The Chamber organized a site visit to the City University of Hong Kong on May 28 to inspect the latest technologies being developed in the fields of RFID, optoelectronics and robotics. Prof Chan Chi-hou, Dean, Faculty of Science and Engineering, CityU, introduced the work of the university to members during a pre-tour briefing.

Many of the technologies developed by the university are in everyday use in Hong Kong, at the airport, in the MTR, and even by rescue crews who were searching for survivors in the tragic Sichuan earthquake. ❀
