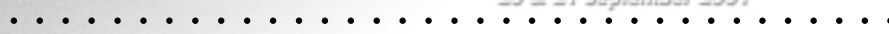




WSC 2001 Selina CHOW

Mrs Chow was educated at St Paul's Co-Educational College and the University of Hong Kong, where she gained a Bachelor degree in English. She went to the United Kingdom to attend the Post Graduate Diploma course at the Rose Bruford College of Speech & Drama and obtained the Licentiate in Drama (Teacher and Performer) of The Royal Academy of Music.

Starting in 1967, she established an extensive career in Hong Kong's television and broadcasting industry, where she served in senior management positions at Television Broadcasts Ltd (TVB), Asia Television Ltd (ATV) and Commercial Television Ltd (CTV).

Mrs Chow is best known for her record in public service, having held numerous official posts since becoming a Member of the former Urban Council in 1980, including membership of the Law Reform Commission, the Housing Authority and the Education Commission, as well as the chairmanship of the Consumer Council.

She has been a Member of the Legislative Council since 1981 and currently represents the Retail & Wholesale Functional Constituency, in addition to being Chairman of the House Committee. She also served on the Executive Council from 1991-2.

As well as chairing the Hong Kong Tourism Board, she is currently a Board Member of the Airport Authority, a member of the Film Services Advisory Committee and a member of the Film Development Fund Projects Vetting Committee.
