Dr. Wang Xinkui, was born in Dinghai of Zhejiang Province in 1947.

From 1978 to 1979, Dr. Wang Xinkui studied at the Department of History of the East China Normal University. In that same year, he became a graduate student majoring in Japanese Economy at the World Economic Research Institute of Fudan University. He was conferred the degree of Master of Arts in economics in 1982. In 1989, he was earned his PhD. in economics at the East China Normal University.

Dr. Wang Xinkui started working for the Shanghai Institute of Foreign Trade (SIFT) in 1982. Since then, he has been engaged in teaching, research and educational administration and has held positions of associate professor, professor, Executive Deputy Dean of the Department. Director of the International Economic and Trade Research Institute of the SIFT. Vice President and President of the SIFT. Owing to his excellent performance, he has been awarded titles of Advanced Teacher of Shanghai and National Model Teacher Prize. He was won the Bao Steel Model Teacher Prize and been granted the special government allowance by the State Council. The Ministry of Personnel has also given him the Award for outstanding Young and Middle-aged Experts Nationwide. Meanwhile, he has held concurrent academic posts of council member of Chinese Society of World Economy, executive council member of Chinese Society of International Trade, executive vice president of Shanghai Society of World Economy, and professor of economics at Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences' Institute of World Economy, etc.

Dr. Wang Xinkui has been doing research for years, on international trade theory, multilateral trade system and the reform of China's foreign trade system as well as practical trade policy decision-making. He is a prestigious economist boasting wide academic contract and influence both at home and abroad.

Since 1982, Dr. Wang Xinkui has published four academic works of about one and a half million words in addition to around 300 academic articles of approximately two million words. He has been responsible for or participated in 30 research subjects at provincial or ministerial levels. Dr. Wang Xinkui has been awarded such academic prizes as one first prize and one second prize, and five third prizes at the provincial or ministerial levels.

At present, Dr. Wang Xinkui is a member of the Standing Committee of the 11th Shanghai Municipal People's Congress (SMPC) as well as a member of the Financial and Economic Committee in SMPC. He is also a senior advisor of Shanghai Municipal People's Government.

Since 2000, Dr. Wang Xinkui has got some new positions on WTO affairs as a member of the Leading Group of WTO Action Plan Works at Shanghai Municipal People's Government and vice chairman and president of Shanghai WTO Affairs Consultation Center as a action body of the leading group.
