



## ICC Uniform Customs & Practice for Documentary Credit (UCP600)

Many companies suffer huge losses in L/C transactions. Managers, supervisors and many banks' bills staff are challenged by lack of professional knowledge of L/C. Therefore, the International Chamber of Commerce hold professional examination called "Certified Documentary Credit Specialist" (CDCS) for testing candidates' specialized documentary credit knowledge including the understanding of UCP600 and Incoterms 2000.
