ASEAN Mission to Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia

ASEAN continues to draw global attention as one of the world's most dynamic emerging regions. Hong Kong is strengthening its international economic and trade networks, with ASEAN increasingly positioned as a key market for business, tourism and regional connectivity. Against this backdrop, this mission offers a timely opportunity for Hong Kong companies to engage with Singapore, Malaysia and Indonesia, and explore new prospects in trade, investment and financial infrastructure.

Singapore

Singapore is one of Asia's leading financial and business hubs, supported by world-class financial infrastructure, strong trade connectivity, and a robust regional headquarters ecosystem. It continues to strengthen its advanced manufacturing base, with recent growth driven by electronics, semiconductors, and biomedical manufacturing, as well as continued investment in high-impact R&D. Meanwhile, headquarters and professional services remain key drivers of new business investments.

Malaysia

During this mission, we will have a special focus on Johor Bahru. Located at the heart of the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone, the city is being positioned as a cross-border growth node that combines Johor's industrial capacity with Singapore's capital, technology, and global networks. The zone is designed to ease the movement of goods and people, attract high-value projects, and create 20,000 skilled jobs in its first five years. Its strongest momentum is highlighted by advanced manufacturing, logistics, digital infrastructure, and renewable-energy-linked development.

Indonesia

Indonesia is Southeast Asia's largest economy, and Jakarta will remain the country's economic hub even as the political capital gradually shifts. Market growth is fueled by scale, rising consumption, and investment, while sectors such as digital infrastructure, AI and cloud services, downstream processing, and the EV battery value chain are gaining strength.

Itinerary

The high-level delegation will engage with senior government officials, local chambers, and businesses through a series of company visits, and networking events.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. DEFINITIONS

In these Conditions of Participation and the Application Form, save as the context otherwise requires:

"Application Form" means the application form to which these conditions are annexed.

"Conditions" means these Conditions of Participation as amended by the Chamber from time to time.

"Chamber" means the Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce.

"Delegate(s)" means the individual(s) named in Section D of the Application Form.

"Mission" means the mission named in the Application Form.

2. PAYMENT

- (a) Upon submission of its Application, the Full Participation Fee shall be immediately payable to the Chamber.
- (b) Once the Application is accepted by the Chamber, and the Delegate subsequently wishes to withdraw his/her participation, he/she may do so by notice in writing to the Chamber. Participation Fee is non-refundable. Any additional charges incurred by the Chamber as a result of the cancellation shall be paid on demand by the Delegate to the Chamber.
- (c) The Delegate shall indemnify the Chamber against all liabilities incurred by its Delegates in connection with the hotel or venues visited and shall on demand pay to the Chamber immediately all amounts claimed by the hotel against the Chamber in respect thereof.
- (e) All payments by the Delegate to the Chamber shall be made promptly without any deduction, set-off or counterclaim.
- (f) The Chamber reserves the right to offset any balance to be refunded to the Delegate against any outstanding liabilities due by the latter to the Chamber in relation to their participation in the Chamber's other activities.
- (g) No interest will be payable by the Chamber in respect of any refund amounts to the Applicant/Delegate.

3. PARTICIPATION IN THE MISSION

- (a) The Delegate shall comply with the Conditions and with all directions which the Secretariat may from time to time give in connection with any matter appertaining to the Mission.
- (b) The Delegate shall use its best endeavours to uphold the reputation of the Chamber and to promote the success of the Mission.

4. PUBLICITY

The Chamber will arrange for such publicity for the Mission as it shall in its absolute discretion deem fit. No Delegate, nor any officer, representative, agent or employee of the Delegate shall give or cause to be given any interview, public announcement, press statement or any other publicity whatsoever in relation to the Mission.

5. TERMINATION OF RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE

- (a) Without prejudice to the Chamber's other rights and remedies, the Chamber has the right to terminate forthwith by notice the Delegate's right to participate in the Mission on or following the occurrence of any of the following events:-
 - i. if the Delegate commits a breach of any of the Conditions;
 - ii. if the corporation / organisation, which the Delegate represents, enters into liquidation whether compulsorily or voluntarily or compounds with its creditors or has a receiver appointed over all or any part of its assets or if the Delegate, being a sole proprietorship or partnership, becomes or one of its members becomes bankrupt or insolvent or enters into any arrangements with its creditors;
- (b) The Delegate's right to participate in the Mission shall automatically terminate in the event that the Delegate is refused entry visa or entry permit to the country or place where the Mission shall be held by any competent authorities.
- (c) In the event that the Delegate's right to participate in the Mission is terminated, the Participation Fee will not be refunded to the Delegate and any expenses incurred by the Chamber for and on behalf of the Delegate prior to such termination and all other expenses reasonably incurred by the Chamber as a consequence of such termination shall be paid on demand by the Delegate to the Chamber.
- (d) The Chamber reserves the right to terminate the Delegate's right to participate in any future Mission if the Delegate is found to have committed any act including but not limited to failing to respect intellectual property rights of any other party, non-compliance with safety, environmental laws and/or any other act which, in the sole opinion of the Chamber, might damage the reputation and/or image of Hong Kong, its industries, the Mission, the Chamber, or if the Secretariat in his absolute discretion decides that such right shall be terminated.

6. CANCELLATION

The Chamber reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Mission or to shorten or prolong its duration at any time without incurring any liability whatsoever to the Delegate if circumstances outside the reasonable control of the Chamber (including but not limited to war, embargo, civil unrest, terrorist attacks, legal proceedings or government regulations) make it in the sole opinion of the Chamber (which opinion shall be conclusive) impossible, impractical or undesirable for the Chamber to hold the Mission.

7. EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY

- (a) The Chamber shall not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury howsoever suffered by or caused to the Delegate or its Delegates, officers, representatives, agents, employees or any third party, or its Products or other property in the course of or in relation to the Mission, unless such loss, damage or personal injury shall be caused by any breach by the Chamber or its employees of the Conditions.
- (b) The Chamber assumes no responsibilities for any introduction or transaction made between the Delegate and any third party during or as a result of the Mission.
- (c) The Delegate shall be responsible for effecting all insurance coverage necessary in connection with its participation in the Mission including but not limited to insurance in respect of the Products, its other property and its Delegates (including travel and medical insurance).
- (d) The Delegate undertakes to indemnify and at all times hereafter to keep indemnified the Chamber from and against all liabilities, actions, proceedings, claims, damages, costs and expenses whatsoever which it may suffer or incur by reason of or in relation to any act, omission or default by the Delegate or its officers, representatives, agents and employees in the course of or in relation to the Mission.

8. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The Delegate shall not disclose or permit to be disclosed to any person or otherwise make use of or permit to be made use of any information relating to the business or affairs of the Chamber or other Delegates in the Mission which has been acquired by reason of the Delegate's participation in the Mission.

9. WAIVER

No failure or delay by the Chamber in exercising or enforcing any right or power hereunder shall operate or be construed or operated as a waiver thereof. No waiver of any breach shall be construed as a waiver of any continuing or subsequent breach.

10. NOTICE

- (a) Every notice or demand shall be in writing but may be given or made by post, cable, telex or fax.
- (b) Every notice or demand to be given by the Chamber may be sent to the address of the Delegate stated in its Application Form. Every notice to be given by the Delegate to the Chamber shall be sent to the offices of the Chamber at: 22/F United Centre, 95 Queensway, Hong Kong.
- (c) Every notice or demand shall be deemed to have been received in the case of a telex, or fax, at the time of despatch, and in the case of a letter three days after the posting of the same by prepaid post.

11. GENERAL

- (a) Nothing in the Application Form or the Conditions shall create or be deemed to create a partnership or the relationship of principal and agent or employer and employee between the Chamber and the Delegate.
- (b) The Application Form and the Conditions embody and set out the entire agreement and understanding of the parties and supersede all prior oral or written agreements, understandings or arrangements between the Chamber and the Applicant relating to the Mission.
- (c) The Chamber reserves the right to alter and amend any of these Conditions and to issue additional rules and regulations at any time it considers necessary for the orderly operation of the Mission. The amended Conditions and the additional rules and regulations shall be sent to the Delegate and become effective immediately. The Delegate will be deemed to have notice of the same and have accepted the amended Conditions and the additional rules and regulations. The Delegate acknowledges that the Chamber shall have the right to interpret these Conditions, additional rules and regulations together any amendments thereof. All interpretations of these Conditions, any additional rules and regulations, and any amendments thereof by the Chamber shall be final and binding on the Delegates.

12. GOVERNING LAW

The Application Form and the Conditions shall be governed by and construed in all respects in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong and all the parties agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Hong Kong courts.
