年內對會員營商助益不淺。我們希望總商會能對貴公司業務有所幫助,也多謝大家對總商會的支持。我誠心希望現有會員更新來年會籍,繼續支持我們的工作。

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# **Evolution, Enhancement & Expansion**

The Pear River Delta looks set to grow from strength to strength if current challenges can be overcome, say speakers at the Third PRD Conference

uangdong's economy grew 14.6 per cent year on year in the first three-quarters of this year and the PRD region represents 95 per cent of Guangdong's economy. Despite this stellar growth, the PRD is facing a number of challenges, with energy and labour shortages being the most serious.

"We hear now that some factories are only able to operate four or five days a week," HKGCC Chairman Anthony Nightingale said. "And I am told that there are now 1.8 million job vacancies in the PRD."

Speaking to the 400-plus audience at the Third Pearl River Delta Conference organised by HKGCC and the South China Morning Post on November 1 in Zhongshan, Mr Nightingale said environmental protection, especially air pollution, was another challenge that needs to be solved.



The conference, entitled "Evolution, Enhancement and Expansion: The Delta within the Pan-PRD," provided a practical approach to how businesses in Hong Kong and China can actualise the benefits of the PRD and use it as a base to expand into the Pan-PRD.

More than 60,000 companies in the Pearl River Delta are invested in by Hong Kong businessmen and more than 200,000 Hong Kong people are living and working in the PRD. And despite the fact that China's other economic engine, the Yangtze River Delta is often viewed as a threat to Hong Kong, Mr Nightingale said that he expects the PRD itself to remain the bridgehead for Hong Kong business to expand into Mainland China.

"The PRD is still Hong Kong companies' first choice in location to start their investment plans in the Mainland," he said.

Xie Pengfei, Deputy Director-General of the People's Govemment of Guangdong Province, and Director of the Center for Development Research of the People's Government of Guangdong Province, was similarly upbeat about the region's prospects.

"I believe that in the next 30 to 50 years, with development and community development in China, the Pan-PRD region will be one of the most vitalised regions in China with the fastest economic growth," he said.

He believes that Guangdong is entering a new stage of development as the region's wealth expands. Last year, urban savings in Guangdong reached some RMB1,360 billion, signifying the province is not only an economic powerhouse, but also that its citizens have a high level of disposable income.

"If you look at the lifestyle of Guangdong residents, they are already at the middle-class level compared to the nation-wide averages. Actually we are slightly better than middle class," he said.

This rising wealth is creating opportunities for service industries, especially retailers. Peter Lau, Chairman and CEO of Giordano, predicts Guangzhou will grow into a shopping mecca to complement the luxury goods and latest designs that Hong Kong is renowned for internationally.

"These two cities would attract the other 30 million people in and around this region to actually make a trip to Guangzhou or to Hong Kong for shopping," he said.

This could turn out to be a double-edged sword, however. Because people in the PRD will have more disposable income, competition for their RMB among retailers is expected to increase, Mr Lau predicts.



"There is going to be tremendous competition in retail especially, because retail has a very low entry barrier. The cost of opening a shop in Zhongshan, for example, is relatively cheap. So all of a sudden you are going to find a neighbour, an unwelcome neighbour that you never saw before next door," he said.

Wang Junzhou, General Manager, GOME Electrical Appliances Holding Ltd, which runs the Mainland's largest home appliance chain with 150 outlets, pointed out that Guangdong's added attraction for retailers is that they can get higher prices for their goods.

"For example, we can sell our TV sets in Guangdong for RMB6,000-7,000, but in Sichuan, in Guizhou, the price may be as low as RMB2,000," he explained, adding that land and labour costs in the two regions where their factories are located significantly affected the retail price.

Getting visitors in and out of Guangdong is expected to be smoother once major infrastructure works are complete. Airports, roads and railways will facilitate tourism, investment and trade in the delta, but worries about inter-competition and redundant projects are far from being amicably solved.

Hong Kong's status as the region's primary airport could come under attack sooner than expected as the Mainland authorities speed up the tempo on aviation reform.

Guangzhou's new Baiyun Airport is not expected to develop a network that would threaten Hong Kong until the turn of the decade. The cargo market, however, is soon expected to come under threat as Lufthansa, Air France and Northwest Airlines' freighter services are expected to take off from Baiyun next year.

#### A US\$2 Trillion Economy in the Making

Economic growth in the Pearl River Delta looks set to continue soaring as the region expands to become the pan-Pearl River Delta, Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology John Tsang said.

"I say so confidently because our forecast figures suggest that the GDP in this region will exceed US\$1 trillion by 2010 and doubling to US\$2 trillion 10 years later in 2020," he told the audience during his keynote luncheon address at the Third Pearl River Delta Conference in Zhongshan on November 1.

Hong Kong's 120,000 enterprises in the Pan-PRD will drive much of this growth as they explore opportunities to penetrate further into the region. Mr Tsang said he also sees the Pan-PRD becoming a market for Hong Kong goods and services, and not just a manufacturing powerhouse. But before that can happen, infrastructure planning in the entire region needs to improve.

"For economic development of the Pan-PRD region to take off, better co-ordination in infrastructure planning, particularly in terms of a transport network, is absolutely essential," he said. "Improved access through better transport will present tremendous opportunities for the logistics sector, a pillar of our economy."

He also sees Hong Kong's financial services playing a stronger role in helping Mainland enterprises looking to expand their reach. They will also be able to benefit from professional business services providers' expertise as they strive to go global and strengthen corporate governance. Mr Tsang said he believes that this is an important ingredient for business to thrive in the Pan-PRD region, especially once the Mainland opens up under its WTO commitments.

"We believe Hong Kong is well positioned to complement its Pan-PRD partners in areas of professional and value-added services, such as legal, accounting, information technology and management consulting, and in turn gear up the Pan-PRD region towards the development of a more advanced regional economy," he said.

Tourism in the Pan-PRD is another area that offers great potential for development, with each province possessing its own unique share of history, culture, entertainment and scenery.

"Development potential is boundless," Mr Tsang says. "We believe that more economic activities in the '9+2' area will stimulate further the growth in traffic among those living in the region, boost tourism, and engender prospects for growth in the tourism-related sectors."

總商會主席黎定基說:「聽說有些工廠現時每星期只能 開工四、五天,據我所知,區內職位空缺亦高達180萬個。」

香港總商會和南華早報合辦的第三屆珠江三角洲會議, 11月1日在中山舉行,吸引了400多人參加。黎氏在會上表 示,環保,尤其是空氣污染問題,亟待解決。

會議主題為「從珠三角到泛珠三角:演變、充實與擴 張」,旨在從實際角度,探討中港兩地企業,如何切實把握 珠三角的優勢,並以珠三角為基地,繼而進軍泛珠三角。

目前在珠三角,投資設廠的港商有6萬多家,居住和工作的港人有20多萬。儘管長江三角洲是中國另一個經濟火車 頭,也常被視為對香港構成威脅,黎氏預料珠三角仍會是港 商進軍內地的橋頭堡。

他說:「對有意投資內地的港商來說,珠三角依然是首 選的落腳地。」

廣東省人民政府副秘書長、省政府發展研究中心主任謝 鵬飛,也對珠三角的前景感到樂觀。

他説:「我認為在未來 30 至 50 年,隨著內地經濟和社 會發展,泛珠三角將成為中國最具活力、經濟增長最快的地 區之一。」

謝氏相信,隨著地區愈來愈富,廣東正踏入新發展階段。去年,廣東省城市儲蓄高達13,600億人民幣,反映該省 不但經濟蓬勃,當地居民的可支配收入亦相當高。

他解釋:「與全國平均生活水平比較,廣東居民的生活

廣東省居民日漸富裕,也為服務業,尤其是零售業帶來更 多商機。佐丹奴有限公司主席兼總裁劉國權預料廣州將成為購 物之都,與素以高檔和新款商品聞名國際的香港並駕齊驅。

劉氏説:「珠三角一帶會有3千萬人到港穗旅遊購物。」 當然,這趨勢有利亦有弊。如今珠三角居民可花的錢多

了,劉氏預料零售商之間的競爭亦會轉熾。

他說:「零售業競爭將非常激烈,因為這行業的准入門 檻很低,譬如在中山開店,所需成本不多。正是這樣,附近 很容易有其他新店來跟你搶生意。」

國美電器 (香港) 有限公司總經理王俊洲指出,廣東省吸 引零售商的另一原因,是商品能賣更高價錢。國美電器是內 地最大規模的家電連鎖店,分店多達 150 間。

王氏舉例:「譬如在廣州,一台電視機可以賣人民幣6、7 千元,但在四川和貴州,卻只能賣2千元。」他解釋國美在兩地 均有設廠,但兩地的土地和勞工成本不同,故零售價也有差異。

待大型基建落成後,旅客進出廣東會更容易。機場、公 路和鐵路將促進珠三角旅遊、投資和貿易發展,但區內競爭 和項目重覆等問題仍未解決。

由於內地政府加快航空業改革步伐,香港機場在區內的 領導地位或會提早面臨考驗。

相信在2010年前,廣州新白雲機場的航空網絡不會威脅 香港,但我們的貨運業卻快將受挑戰,因預期德國漢莎航空、 法國航空和西北航空明年將在白雲機場開展貨運服務。

#### 締造萬億美元經濟

工商及科技局局長曾俊華預期,隨著 珠三角演變至泛珠三角,區內經濟增長將 延續。

曾局長11月1日於中山舉行的第三 屆珠江三角洲會議上發表午餐會主題演 說,他向與會者稱:「我們的預測數據 顯示,區內本地生產總值至2010年將 超過1兆美元,而10年後更將倍增至2 兆美元,因此我對珠三角未來經濟增長 很有信心。」

泛珠三角區內 12 萬家香港企業,將

不斷探索機會擴展區內業務,是區內經 濟增長的主要來源。泛珠三角不僅是製 造基地,更有條件成為香港貨品及服務 的市場,但必須先改善區內整體基建規 劃來為此鋪路。

他說:「必須改善區內基建規劃,尤 其須統籌好區內運輸交通,泛珠三角經濟 才能蓬勃發展。良好的運輸網絡能令物流 業——本港經濟支柱大大獲益。」

他指香港金融服務業,在協助內地企 業擴展業務上亦會扮演更重要角色。內地 企業可借助香港商業服務供應商的專才和 知識,走向國際和加強企業管治。曾局長 相信兩者對在泛珠三角營商 (尤其在內地 按世貿承諾而開放市場之後) 很重要。

他說:「我們相信香港的專業和增值 服務,如法律、會計、資訊科技、管理顧 問等,能補助泛珠三角同業的不足,推動 泛珠三角地區經濟發展更上層樓。」

此外,泛珠三角各省,均擁有不同的 歷史、文娛和風景特色,區內旅遊業有戶 大發展潛力。

曾局長稱:「區內發展潛力無限。我 們相信,9+2區內經濟活動愈多,愈能促 進區內人流往來,進而刺激旅遊業,帶動 旅遊相關行業增長發展。」





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#### **Developing a Pan-PRD Union**

We generally think of the Pan-Pearl River Delta as the workshop of the world. While the notion of turning part of factories' output for exports around for sale domestically has crossed manufacturers' minds, the idea has never really been taken too seriously.

But Victor Fung, Chairman of the Greater Pearl River Delta Business Council, believes manufacturers producing goods in the Pan-Pearl River Delta region should start thinking seriously of the delta as not just as their workshop, but also as a developing market with enormous potential.

Speaking at the PRD Conference, he said over the long term, the whole area could develop into a common market, which he likens to Europe before the establishment of the European Community.

"The idea of making this a common market, a unitary market, I think is really where we are heading," he says.

Realising this dream will not involve the complexities of different governments, countries, and customs that Europe had to grapple with, but like the European Community, self interests within the region could turn the dream of a common market, a unitary market, into a nightmare.

"We still see a lot of what I would very bluntly call protectionism in terms of movement of trade and commerce between provinces," he said. "There are still stories of trucks going to the border of a province, having to have their cargo unloaded and then reloaded onto provincial trucks before they could go further."

A common market will also serve as a very strong regional base, both for multinationals approaching the rest of the country and the rest of the Pan-Pearl River Delta region as well as a base for Chinese companies to go abroad, he added.

Businesses should also be looking at how they can tap the Pan-Pearl River Delta as a reservoir of talent and resources ready to meet our future land and labour needs.

"In my mind, the greater strategic value of actually developing the Pearl River Delta and the Pan-Pearl River Delta concept, is in fact the development of the western region of China," Mr Fung said. "You develop western China through the south western provinces, and the future destiny – if you would – of the Pearl River Delta, Guangdong, and Hong Kong, is really to bring the south west provinces into the western part of China."



### Holidaying in the PRD

W hichever part of the world you decide to vacation in this year, more than likely you will plan to visit two, three or more destinations. Many people go to Los Angeles, Las Vegas and San Francisco as a triangle from international destinations. Likewise, the London-Paris-Rome triangle also draws tourists like a magnet. Closer to home, Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand team up to offer three-destination packages.

Hong Kong, Macau and other cities in the PRD, however, are still concentrating on marketing themselves as single destinations instead of multi-city packages. As a result, everyone is losing out, according to a panel of travel experts.

Hong Kong and Macau did joint promotions 12 years ago, Joao Manuel Costa





 Antunes, Director of the Macau Government Tourist Office, said, but unfortunately the effort was quickly abandoned.

"If you create awareness of one region, it is much more effective than just promoting one single destination," he said. "People come to one destination and they do not know what else is nearby, so they don't come back and as a result we miss out on repeat visitors because they think they have already seen everything here."

Tom Mehrmann, Chief Executive of Ocean Park Corporation, also speaking on the panel, echoed his comments. "Everybody comes to Hong Kong once, and Macau once, but actually the important thing is to get them coming back again, and I think we have to create a certain amount

of attraction so that people will want to return and continue travelling here."

However, the danger of one bad apple spoiling the barrel is an issue that cannot be ignored, a member of the audience suggested. Many destinations in the PRD, as in the whole of China, simply do not have sufficient infrastructure in place to handle the number of domestic tourists that they already receive, let alone bring in more international visitors. As a result, one bad experience would reflect badly on the whole "PRD brand."

This is clearly illustrated by the fact that Hong Kong people, themselves, turn their backs on taking short tours in the PRD, opting instead to visit Cebu, Bali or Phuket.

She is determined to go on from Hong Kong to Bali and back via Singapore," he said. "There are no interesting or attractive packages for her that are marketed back in the U.K. in such a way that she would be attracted to come to Hong Kong-Macau-Zhongshan. So I see a very long way to go before we are in the right place to promote that kind of multi-polar destination."

Ronnie Ho, Chairman of the Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong, however, feels that China's cultural and heritage attractions, together with efforts to improve the local infrastructure will be enough to attract Hong Kong and international tourists.

#### 發展泛珠三角聯盟

我們普遍視泛珠江三角為一個世 界工場。雖然製造商曾想把部份出口 產品轉為內銷,卻不曾認真作出任何 行動。

大珠三角商務委員會主席馮國經 認為,泛珠三角的製造商應認真意識 到珠三角不僅是個生產基地,還是個 潛力龐大的發展中市場。

馮氏在珠三角會議上表示,長遠來 説,整個地區可發展成共同市場,現 時情況就像歐盟成立前的歐洲一樣。

他説:「我們要走的路<sup>,</sup>是把泛 珠三角發展成單一共同市場。」

歐洲組織歐盟,要解決不同政 府、國家和海關的複雜問題。相比之 下,泛珠三角發展共同市場則容易得 多。然而,若區內省市像歐盟成員國 一樣自顧本身利益,只會把一個好的 動機變成一場噩夢。

馮氏説:「恕我直言,目前省際 商貿依然充斥著保護主義。我們仍不 時聽聞,貨車將進入另一省邊境前, 須卸下貨物,把貨搬上該省貨車,才 能入省。」

他續說,這共同市場可作為強大 的地區基地,幫助跨國公司進軍全國 各地和泛珠三角其他地區,還可成為 有意拓展海外業務的內地企業據點。

此外,企業應研究如何利用泛珠 三角的豐富人才和資源,以應付未來 的土地和人才需要。

馮氏説:「我認為,珠三角和泛 珠三角概念的更大策略價值,在於開 發中國西部。我們可借助西南省份來 發展中國西部,而珠三角、廣東和香 港能在這當中發揮作用。」



#### Workshop of the World

In the 1950s, the United States was the centre of manufacturing in the world, producing the best cars, television sets, chemicals and other products for export. The Japanese soon caught up, as did South Korea, Hong Kong, Singapore, Chairman of Hopewell Holdings, Sir Gordon Wu said.

Then after Deng Xiaopeng's reforms, many manufacturers moved to the Pearl River Delta, which has now become the workshop of the world. To ensure the delta retains this title, we need to produce high value-added products in the more expensive eastern PRD, whereas the lower value goods can still be produced in west Guangdong.

"Then, the Pearl River Delta plan has real practical, useful concepts that utilise or integrate the resources of all different places and work under the same system and framework, to maximise our competitive strength," Sir Gordon said.

#### 世界工場

### Air Pollution a Common Concern

n the course of the PRD's economic development, "We all have to pay attention to environmental protection," Xian Wen, Vice Mayor of Zhuhai says. "So for industries that invest in Zhuhai, we have strict controls over pollutants and the government enforces these laws."

As Zhuhai is still industrially undeveloped compared with the rest of the delta, he believes his city is not a big contributor to the pollution problem in the PRD, and suggested that the sources come from further north.

Huang Weiguo, Vice Mayor, Foshan, says that as his city and Hong Kong are 200 kilometres apart, it was unlikely that they would impact each other's air quality. Nonetheless, environmental protection is a big concern in Foshan, especially water pollution and acid rain, which all municipalities in the PRD are concerned about.

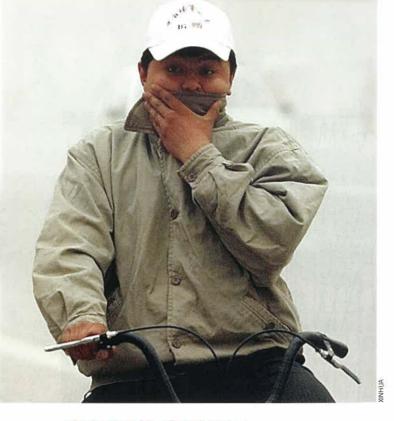
"Environmental concern is our number one priority, social development and economic development ranks second," Mr Huang says. "Regarding Foshan and Hong Kong, I do not think there is any connection, but regarding air pollution, perhaps we need more studies into that to find out if there is any connection."

In Shenzhen, residents there are no less concerned about air pollution than people in Hong Kong, says Zhang Yiwen, Deputy Secretary General Shenzhen. "Just 10 years ago, Shenzhen used to be proud of its very clean air and blue skies," he said. "But now we don't have this."

For 23 out of the 31 days in October, the city was blanketed in smog, Mr Zhang said, adding that exactly where all this pollution is coming from was unclear.

He admitted that environmental protection in Shenzhen was not as stringent as in Hong Kong, but that the city was striving to match our efforts.

"We are looking at sustainable developments and we pay particular attention to environmental protection. No matter what industry you are involved in, you now have to go through an environmental assessment," he said. B



### 空氣污染廣受關注

本海市副市長洗文指出,在中國發展經濟的過程中,應 同時注重環保:「珠海嚴格管制市內工業排出污染物,市政府亦認真執行有關法例。」

在珠三角區內,珠海市的工業發展相對較落後,故冼氏 認為珠海並非區內污染的主要源頭,他相信污染來自區內較 北市縣。

佛山市副市長黃維郭表示,佛山與香港相隔200公里, 兩地空氣質素應沒有關連。然而,佛山市對環境保護,尤其 全國均關心的水源污染及酸雨問題,高度關注。

黃氏稱:「環保是我們的最大關注,社會及經濟發展反 而居次。我看佛山與香港的情況沒有關連,不過在空氣污染 方面可再作研究,看有否相連的地方。」

與港人一樣,深圳市民亦非常關心空氣污染問題。深圳 市政府副秘書長張綺雲說:「十年前,深圳經常是藍天白 雲,我們亦以此自豪,但如今,環境已面目全非。」

張氏慨歎在 10 月份的 31 天裡,深圳被煙霧籠罩了 23 天,該市至今仍未清楚污染來源。

他承認深圳的環保規管未及香港嚴謹,但該市正致力與 香港看齊:「我們正就可持續發展進行研究,也特別注重環 保,並規定所有行業,都必須通過環境評估。」

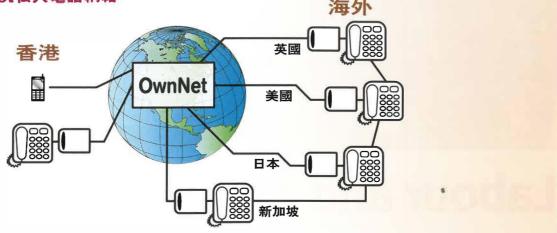

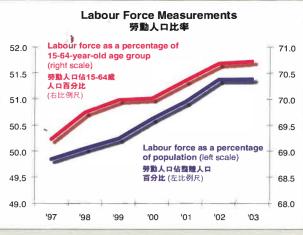

## Labour and Productivity

More people are working in Hong Kong than at any other time in the city's history, yet the unemployment rate remains stubbornly high. The Chamber's Chief Economist, DAVID O'REAR, crunches the numbers to find out what is going on

t nearly 3.3 million jobs, employment in Hong Kong has never been higher. New records were set in four of the last five months, yet the unemployment rate remains stubbornly high, at 6.7 percent. What's going on?

Employment in the first 10 months was up 44,385 as compared to the same 2003 period, while unemployment dropped by 32,300 and under-employment – those working fewer hours than they wish – fell by 5,423. Surely such a sharp turn around must mean that the unemployment rate is getting back to the normal 4-5 percent level, right?

Not quite. The unemployment rate is a measure of job holders against the labour force, one divided by the other. When the labour force rises, employment must rise at least as fast just to keep the rate constant. In January-October, the labour force (those who say they are willing to work) increased by 14,828 people. As a result, the 1.4 percent rise in employment generated only a 0.9 percent improvement in the unemployment rate.

The labour force is growing less quickly than overall employment, but still is rising as a share of the population. There are two possible explanations for this, one demographic and the other economic. Demographically, the typical working age population (ages 15-64) may, through an accident of birth, be rising at a faster pace. Alternatively, more people may be looking for work, including those who were discouraged from seeking employment last year. A combination of the two is at work in Hong Kong: the working age population rose an average 1.08 percent per annum in the past five years, while population growth overall was just 0.8 percent a year. The first graph shows the rise in the labour force as a percentage of total population, and as a share of the appropriate age group.

In the mid-1990s, employment grew strongly in the U.S., Taiwan, Hong Kong and Singapore, as illustrated in the second graph. Japan's low population growth rate explains that the country's near-zero change, and Korea's numbers show the impact of job losses from the Asian Financial Crisis. In the last five years, job growth rebounded strongly in Korea and remained healthy in Singapore, while the other economies saw sharp drops in the pace of employment expansion.

The ratio between the growth in real GDP per employee and that of real GDP itself may be a proxy for changes in productivity. Among the six economies mentioned above, the U.S. had the strongest improvement, followed by Hong Kong. Our own strong showing is based on very good growth in trade, where productivity enhancements – turning over more product per person employed – is easier than, say, producing more widgets or wheat.

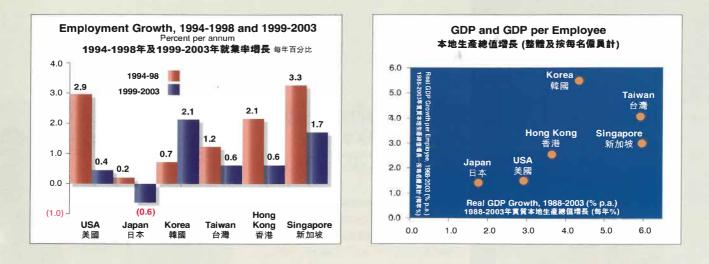
The last graph shows relative positions as measured by real economic growth and growth per employee over a 15 year period. Korea stands out for the fastest growth per employee, indicating substantial improvements in capital, productivity or both. The bottom scale is average annual growth in real GDP, with Taiwan and Singapore on the right expanding around 6 percent per annum. The left scale measures growth in real GDP per employee.

What is startling is Korea's faster rise in output per employee than in overall output. This is partly explained by strong capital investment, and partly by the temporary slump in employment that hit Korea harder than the other economies on the chart.

In Taiwan and Singapore, more workers were needed to produce the incremental improvements in overall GDP growth, whereas improvements in both measures were balanced in Hong Kong, the U.S. and Japan. What isn't captured well in this data is output from economic activities that take place in other economies, most particularly Hong Kong's investments in other parts of China.

The next 15 years will likely see continued strong growth in GDP per employee in economies where the use of information technology and mobile communications is already well established. Spreadsheets, e-mail and word processing fed productivity enhancements over the past 15 years, and greater use of such technology – and of applications and capabilities we cannot even begin to imagine – are likely to be key drivers in 2005-20.

### 勞工與生產力

現時香港就業人數處於歷史新高,但失業率依然高踞不下,本會首席經濟師<mark>歐大衛</mark> 從數據中尋找答案。

最近5個月,本港就業人數四度創出新高,現時 已逼近330萬。然而,失業率仍然高企於6.7%, 原因何在?

今年首 10 個月就業人數較去年同期增加 44,385 人,同 期失業和就業不足人數 (在非自願情況下工時不足的人士)分 別減少 32,300 人和 5,423 人。既然就業數字明顯改善,失業 率理應逐漸回落至 4-5% 的正常水平吧?

事實卻不盡然。失業率的計算方法是勞動人口除以就業 人口。當勞動人口增加,就業人數必須同步上升,失業率才 會穩定。因此,在今年1至10月,勞動人口(願意就業者)增 加14,828人,而同期就業人口只上升1.4%,故失業率僅改 善了0.9%。

儘管勞動人口增長落後於總就業人口升幅,但勞動人口 佔全港人口比率仍不斷上升,導致這情況的原因可能有兩 個:(一)人口發展因素——意外出現的生育潮,令就業適齡 人口(15-64歲)升幅加快;(二)經濟因素——求職者增加, 其中包括去年未找到工作的求職者。在二者產生作用之下, 過去5年香港就業適齡人口每年平均上升1.08%,而全港人 口每年僅增長0.8%。圖1顯示勞動人口佔總人口比率和勞動 人口佔就業適齡人口比率的升勢。

圖2顯示,90年代中期,美國、台灣、香港和新加坡的 就業率強勁上升。由於日本人口增長率低,該國就業增長近 乎零。韓國的數字反映亞洲金融危機打擊就業,但過去五 年,該國就業增長率顯著回升,新加坡亦保持穩健,但其他 經濟體系的增長率卻急跌。

對比每名僱員計及整體實質本地生產總值增幅,可反映 生產力變幅。上述6個經濟體系中,美國生產力增幅最大, 其次是香港。本港生產力增長主要由貿易增長帶動。顯然, 貿易比工業 (例如生產小機件) 或農業 (例如生產小麥) 更容 易提升每名僱員的生產力。 圖3顯示過去15年,各經濟體系整體及每名僱員計的實 質經濟增長。按每名僱員計,韓國的經濟增長最迅速,反映 資金及/或生產力大有改善。下方比例尺是實質本地生產總值 平均增長,可見台灣和新加坡整體經濟每年增幅約6%;左比 例尺則是按每名僱員計的實質本地生產總值增長。

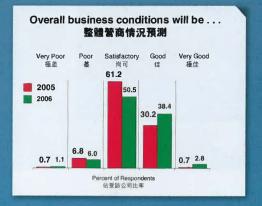
令人吃驚的是,韓國每名僱員產值比整體產值升得更快,原因之一是資本投資龐大,另亦因為韓國就業曾經歷的 短期急跌,比圖中其他經濟體系更嚴峻。

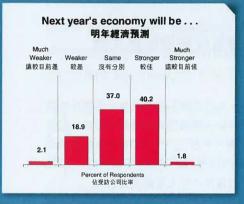
台灣和新加坡的就業人口必須增加,才能逐漸提高整體 經濟增長。至於香港、美國和日本,兩方面的增長步伐皆相 若。然而圖中數據卻未有計入境外經濟活動所得產值,尤其 是香港在內地投資所得產值,並未包括在內。

在早已普及應用資訊科技和流動通訊的經濟體系,預料 未來15年按每名僱員計的本地生產總值會持續強勁上升。過 去15年,試算表、電郵和電腦文書處理的應用大幅提高了生 產力。估計於2005-20年,提升生產力很可能主要靠進一步 應用科技——然而其應用和功能已並非今天所能想像。**B**

### HKGCC's Business Prospects Survey reveals surging optimism in 2005-06

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ong Kong's business community is becoming more upbeat about the prospects of the local economy over the next two years, but are growing increasingly dissatisfied with the environment, according to the findings of HKGCC's annual Business Prospects Survey, released on November 24.

"2004 has been a good year for most businesses in Hong Kong, and many people can actually feel the benefits in one way or the other," HKGCC CEO Dr Eden Woon said. "Our survey shows that the majority of the local business community is becoming more optimistic, and this is a very encouraging sign."

For 2005, 30.9 percent of survey respondents expect overall business conditions to be "good" or "very good," up from 19.2 percent a year earlier. Looking ahead to 2006, conditions are expected to be "good" or "very good" in the opinion of 41.2 percent of the responding companies, and "poor" or "very poor" in just 7.1 percent of those polled.

The optimism within the local business community has also been reflected in their corporate wage review plans for 2005. Some 19.6 percent of the respondents said that there would be a general wage rise, compared with 7.3 percent a year ago. A total of 61.2 percent of the respondents said wage adjustments would be based on performance, up from 42.6 percent a year earlier.

While most respondents are clearly optimistic about the local economy, they are equally clear about their dissatisfaction with the current pollution, 81.2 percent, compared to 68 percent a year earlier.

"Mounting air pollution is definitely a problem faced by everyone living in the territory. There is no doubt that the situation is getting worse and we sincerely hope the SAR Government will take this urgent environment problem seriously and intensify its dialogue with our PRD neighbours on this problem," Dr Woon said.

Following the signing of the Closer and Economic Partnership Arrangement

(CEPA) between the Mainland and Hong Kong, over 39 percent of the respondents are already taking advantage of CEPA opportunities in various ways. Most have benefited through easier access to investment in services and zero tariff on made-in-Hong-Kong goods.

"CEPA has been beneficial to



Hong Kong, but we should look beyond the statistics to see that CEPA has given Hong Kong 'a new story to tell' when promoting its positioning to overseas and Mainland audiences. The Chamber has found receptive listeners when we talk about CEPA in several places we visited – Indonesia, Japan, the U.S., and most recently South America – where we just concluded a Chamber visit," Dr Woon noted.

Meanwhile, about 67 percent of respondents believe GDP will rise between 3 and 7 percent in real terms in 2005. At the other end of the scale, just 1.4 percent think a contraction is likely and 3.6 percent envisage growth faster than 7 percent.

On the government front, the survey examined a number of issues.

"The survey revealed continued and extremely strong support for reducing spending, through trimming the size of the civil service and other measures," Dr Woon said.

A total of 69 percent of respondents support reducing the size of the civil service while 65.5 percent favour a cut in civil service pay and/or benefits.

"Civil servants' pay is significantly higher than that for similar jobs in the private sector. The Chamber has long called for a comprehensive and coherent plan to reduce government spending. A balanced budget will be essential for Hong Kong's overall competitiveness," Dr Woon said.

The majority of the respondents, about 37 percent, said they will support a broad-based consumption tax such as a Goods and Services Tax (GST) or Value Added Tax (VAT) if these are in conjunction with reduced government operating expenditure.

Overall, 37 percent of respondents were satisfied with the SAR Government's performance compared with 21.8 percent from a year ago. Some 60.9 percent said they were dissatisfied compared with 76.6 percent from a year earlier.

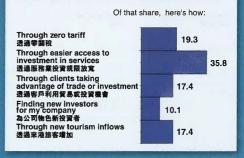
The Chamber's annual Business Prospects Survey was conducted from mid-October to mid-November this year. It contained 43 questions covering a broad range of topics of concern to the local business community. Among these are the outlook for economic and business conditions, Hong Kong's competitiveness, the SAR Government's role, Hong Kong's situation, Mainland economic relations, and background information on the respondents. There were 281 valid responses received for a 9.3 percent response rate. The survey has been conducted every year since 1998.

# 工商界看好前景

總商會「商業前景問卷調查」反映商界對 2005 及 06 年 前景更感樂觀

港總商會於11月24日發表 的年度「商業前景問卷調 查」結果顯示,香港工商界 對未來兩年本港經濟前景更感樂觀, 惟對環境問題不滿者趨增。

總商會總裁翁以登博士説:「對本 港多數行業而言,2004年營商情況良 好,市民能在多方面切實受惠。本會的 調查顯示,香港工商界普遍對本港經濟 前景更感樂觀,這迹象令人鼓舞。」

在今年調查中,30.9% 受訪公司 預期 2005 年香港整體營商情況會是 「佳」或「極佳」,多於去年調查的 19.2%。展望 2006 年營商情況, 41.2 % 受訪公司預期會是「佳」或 「極佳」,只有 7.1% 預計情況會是 「差」或「極差」。

本地企業的 2005 年薪酬檢討結果 亦反映工商界的樂觀情緒。受訪公司 之中,表示會全面加薪及按表現調整 薪酬者,分別佔 19.6% 及 61.2%,去 年比率則分別為 7.3% 及 42.6%。

雖然大部份受訪公司對本港經濟 感樂觀,但81.2%受訪公司對污染問 題感不滿,去年比率則為68%。

翁博士説:「空氣質素每況愈下, 對本港居民構成威脅。空氣污染情況無 疑會繼續惡化,我們冀望特區政府正視 這個逼切的環境問題,尤其加快與珠三 角鄰近省市政府作出溝通。」

自內地與香港簽定「更緊密經貿 關係安排」以來,近 39% 受訪公司表 示現正透過各種方式利用「安排」帶 來的機遇,其中放寬服務業投資規 限,和給予港製產品零關税優惠令最 多企業獲益。

翁博士指出:「我們不應只按統 計數字來衡量『安排』對香港的好 處。事實上,『安排』是個新賣點, 有助香港向海外和內地宣傳本身角色 定位。今年本會曾先後訪問印尼、日 本、美國,而最近亦剛完成南美訪問 行程返港,我們在各國所接觸的海外 人士均對『安排』很感興趣。」

同時,約67%受訪公司預測2005
年本地生產總值實質增長將介乎3至
7%,只有1.4%認為經濟會收縮,另
有3.6%估計經濟增長會超過7%。

調查結果反映工商界對多項政府 問題的意見。

翁博士説:「調查顯示,受訪公 司仍大力支持削減開支,方法包括削 減公務員人手和其他措施。」

69% 受訪公司支持削減公務員人 手, 65% 則贊成削減公務員薪酬及/ 或福利。

翁博士續說:「目前,公務員薪 酬遠高於私人機構同類職位的薪酬。 本會早已促請政府制定一套周詳而連 貫的節流方案,因為收支平衡對維持 香港整體競爭力十分重要。」

大部分受訪公司 (約 37%) 表示, 他們會支持開徵税基廣闊的消費税, 如商品及服務税或增值税,惟政府須 同時削減營運開支。

整體而言, 37% 受訪公司滿意特 區政府表現,去年比率則為 21.8%;不 滿意的約有 60.9%,去年則為 76.6%。

總商會今年的「商業前景問卷調 查」於本年10月中至11月中舉行, 問卷內提出43條本地工商界關注的問 題,涵蓋經濟及商業前景、香港的競 爭力、特區政府的角色、香港前景、 與內地經濟關係,以及受訪公司的背 景資料。「商業前景問卷調查」自 1998年起每年進行。本年調查收回 281份有效問卷,回覆率9.3%。

### **Renminbi Appreciation:** The Pros and Cons for China



Speculators are adding to the pressure for the renminbi to appreciate, but as RUBY ZHU explains, there is no easy solution to the problem

alls for renminbi revaluation from the market grew louder following the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) meeting last month. However, China, backed by strong economic development, will not allow pressure from other countries to dictate its currency policy. In addition, renminbi exchange rates are still controlled by the central bank, which controls the capital account. Nevertheless, the PRC's fixed system and the depreciation of the US dollar are putting a lot of pressure on its financial system.

#### **Positive factors**

The PRC had over US\$510 billion in foreign exchange reserves at the end of September, out of which an estimated US\$100 billion is speculative money betting that the renminbi will appreciate. This year alone, Mainland residents have converted personal savings worth US\$20 billion into renminbi.

The dollar's fall against other major currencies, the euro and yen, has pushed up oil and natural resources prices. Although the Mainland's foreign trade volume is expected to reach US\$1.1 trillion this year, this kind of buying high and selling low comes at a great cost. For example, imported materials have resulted in China "importing" inflation, which caused the Mainland's industrial product wholesale prices index to jump 9 percent in August, and put pressure on prices of end products.

#### **Negative factors**

Renminbi appreciation might appear to be a solution to such a problem, but other factors are standing in the way. A stronger renminbi could slow exports and investment, which would in turn impact employment. Although this year's rise in peasants' wages may ease employment pressures, the PRC Government needs to keep in mind the impact that renminbi appreciation could have on employment stability.

China is currently awash with foreign exchange reserves, but speculators are threatening its financial stability. In the second half of this year, China's short-term foreign loans accounted for 42 percent of total foreign loans, far exceeding the international security level of 25 percent. A sizeable number of these loans have been drawn by speculators who are betting that the renminbi will appreciate. Moreover, with everyone expecting renminbi appreciation, foreign invested enterprises are accumulating their realised profits with the plan to remit them out in US dollars when the time is right. An estimated US\$15 billion in non-remitted profits have been accumulated in Shanghai, and the amount in Guangdong and other coastal cities is expected to be even higher.

#### **Measures adopted**

Assistant Governor of the Central Bank Li Ruogu said that the Central Bank will not adjust the exchange rate due to massive speculative activities and international pressure. It seems that the central bank is determined not to allow speculators to use China as an ATM, and has already taken steps to ease pressure on the renminbi.

Firstly, the Ministry of Commerce relaxed controls on domestic enterprises investing overseas. To provide a proper investment channel for foreign exchange within the country, overseas investments under US\$30 million can be approved by provincial bureaux. The central bank has also relaxed controls on outward remittances of personal assets. Personal assets below RMB\$200,000 can be remitted in one lot, while assets over RMB \$500,000 can be remitted within two years.

The soon to be implemented QDII scheme also aims to relieve foreign exchange pressure. Obviously, all these new measures are an attempt to relax foreign exchange controls, move the Mainland closer to opening up its capital account, and to act as a release valve for foreign exchange pressure. Capital controls have intensified pressure on the renminbi to a certain extent, but completely opening its capital account is probably a medium-term goal of the central bank rather than a short-term solution.

To increase foreign exchange individual savings rates, the central bank raised interest rates for personal dollar deposit accounts by 0.3125 percent on November 18. Moreover, to plug the growth of shortterm foreign loans, the central bank raised the foreign exchange deposit reserves

## 人民幣升值對中國的利與弊

投機活動正增加人民幣升值壓力,問題並不容易解決。

PEC會議之後,市場對人民幣 升值的呼聲重新高漲。然而中 國政府在經濟發展到現今的水 平時,他國的壓力已不能完全左右中國 的貨幣政策。再加上仍未開放資本帳 戶,央行仍然可以控制人民幣的利率。 但由於固定的匯率機制和美元貶值,內 地金融市場亦面臨壓力。

#### 正面因素

截止9月底,內地的外匯儲備已超 過5,100億美元,央行為此要投放大量 的本幣,在中國實施宏觀調控控制貸款 規模的情況下,無疑倍添壓力。而且這 5,100多億美元的外匯儲備中,約有 700到1,000億美元是博人民幣升值的 熱錢。僅內地居民在今年就已將200億 美元的個人存款換為人民幣。

其次,由於美元相對於歐元和日元 的貶值,使礦產及石油等資源性產品的 國際價格大幅飆升,貴買賤賣,使中國 在對外貿易中的損失不菲,雖然外貿規 模急劇膨脹,今年將達11,000億美 元,但中國受惠有限並引發大量貿易摩 擦。而且進口原材料導致輸入通脹,內 地工業產品的批發價格指數在今年8月 已上升9%,為下游終端產品增添價格 上升壓力。

#### 反面因素

似乎人民幣升值可以解決上述問 題,但又有另外的因素阻礙人民幣升 值。人民幣升值會減少出口,降低外商

requirement of financial institutions up from 2 percent to 3 percent, effective January 15, 2005. The rise will help rein in foreign loans, especially since dollar interest rates are expected to rise further.

#### Outlook

Renminbi appreciation alone is not the solution, as this could create a flood of hot

#### 已採取的措施

#### 前景

weaken, the peg is becoming increasingly irrelevant. China needs to construct another renminbi exchange system that will allow greater flexibility of exchange rates, further relax its capital controls and improve its exchange market.

hina's economic success is giving rise to "China bashing" in the West and opening up a whole new can of protectionistic worms as political parties look for a scapegoat to pin their problems on, says the former director of the World Economic Forum's Asia operations.

"We can see that China bashing around the world is an interesting phenomenon," Dr Frank-Jurgen Richter, President of HORASIS told members at the Chamber's November 8 roundtable luncheon. "We have even started to blame China for the rise in oil prices. So everything we don't like we blame on China."

As a result, citizens are increasingly calling on politicians to protect their factory jobs. Eager to win votes, politicians – and more frighteningly rightist parties – are only too willing to play on the public's fears to further their own causes. The U.S., for example, used to be considered a symbol of free trade and globalisation. Campaign pledges during the run up to the U.S. presidential election portrayed the U.S. as an increasingly protectionistic nation trying to keep imports out and factories at home. Protectionistic fears reached flashpoint in the capital of Spain's footwear industry, Elche, inSeptember. Chinese companies had been building up their own manufacturing plants and their own distribution centers in the town for years, but facing falling business, Spanish protesters marched through the town carrying banners reading "Chinese out." The protest took a more menacing turn when two Chinese-owned warehouses and a lorry belonging to a Chinese entrepreneur were set on fire.

"Globalisation and market principles honoured by most of the world's businesses went up in flames along with the shoes in Elche. So it is quite a horrifying scenario if this China bashing continues," Dr Richter warns.

With almost everything now being manufactured in Asia or in China, Europeans just don't want to realise that the manufacturing era in their countries is coming to an end. So the question to ask, Dr Richter says is: "What will happen to Europe?"

On the extreme right of the spectrum, rightist parties are fanning people's fears about their livelihood to get themselves elected and promote their cause. On the other side of the spectrum, the leftists are withdrawing into their shell and turning their backs on globalisation, against foreign influences, and against China.

In the past, when thinking about globalisation, the argument basically went that Western companies were exploiting the developing world by using cheap labour to boost their profits. That changed slightly when developing countries, like Mexico, began going head-to-head with China to attract FDI. Now, we see what Dr Richter calls the south-north globalisation conflict.

"Basically, it is countries like China – and India by the way – that are the winners of globalisation, and the West – Europe and North America – that are the losers. So it is now reverse globalisation if you will," he says.

Dr Richter suggests two scenarios could emerge as a result of this. One would see China continuing to grow, leaving Europe further behind, and forcing it to deglobalise and de-industrialise. Rightist parties could even come into power, destabilise the entire continent and reverse the successes that Europe has built up over the past 50 years.

"If I tell this to politicians in Europe now they all say that I am crazy. They say, 'Frank that is impossible, you are crazy.' But if the development continues as it is now, there is really a chance that this worst-case scenario will come into being," he warns.

On the other end of the scenario scale, China continues to be an important engine for growth for the world, but Europe reinvents itself and sets its sights on becoming the most competitive region in the world. Businesses downsize, labour laws and subsidies are brought under control, and the continent decides to abandon manufacturing over the long-term and move into knowledge industries, into education, and into services.

"I think this is the only way forward for Europe," Dr Richter says. **B**

過去,談到全球化,話題總圍繞西 方企業靠剝削發展中國家的廉價勞工來 賺取利潤。但形勢已變,一些發展中國 家如墨西哥,已開始像中國那樣設法吸 引外國直接投資。現今,我們已感受到 Richter 博士所説,全球化帶來的南北 衝突。

# Challenges in Meeting Future Global E

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### Asia's demand for energy will triple over the next 25 years, creating a host of unique challenges, says LEE R RAYMOND

n addressing global energy trends, the place to start is with economic growth, because economic growth depends on having adequate and reliable amounts of affordable energy, and at the same time economic growth tends to lead to increases in energy demand.

Each year, my company's economists and planners take a long-term look at world economic trends and energy growth. Overall, we project just under 3 percent annual economic growth through 2030. Now of course this will fluctuate as business cycles come and go, but we think this is a reasonable long-term forecast for growth.

Energy use will also rise, but by less, because we expect that continued progress will be made in improving the efficiency of energy use. We place energy growth at a bit less than 2 percent annually, reflecting this improvement in energy efficiency.

This efficiency gain is actually an ambitious estimate, in that we expect the pace of improvement to accelerate and exceed that of recent decades. But even with this efficiency gain, the world will see total growth in energy demand of about 50 percent by 2030.

This will be a huge amount of energy. The increase in demand alone will be equivalent to more than 100 million barrels of oil per day, or about ten times Saudi Arabia's current oil production.

#### What type of energy will be demanded in the future?

Without a doubt, for many decades most growth in energy will be for oil, natural gas and coal. Put simply, these are abundant and affordable and we have established technologies for finding and using them.

We project that oil and gas demand will each grow by close to 40 million barrels a day oil equivalent by 2030 and coal by almost 30 million oil equivalent barrels per day. The remainder will come from other sources.

These increases will come despite an improvement in global energy intensity, which is the amount of energy used per unit of economic output. That improvement we forecast to average about 1.1 percent per year, or about one-third faster than the pace since 1970.

And, the increase in petroleum and coal energy demanded will come about even as alternative energy sources grow even more rapidly. For example, we believe wind and solar energy may grow at about 10 percent per year, but because they are such small contributors today, they will remain less than 1 percent of total energy in 2030.

The limitations and dilemmas presented by these alternative energy sources are serious, and can be overcome only with research, significant investments and time. Therefore, we are left with the reality that for many decades the vast majority of energy that we will use will be hydrocarbon energy. That is why we must face seriously the issues that arise when obtaining energy from hydrocarbons.

#### How much and what types of energy will Asia need?

Turning more specifically to Asia, we need to ask how much energy will this region need, and what type of energy will it be?

The short answers are much more, and of all types. Let me explain. Because most Asian economies are growing more rapidly than countries in other regions of the world, their energy requirements will grow faster. Specifically, we foresee average annual economic growth of 5 percent on average through 2030, with China a bit higher at about 6 percent per year. With significant improvements in the efficiency of energy use, it may be possible to limit energy growth to slightly under 3 percent per year, but as my earlier comments should have made clear, this growth will still add up rapidly.

For example, for Asia's most rapidly growing countries – which I call emerging Asia – oil needs will likely more than double by 2030, largely due to increases in the numbers of cars and trucks. Electricity demand will likely triple, and in turn drive a tripling in natural gas demand. Coal, which today represents 35-40 percent of emerging Asia's energy, and about 55 percent in China, will continue to grow and likely double by 2030.

### What are the implications of this energy growth for Asia?

If we are close to the mark on energy developments and energy growth, what will the implications be for countries in emerging Asia, including particularly China? Let me offer some thoughts.

First, we expect there will be many more cars. By 2030, Asia's car population could rise from about 60 million to over 400 million, which is an enormous increase and in fact would surpass the car fleet of North America by nearly 100 million vehicles. Regardless of the precise level, there will be much more need for automotive fuel.

Second, electricity use will also increase rapidly, and about twothirds will be supplied from coal power plants. Coal will be gradually relinquishing share to natural gas, which by 2030 will fuel nearly one-fifth of power generation needs. Regionally, nuclear and hydropower growth is also expected, though their combined shares of power generation will likely remain well under 10 percent.

Third, the increase in the number of trucks and automobiles will generate a very large demand for investment in constructing the roads to accommodate them, while the much-increased electricity demand will impose very significant power sector investment burdens. To give you an example, the International Energy Agency estimates that 60 percent of the world's energy investment needs through 2030 will be in the power sector.

Fourth, with so many more cars and trucks, with rapid industrial growth, and with much greater electricity generation from

coal, air quality and pollution concerns will become ever-greater public issues. This is already a major issue for Hong Kong as a result of rapid growth in the surrounding Pearl River Delta; so clearly, balancing between cost and cleaner fuels will be a factor for consideration for this region.

Fifth, the dual pressures from increasing energy needs and greater environmental emissions will give an ever-stronger impetus for China to focus greater attention to the efficiency with which energy is used. China will have the benefit of being able to adopt technologies that have earlier been developed overseas, but clearly the importance of economic investments to enable efficient and wise use of energy cannot be overestimated.

Finally, the large increase in oil and gas that will be needed even with conservation and efficiency gains will mean that this region will require a very large increase in imports.

For example, a recent estimate by the International Energy Agency placed Chinese import dependence in 2030 at more than 80 percent for oil and about 30 percent of natural gas. Statistics like this have evidently attracted notice in Beijing, leading to discussion of plans to address import dependence.

If this demand and import growth materialises, the bulk of the imports will need to be supplied from Africa and the Middle East.

Overall, meeting Asia's energy needs will be quite challenging in the next several decades. It will be necessary for Asian countries to adopt a full array of energy options, including more hydropower, more nuclear, more coal – as well as importing more LNG and facilitating oil and gas production in the region.

Moreover, Asian countries will have to compete for these supplies with both North America and Europe. No country has a preferential right to specific energy supplies. Every country or company must compete for those supplies in the global marketplace.

#### Steps needed to meet longer-term energy needs and improve environmental quality

But there are other important considerations that are more general and relate to the more distant energy future.

First among these is the development of sufficient energy resources to meet future energy needs and support economic progress. As time goes on, energy needs will grow. Eventually, the resources we use now will prove insufficient, or will entail costs that we would wish to mitigate.

We hope to identify the most promising technologies for lowemissions, high-efficiency energy supplies. We wish to identify the barriers to the application of these technologies on a worldwide basis.

At the same time, we should not delude ourselves into thinking that this pursuit of next-generation energy will be an easy endeavour. The issues that present themselves are very hard problems to solve, there are no clear near-term answers, and no one has yet found a way to resolve the problems without risking serious economic consequences.

Successfully overcoming future energy challenges will require strong cooperation between companies and government to establish the necessary investment climate and to help balance the economic and environmental concerns of the public. **B**  析全球能源趨勢,應先從經濟增長入手,因為這與能源供應的充裕、可靠和可負擔程度有密切關係,而且,經濟增長往往帶動能源需求上升。 每年,本公司經濟師和規劃師都會對全球經濟趨勢及

能源需求增長作出長遠預測。我們預計由現時到2030年, 每年環球經濟增長將低於3%。當然,隨著商業周期轉 變,短期數字會有上落,但長遠而言,我們認為這預測仍 是合理的。

能源需求亦將增加,但由於估計能源效益不斷提高, 所以需求增幅會較少,略低於每年2%。

事實上,我們大膽假設能源效益會不斷提升,速度甚至比近數十年更快。儘管如此,至2030年,全球能源需求總增幅仍將高達50%。

這是一個龐大的數字,相當於每日需要逾1億桶石 油,或目前沙特阿拉伯石油產量的10倍。

#### 未來需要那種能源?

未來數十年的能源需求增長無疑將集中於石油、天然 氣和煤,理由是三者的產量充足、價格可負擔,開採和運 用它們的科技亦已發展成熟。

我們預測,到 2030年,石油和天然氣的需求增長將分別相當於每日近4千萬桶石油,煤的需求增長則相當於每 天近3千萬桶石油,餘下是對其他能源的需求。

儘管全球能源密度(每單位經濟產值的能源用量)改善, 能源需求仍會增加。我們預料能源密度每年平均下降 1.1%, 較 70 年代以來的下跌速度快約三分一。

即使替代能源的產量快速增長,全球對石油和煤的需 求仍會上升。以風能和太陽能為例,我們估計產量以每年 約 10% 增長,但兩者的貢獻微不足道,到 2030 年,它們 佔全球能源需求的比例仍不足 1%。

應用替代能源面對不少限制和困難,必須投入大量資 源、時間來研究和發展才能解決。重歸現實,未來數十 年,我們所用的大部分能源依然來自烴類<sup>,</sup>並須正視從烴 類提取能源所產生的問題。

#### 亞洲需要那種能源?需求有多大?

至於亞洲,我們需要多少能源和需要那種能源?

答案是,亞洲的能源需求更大,而且各種能源都需要。 且聽我解釋箇中原因。由於大部分亞洲國家的經濟增長較全 球其他地區迅速,其能源需求亦增長得更快。我們估計由現 時至2030年,亞洲經濟每年平均增長5%,中國則略高, 每年約6%。隨著能源效益顯著提高,亞洲能源需求增長可 能稍低於每年3%,但正如先前所說,<sup>\$</sup>累積增幅仍很可觀。

以亞洲發展得最快的國家 (簡稱為新興亞洲) 為例,到 2030年,由於汽車和貨車數目增加,石油需求可能增至現 時的兩倍以上。電力需求亦可能增至目前的三倍,帶動天 然氣需求亦大增三倍。煤現佔新興亞洲能源需求 35% 至 40%,中國則約佔 55%,其需求量亦會持續上升,至 2030年很可能是目前的兩倍。

#### 亞洲能源增長有何含意?

那麼,能源發展和增長趨勢對新興亞洲,尤其中國,有 何含意?

首先,亞洲汽車數量會飆升,由現時約6千萬輛增至 2030年的4億輛以上,比北美多出近1億輛。不論確實增 幅如何,<u>重點是汽車燃料需求將大</u>增。

第二,用電量亦會迅速增加,約三分二的電力將來自燃 煤發電廠,但天然氣發電的比率會逐漸提高,到2030年, 約佔發電燃料五分一。區內核能和水力發電量也會上升, 惟兩者合佔發電比例可能仍遠低於10%。

第三,貨車和汽車數目上升,刺激道路建設投資需要, 然而電力需求急升,相關的投資將成為沉重負擔。國際能 源機構估計,至 2030年,全球能源投資需求中,有6成屬 於電力方面的投資。

第四,隨著車輛愈來愈 多,工業發展迅速,加上燃煤 發電量不斷上升,空氣素質和 污染問題將更受公眾關注。珠 江三角洲近年迅猛發展,今本



港空氣質素問題備受關注。顯然,亞洲地區須考慮怎樣平 衡成本與環境因素。

第五,能源需求和排放量上升的雙重壓力,將促使中國 更加重視能源效益。中國可受惠於海外早已開發的技術, 但也不能過分高估這方面投資的成效。

最後,儘管亞洲在節約能源和提高能源效益方面取得成 果,石油和天然氣需求仍大增,意味亞洲需大幅提高能源 進口量。

例如,國際能源機構最近估計,至2030年,中國石油 和天然氣的進口比例分別為8成以上和3成。在北京,這些 統計數字已引起關注和成為討論議題。

若預測成為事實,中國的進口能源將主要來自非洲和 中東。

總括而言,應付亞洲未來數十年的能源需求是一項重大 的挑戰。亞洲國家必須實行一系列能源方案,包括增用水

力發電、核電和煤,進口更多 液化天然氣,以及提高區內石 油和天然氣產量。

此外,亞洲國家須與北美 和歐洲競爭,以取得能源供 應。在各種能源供給上, 國家享有優先權, 公司均須在全球市場上競爭。

滿足長遠能源需求及改善 環境的方法

然而,還有其他更重要、關乎未來能源供應的廣泛性問 題須予考慮。

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開發足夠能源,以應付未來能源需求及支持經濟發展是 其一。能源需求將與日俱增,現有資源將不敷應用,屆時 能源成本會高得難以負擔。

我們希望研究出低排放、高能源效益兼具優厚發展潛力 的能源技術,以及找出妨礙全球應用新技術的困難所在。

與此同時,我們不能輕視這件工作的難度。事實上,開 發新能源牽涉的問題絕不簡單,短期內亦不會得到明確結 論。至今,我們仍未找到一個既可解決能源需求問題,而 又不會妨礙經濟發展的方法。

要成功解決未來的能源問題,商界和政府必須衷誠合 作,共同建立合適的投資環境,協助平衡社會對經濟和環 保的訴求。B

#### 如何提高競爭力排名?

世界經濟論壇最新公布的增長競 爭力指數 (Growth Competitiveness Index) 排行榜上,香港排名由去 年的第24位晉升至今年的第21位。不 過有批評者認為這指數的調查方法已過 時,不能反映各地區的真正競爭力。

例如,佔據前十大位置的國家,都 是全球税率最高、勞工法例最嚴、且生 活水平最高的地方。反觀香港,是全球 税率最低、税制最簡單的地區之一,法 律容許的自由度亦較大。

那麼,若實行唐英年的開徵銷售稅建 議,加上引入新的勞工法例和反競爭法, 對提高香港的排名,有利?還是有害?

世界經濟論壇首席經濟師Augusto Lopez-Claros博士11月17日在本會午 餐會上表示,這調查沒有把高税率視為 不利因素。

他説:「雖然商界一般不歡迎高税 率,但全球最具競爭力的國家都徵税不 輕,這豈不諷刺!」

他解釋,這些國家的政府,都願意 投放大量資源來教育和培訓人民,故人 力資源質素很好。政府亦保持高透明 度,讓納税者清楚知道税收用途。培訓 人才是一項昂貴而長遠的工作,但營商 者都明白,提高人力資源質素,最終會 令他們得益。

Lopez-Claros博士説:「然而,若 營商者覺得政府亂用税收,那高税率便 會成為不利因素。走那一條路,就看香 港怎樣運用税收了。」

他說立例規定最低工資及最高工 時,基本上不會影響香港排名,因為調 查沒有計入這些因素,但承認營商者普 遍抗拒影響勞工市場的法規,故亦有需 要計入這些因素,並續說世界經濟論壇 的下年度調查,會把市場彈性,還有反 競爭政策,列入考慮因素。

Lopez-Claros博士認為,改善財政 平衡,及加強普及專上教育,將大大有 助香港提升排名。

他説:「我真不明白,香港經濟正



#### '3+3+4 Reform'

Hong Kong's education system has produced many outstanding people, so if something isn't broken, why try to fix it? Professor Arthur K C Li, Secretary for Education and Manpower, asked at the Chamber's November 15 luncheon on the government's "3+3+4 education reform proposal."

"One simple reason is that the community is saying the quality of our graduates is not what it used to be," he said.

Language standards continue to fall, more youths are leaving school without any qualifications and are unemployable, and with three to four hours of homework to do every night, children are bored with studying and have no time to develop other interests or learn any vocational skills, he added.

Giving all children one extra year of high school, and one extra year of university, will hopefully take some of the exam-culture stress off their shoulders and encourage them to broaden their non-academic skills.

#### 「三三四」教育改革

香港的教育制度培育了不少優秀人才,要不是當中有問題,為何要推 行改革?教育統籌局局長李國章教授於11月15日總商會小型午餐會談政 府的「三三四教育改革方案」,並於會上提出這個問題。

他説:「其實理由很簡單,因為社會普遍認為,現今畢業生的質素已 下降。」

他續說,語文水平不斷降低,愈來愈多年輕人低學歷、失業;學童每 晚做三、四小時功課,令他們失去學習興趣,亦無暇培養其他興趣或學習 職業技能。

李局長認為,讓高中和大學教育分別延長多一年,可望減輕學生的考 試壓力,及鼓勵他們學習更多非學術性技能。

香港大學畢業生人數低,也是影響 排名的重要原因。排第1位的芬蘭,其 大學畢業生數字也是全球之冠,台灣僅 次其後,在競爭力排行榜上名列第4。 他說:「同樣,我也不明白為何這 裡大學收生率這麼低。人才質素能影響 一國的競爭力。因此,要提升競爭力, 便要提供更好的教育和培訓。」

KGCC concluded an eleven-day visit to Miami, Sao Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Buenos Aires and Santiago last month. This was the first Chamber study mission to South America since 1992. In each of the cities visited, the Chamber delegation was just ahead of President Hu Jintao on his South American tour before the APEC Leaders Meeting.

During the mission, Chamber delegates met with a number of senior government officials, including: Dr Raúl de Jean, Undersecretary of Industry of Argentina; Dr Federico Poli, Undersecretary for Small and Medium Enterprises of Argentina; Alfredo Chiradia, Secretary for Trade and International Economic Relations Ambassador of Argentina; and Karen Poniachik, Executive Vice-President of the Foreign Investment Committee of Chile. The delegation also had the opportunity to meet local business people, including Ricardo Semler, President of Semco, the renowned Brazilian machinery manufacturer.

Officials briefed Chamber delegates on the general economic climate, business environment, investment incentives and support provided to investors in each of the countries visited.

Brazil's economy began to recover in 2000 and has enjoyed a trade surplus since 2002. Agriculture accounts for about a third of export earnings and to around 8.4 percent of its GDP growth.



港總商會為期11日的南美 訪問行程於上月結束返港。 這是總商會自1992年以 來,首次出訪南美。代表團此行到訪 邁亞密、聖保羅、里約熱內盧、布宜 諾斯艾里斯及聖地牙哥,剛好比國家 主席胡錦濤在出席亞太經合會議前進 行的南美之行早一步。

訪問期間,代表團與南美三國多 名政府高層官員會面,包括阿根廷工 業副部長 Raúl de Jean 博士、中小型 企業副部長 Federico Poli 博士、商貿 及國際經濟關係大使秘書 Alfredo Chiradia 先生及智利外國投資委員會 執行副總裁 Karen Poniachik 女士。 代表團亦有機會與當地商人會晤,包 括巴西著名機器製造公司 Semco 總裁 Ricardo Semler 先生。

接見代表團的官員及商界人士,均 向團員介紹其國內整體經濟和營商環 境,以及給予投資者的優惠和協助。 Main crops include soybeans, for which Brazil is the world's second largest producer, sugar, cotton, cocoa, rubber and coffee as well as wheat, rice, corn and fruits.

Argentina is rich in resources and boasts a well-educated population. Its major sectors are manufacturing, agriculture and mining.

Chile is the world's leading exporter of refined copper and is also the main exporter of potassium nitrate and iodine, claiming a 50-percent share of the world market. Moreover, Chile's exports of services have also become increasingly important, particularly in the transport industry, which represent over half of service exports, and tourism, which accounts for almost a further fifth.

David Eldon, HKGCC Deputy Chairman and mission leader, and Chamber CEO Dr Eden Woon, gave speeches in three of the South American cities visited on the positioning of Hong Kong within Pearl River Delta. They also explained the benefits of CEPA to South American businesses, who expressed a great deal of interest in China and the role of Hong Kong in facilitating business in the Mainland.

"The purpose of this particular mission is to explore business opportunities between South America and Asia," Mr Eldon said during one of his speeches in South America. "Our goal is straightforward: we want to

Commenting on the mission upon returning to Hong Kong, Dr Woon

said, that the warm reception delegates received from their hosts and at several large business matching ~ receptions sent a clear signal that all these countries are looking forward to expanding their markets in China. More importantly, many were interested in using Hong Kong as a middleman.

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"With their vast experience and knowledge in doing business in China, Hong Kong businessmen can use this expertise to their advantage," Dr Woon said. "On the other hand, these South American countries offer attractive import and export opportunities to Hong Kong businessmen."

The HKGCC delegation was led by David Eldon, Chamber Deputy Chairman and Chairman of The Hong Kong & Shanghai Banking Corporation Ltd, and included 20 delegates, including Chamber CEO Dr Eden Woon.

#### Moving Up the Rankings?

ong Kong ranked as the world's 21st most competitive economy in the recently released World Economic Forum's Growth Competitiveness Index rankings, up from 24th slot last year. Critics of the survey argue that its fails to capture the true picture of economies' competitiveness because the methodology is outdated.

For example, the top-10 countries have the highest tax rates in the world, while Hong Kong has one of the lowest and simplest tax systems anywhere. Their labour laws are also among the most rigid compared to Hong Kong's liberal laws, and the cost of living in these countries is also among the highest on the planet.

So if Hong Kong wants to move up the rankings, would Henry Tang's proposed goods and services tax, together with the introduction of a labour law and anti-competition law, improve or hurt our ranking in the World Economic Forum's index?

Dr Augusto Lopez-Claros, Chief Economist, World Economic Forum, speaking at the Chamber's November 17 roundtable luncheon, said the survey does not penalise countries for having high tax rates.

"While business communities com-

plain about high taxes, the most competitive economies in the world are paradoxically those that have the highest taxes," he said.

The quality of the labour force in these countries is generally very high because their governments spend huge sums on education and in training their citizens. They are also very transparent about this, so people know exactly how taxes are being spent. Training up people is an expensive and long-term strategy, and businesses concede that at the end of the day, they are the ones who benefit from a more educated workforce, he added.

"However, if the business community were to feel the tax collected would be frittered away, then that economy would be penalised," Dr Lopez-Claros said. "So Hong Kong could go either way depending on how the money was used."

If Hong Kong were to implement legislation for a minimum wage and maximum working hours, the economist said this wouldn't damage our rankings basically because these issues are not accounted for in the survey. With business communities in general adverse to any regulations which impact the labour market, this is something which the survey needs to address, he conceded, adding that WEF's new survey will take into consideration a flexible market. The same is true for anti-competition policies.

Two issues that would help Hong Kong's rankings in the survey considerably, however, are the balancing of public finances, and a higher rate of tertiary education.

"You have a very high budget deficit in Hong Kong, but I don't understand why this is the case when your economy is booming," Dr Lopez-Claros said. "You should be riding on surpluses."

The low number of university graduates in Hong Kong is also a critical factor in the rankings. Finland, which tops the list, has the highest number of university graduates in the world, followed by Taiwan, which ranks fourth on the index.

"Again, I really don't understand why your university enrolment rate is so low," he said. "It is the quality of the workforce which impacts a country's competitiveness and the way to raise this is by making sure your workforce his well educated and well trained."

# Going Solar

HKGCC visited Hong Kong's largest solar electricity generation system to see if the technology is mature, and cheap enough to go mainstream

Solar electricity generation facilities at Wanchai Tower reduce the building's contribution to greenhouse gas emissions by 23 tonnes annually. The project, the largest solar electricity generation system in Hong Kong, is a pilot scheme run by the government's Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD) to determine if photovoltaic (PV) solar panels installed on buildings can be practical and economically viable.

To find out more about the project, the Chamber organised a site visit to the tower on November 18. Dr Kwok Yu-fat, building services engineer for the EMSD, said the entire system, consisting of 500 sq. meters of PV panels installed on the building's roof and windows as shades, cost HK\$8.15 million. The total peak capacity of the system is 55 kW.

Electricity generated by the panels is fed into Hong Kong's power grid, which was made possible after discussing the project with Hongkong Electric, he said. Impressive as the system is, it still only accounts for just 1 percent of Wanchai Tower's total energy consumption. However, Dr Kwok said he hasn't done any studies to determine if the solar panels mounted on windows, which shade rooms and thus keep them cooler, has helped to bring down the building's air conditioning usage.

All PV panels have been installed facing south to receive maximum solar irradiation. To demonstrate the applicability of photovoltaic technologies locally, the BIPV system is divided into three different sub-systems:

- A rack sub-system comprising poly-crystalline PV panels on the upper roof of the building;
- b) A sunshade-screen sub-system comprising mono-crystalline PV panels in the form of double-glazed panels complete with integrated PV cells. The panels are externally mounted on the building facade to provide shading for the upper portion of all south-facing windows from 1st to 12th floors; and
- c) A skylight sub-system comprising mono-crystalline PV panels in the form of double-glazed panels complete with integrated PV cells. It is mounted vertically to replace some of the glassinfill of the existing glass atrium at the front entrance hall.

Although installation costs for panels are high, Dr Kwok said costs could be substantially reduced if architects designed buildings to incorporate solar panels at the conception stage. They then would also be able to maximise their effectiveness by positioning panels at their ultimate power generation angle.

"The panels are quite expensive, but their cost is coming down all the time. As the life span of the panels is about 20 years, it could be commercially viable over the long term," he said. B









## 建築物應用 太陽能發電

總商會率團參觀全港最大的太陽能發電 系統,以了解這種科技的成熟程度和經 濟效益。

港最大的太陽能發電系統已裝設於灣仔政府大 樓,該系統產生的電力,間接令電廠每年減少排 放二氧化碳 23 噸,有助減低全球溫室效應。機電 工程署利用該系統進行試驗計劃,研究於建築物裝設光伏 板的技術和經濟可行性。

為進一步了解有關項目,總商會於11月18日率團到灣 仔政府大樓參觀。機電工程署屋宇裝備工程師郭裕發博士 表示,這工程耗資815萬港元,包括在大樓天台及窗戶裝 設共500平方米光伏板,系統最高總發電量為55千瓦。

郭氏稱他們經已和香港電燈公司談好<sup>,</sup>把系統產生的電 力輸進香港電力網絡。

整套系統龐大先進,但其發電量卻只夠供應灣仔政府大 樓總用電量 1%。郭博士指掛於窗戶的光伏板能遮擋陽光, 但他們並未研究這是否有助降低室內溫度,從而能減低大 廈的冷氣用量。

所有光伏板均向南安裝,以盡量接收陽光。該系統共分 3個子系統,以展示不同的光伏科技在本港的應用方法,即:

- a) 支架式子系統:由複晶光伏板組成,安裝於建築物天台上;
- b) 遮陽篷式子系統:由雙層玻璃光伏板組成,並配有內置 的單晶光伏電池。這些光伏板安裝於建築物的外牆,為 1樓至12樓所有向南窗戶的上半部提供陽光遮擋;和
- c) 天窗式子系統:由雙層玻璃光伏板組成,並配有內置的 單晶光伏電池。這些光伏板垂直安裝於正門入口大堂 內,以取代其玻璃中庭部分現有的玻璃牆身。 安裝光伏板的工程昂貴,但郭氏指若早在建築設計階

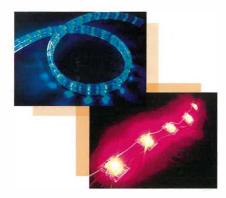
段,便加入光伏板的構思,那建造費用會相宜得多,並能 把光伏板裝設於最佳位置,以發揮最大的產電效益。

他説:「光伏板成本頗高,不過價格正一直下降。光伏 板的壽命約為20年,長遠而言,也具有商業可行性。」



The City of Lights is burning brighter than ever this year as Christmas decorations paint a festive glow across Hong Kong

he Christmas season is finally upon us. But for Sonya Wu, Christmas began five months ago. "We need to start work on designing Christmas lighting decorations and street displays in the summer and then submit our tenders to the government," the Parsons School of Design and Harvard-trained graphic designer says. "So I guess I'm quite lucky in that Christmas lasts for half a year for me."



Her latest project, to design and install Christmas decorations for Tuen Mun and Shamshuipo, began in June with research into the areas to find out how local people would like to see their neighbourhoods decorated. Her team of designers then started work on bringing those ideas to life in lights.

"Shamshuipo is well known for computers and IT equipment, and also as a wholesale fashion area, so we have tried to customise these local flavours into the Christmas decorations," she explained.

Combining traditional Christmas decorations and themes with local characteristics in the designs helps promote the districts, and adds a dash of uniqueness to the areas. Such an approach has also helped her win government tenders for the National Day festivities in October, and the Chinese New Year festival and tourism promotion lighting for the Eastern, Shatin, Cheung Sha Wan, Lai Chi Kok, Mei Fu and Tsuen Wan districts.

Beyond design, Ms Wu says the technical considerations also play a significant role in determining how the displays will look.

"We also need our structural engineers to evaluate the installation, weight, wind factor, voltage, maintenance, et cetera, to make sure everything is as safe and as practical as possible," she says.

Once designs are finalised, plans are sent to her family's business, Hong Kong & Asia Ltd., to be produced. The arrangement ensures that strict quality control standards are adhered to. "Obviously, if even a small part of a lighting installation fails then the whole display can be ruined, so we have to make sure no corners are cut on quality," Ms Wu says.

## 璀璨燈飾耀香江

#### 今年本港聖誕燈飾比往年更繽紛奪目,為市內添上濃厚節日色彩。

近年尾,聖誕節快將來臨, 但胡安的聖誕節早在5個月 前已開始。 曾於帕森設計學院和哈佛受訓的平 面設計師胡安説:「在夏天,我們 便已著手設計聖誕燈飾和街道佈 置,然後競投政府項目。我覺得自

己很幸運,因為我的聖誕節有半年 那麼長。」

胡氏的最新任務,是設計及安裝 屯門和深水埗區的聖誕燈飾。早在 今年6月,他們開始調查區內居民 對地區裝飾佈置的喜好,繼而由設 計小組接手,構思怎樣以燈飾來表 達意念。

她解釋:「深水埗以電腦和資訊 科技商品著稱,又是時裝批發區, 我們在設計時,會盡量融入這些地 區特色。」

在傳統聖誕燈飾和主題中, 融入

地區色彩,既特別,又可收地區宣 傳之效。胡氏憑著這個策略,成功 投得十月國慶和農曆新年的燈飾項 目,以及東區、沙田、長沙灣、荔 枝角、美孚和荃灣的旅遊推廣燈飾 項目。

胡氏表示,除設計之外,工程技 術是燈飾佈置的另一個重要元素。

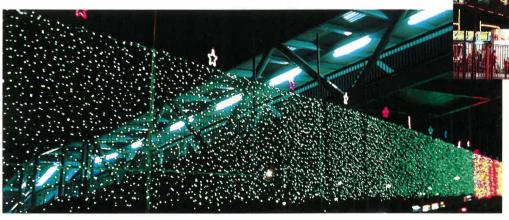
她說:「我們的結構工程師會仔 細評估安裝、重量、風向、電壓、 保養等因素,以確保一切安全和切 實可行。」

設計方案一經落實,便會交予胡 氏家族經營的 Hong Kong & Asia Ltd 承造,確保所有製作工序均嚴格 符合品質控制標準。她説:「顯 然,就算只是一個很小的燈光安裝 工序出錯,也可能會拖垮整個佈 置,所以,我們不能在任何一個細 節鬆懈。」 安霈設計於 2001 年成立,專為 客戶提供平面設計和企業品牌設計 方案。胡氏説,戶外燈飾設計現約 佔公司營業額4成,其次是活動管 理,約佔3成。

她説:「這些服務看似各不相 干,但其實互有關連。由設計活動 宣傳海報和小冊子,以至策劃、管 理和推行活動,每個環節,都需要 以平面設計為基礎,才能成功。」

胡氏的經營哲學為安霈帶來不俗 成績。公司在短短數年內,已擁有多 元化的客戶群,包括政府、酒店及流 行歌手,並曾為柬埔寨第一航空公司 推出全新設計的環球品牌。 3





Although Aspirations was founded in 2001, focusing mainly on providing a graphic design and corporate branding solutions to clients, outdoor lighting contracts now account for around 40 percent of the company's turnover, Ms Wu says, followed by around 30 percent for events. "These services that we offer may seem to be unrelated, but in fact they are actually interwoven," she says. "From the posters and brochures that we create to promote the events, to the planning, management and launch of events; they all need graphic design as their foundation to be a success." Her formula seems to be paying off. For a relatively young company, Aspirations has a wide portfolio of clients, running from government to botek to pop stars, and

government, to hotels to pop stars, and has even created a new livery and global brand launch for First Cambodia Airline. **B**

# Select Service Partner

R estaurants have a tough enough time attracting customers and tempting them back to try other dishes at the best of times. But try doing it at the airport, where repeat business appears to be nil and customers literally run past your operations and quite possibly may never come back.

In spite of these challenges, Select Service Partner (SSP) has managed to build up an enviable repeat customer base, as well as brand loyalty among the 860 million passengers that it serves through its 800 outlets in 140 airports. SSP is a subsidiary of the world's largest foodservice company, Compass Group, which employs over 415,000 employees in more than 90 countries providing foodservices to offices, factories, railway stations, airports, universities, schools, healthcare institutions, and shopping malls, among others.

Creating an "enjoyable dining experience," whether that translates as good value, good food, good service or all three, is the secret ingredient to the company's success, says Daren Lau, General Manager for Asia Pacific Operations, SSP.

Airport food has come a long way since the days when a lukewarm, tasteless bowl of wonton noodles would cost you HK\$80 at the old Kai Tak airport. SSP, the largest food and beverage operator at Chek Lap Kok International Airport, tempts hungry travellers with no less than 16 restaurants, ranging from Burger King to Grappa's to elegant fusion cuisine prepared in open kitchens at Café Déco.

Mr Lau says that about 40 percent of his business customers are repeat diners, over 96 percent of whom are loyal customers. "We even get some Hong Kong people who come all the way out to the airport just to eat at our Hereford Beefstouw Steak House," he says while demonstrating how the restaurant's unique wine aerator works. "This is the only Scandinavian steak house in Asia, and as the owner is very hands on and particular about providing quality food in a stylish setting, we provide a very enjoyable dining experience."

Business looks to be rosy now, but Mr Lau admits it hasn't been any easy journey since SSP started at Chek Lap Kok in 1998. First came the economic slowdown, then the 9-11 terrorist attacks in the U.S., and then SARS. He's optimistic that the worst is now behind us and that business will really take off next year. In the past year alone, the company has opened 11 outlets as part of the Hong Kong Airport Authority's efforts to dramatically upgrade travellers' experiences at the airport.

"We now have so many different outlets that we can suit travellers' preferences, whatever their nationality, tastes or budgets," he says.

About 10 years ago, airports in Europe discovered that they could actually make more money by charging people less, as this encouraged travellers to spend more. Mr Lau says both he and the Airport Authority feel that charging travellers downtown prices is the key to encourage more consumption in the airport.

#### **Cultural tastes**

Running food and beverage outlets in an airport requires a deep understanding of human nature and cultural differences. Although very international, airports around the region have very local characteristics and customers. At Singapore's Changi Airport, where Mr Lau also manages SSP's operations, locals are so proud of their airport that many families spend their weekends wandering around the halls.

"The same thing happened in Hong Kong for the first six months after it opened, but people soon lost interest," he said.

Travellers also behave differently. Western travellers, for example, prefer to go through immigration early, find the location of their gate, and then settle down to a bit of shopping, grab a bite to eat or have a drink. Asian travellers tend to do the opposite, preferring to spend as much time with friends or relatives before going through immigration, Mr Lau explains.

"For business people, a lot of them hold meetings in our outlets before flying off, especially around the time of the big Canton Fair when we see a lot of local

般食肆,既要吸引新客青 睞,又要設法令舊客重臨, 即使市道很好,也不容易 做。至於經營機場餐廳,那難度就更 高了——對象是大批匆匆過境的旅 客,客人重臨光顧的機會似乎是零。

然而,在140 個機場經營 800 多 間食肆的 Select Service Partner (SSP),曾服務 8.6 億旅客,不單成功 建立品牌,更能令許多旅客留下印 象,再三光顧。SSP 附屬於全球最大 的膳食服務集團 Compass Group, 該集團在 90 多個國家有經營點,旗下 員工逾415,000 人,為寫字樓、工 廠、火車站、機場、大學、學校、醫 療機構、商場等提供膳食服務。

SSP 亞太區營運總經理劉達文指

出,成功之道,在於令食客享受和回 味用膳體驗,即無論在價錢、食物和 服務方面,都要令食客滿意。

回想在啓德機場年代,機場餐廳 的雲吞麵既不夠熱,湯底亦淡而無 味,卻要盛惠80大元。相比之下,現 在的機場餐飲無疑大有進步。SSP現 時是赤鱲角國際機場的最大餐飲經營 商,旗下食肆多達16間,包括 Burger King、歌柏斯意大利餐廳,及 供應高級 fusion菜式、設開放式廚房 的峰景餐廳,為飢腸轆轆的旅客提供 多元化的美食選擇。

劉氏表示,光顧他們的商務旅客 中有四成是舊客,顧客忠誠度超過 96%。他說:「有些香港人更專程來 機場光顧我們的希福牛扒屋——全亞 洲唯一的北歐風味扒房,餐廳主理人 拿手泡製一流美食,也懂得創造菜式 風格,另食客們回味無窮。」劉氏更 試範操作餐廳內一部特別的器具,專 給酒品加氣。

看來,公司前景樂觀。劉氏坦言 SSP於1998年進駐赤鱲角機場以 來,經歷不少風浪:先是經濟放緩, 然後是美國9-11事件,還有去年的 沙士。但他相信否極泰來,明年生意 會真正好轉。單在去年,SSP已在 機場增開11間食肆,此舉乃配合機 管局的計劃,務求給予旅客更佳的機 場體驗。

他説:「我們現有更多食肆供旅 客選擇,不但口味多元化,更能滿足 不同國籍旅客需要,而且豐儉由人。」

business people holding meetings with their clients before they take off," he says.

Burger King and Ajisen Ramen are his two busiest outlets at CLK, which appeal to travellers concerned about their schedules.

"The average waiting time, even for a ramen noodle, is less than 5 minutes," he says pointing to a huge tank of boiling water capable of cooking 16 bowls of noodles simultaneously.

Numerous factors are analysed before deciding which restaurants to bring into the airport. The current mix consists of local, Asian and international franchises complimented by SSP's proprietary operations. While it may appear that 16 outlets compete against each other for customers, Mr Lau says each outlet serves a different market segment.

"We have Burger King and Popeye's Chicken & Biscuit next to each other, but if you are Asian, or Muslim, you would probably prefer to eat Popeye's Chicken, which is the second largest chicken chain after KFC," he says.

Similarly, travellers wanting to have a drink with their meal and even a smoke afterwards, would choose Champions Bar, or for even more upscale food and entertainment travellers could try fusion cuisine at Café Déco or sushi at the Toro Bar & Seafood House. These upscale outlets are more popular with business travellers who can use private rooms for meetings, Mr Lau adds. Although SSP's operations at CLK have exploded from three to 16 outlets in just seven years, Mr Lau says he is always on the look out for other brands that he can apply to other airports in the region. As a European firm, SSP is very strong in Western brands, but is looking to expand its line of successful Asian brands, he says. Thai food and noodles are now very popular in Europe, so Mr Lau says he is recommending a number of local brands to headquarters.

For the time being, space prevents SSP from opening more outlets at CLK. But if travellers' tastes start to change, Mr Lau says he will be ready to bring in whatever food tickles their palate. 約十年前,歐洲機場發現,只要 減低收費,便能令旅客在機場消費更 多。劉氏與機管局亦相信,使機場物 價貼近市區水平,能刺激旅客在機場 消費。

#### 文化口味差異

經營機場餐飲食肆,需要對本土 社會文化有深入認識。即使是國際機 場,也會帶有本土特色,及有大量本 地顧客。SSP於新加坡樟宜機場經營 的食肆亦由劉氏管理,他指當地居民 以國家機場為榮,遊覽機場大堂是很 多家庭的周末消遣活動。

他説:「香港新機場啓用後的半 年,也曾出現同樣情況,但這熱潮很 快便過去。」

#### 到最後一刻才進入離境區。

劉氏續說:「許多生意人會在我 們的餐廳與客人開會,在廣州交易會 舉行期間,這情況便很常見,他們趁 客戶等候登機,把握時間談生意。」

在赤鱲角機場, Burger King 和 味千拉麵是 SSP 客量最高的食肆,尤 其適合趕時間的旅客。他說:「平均 等候時間,就算是拉麵,也不用5分 鐘。」店內有個滿盛沸水的大鍋,可 以同時煮 16 碗麵。

在決定於機場開設那些食肆前, SSP 會分析並考慮多項因素。該公司 現時在機場經營的 16 間食肆,有本 地、亞洲及國際專營食肆,也有 SSP 本身擁有的餐廳。看來當中必有一番 競爭,但劉氏指各食肆針對的市場層 二大的雞肉快餐連鎖集團,地位僅次 於肯德基。」

同樣,有些旅客希望在用膳之 餘,也喝一杯甚至抽支煙,他們會選 擇 Champions Bar;要求較高的旅 客,則會嘗試峰景餐廳的 fusion 菜 式,或到 Toro Bar & Seafood House 吃壽司。劉氏補充,高級食肆較受商 務旅客歡迎,因為他們可用餐廳的私 人房開會。

SSP 在赤鱲角機場的食肆,已在 短短7年內由3間擴展至16間,然而 劉氏仍繼續物色其他合適食肆。他表 示,SSP 是歐洲公司,旗下有名的西 餐食肆不少,如今公司希望為更多亞 洲食肆打響名堂。鑑於歐洲現流行泰 式食品和麵食,劉氏建議在機場引入



此外,旅客行為亦有分別。例 如,西方旅客喜歡一早辦妥離境手 續,確定登機閘口在那裡,然後才逛 商鋪,買點吃的或喝的;亞洲旅客則 剛好相反,他們會盡量與親友一起,

#### 面不同。

他説:「雖然 Burger King 和 Popeye's Chicken & Biscuit 兩店毗 鄰,但亞洲人或伊斯蘭教徒多數會光 顧 Popeye's Chicken,它是全球第 本地泰式食店。

由於赤鱲角機場鋪位有限, SSP 暫未能開設更多食肆,但他表示 SSP 會盡力迎合潮流和口味變化,為旅客 帶來更精采的佳餚美食。**B**

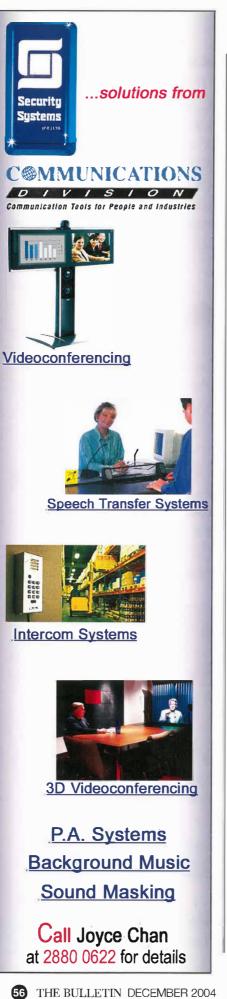
