Eddy Chan was appointed Regional Vice President, China and Mid Pacific in November 1999.

Based in Hong Kong, Chan is responsible for the overall strategic planning, administration and management of the China, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Macau markets.

Chan joined FedEx in Hong Kong as an account executive in 1985. In 1987, he was promoted to Station Manager, responsible for import and export operations in Hong Kong. In 1990, Chan was assigned to the sales department as District Sales Manager, supervising all sales activities in Hong Kong. He assumed the position as Senior Sales Manager in October 1992. In March 1994, he was appointed Managing Director of Sales for Mid Pacific. Two years later, Chan was appointed Managing Director of Operations for FedEx in Taiwan. In September 1998, Chan was named Vice President and General Manager of China. In April 1999, Chan became Regional Vice President, China and Taiwan.

Chan left FedEx Hong Kong in August 1994, and joined Inchcape Shipping Service as Seneral Manager of Greater China, where he consolidated his knowledge about the world's most thriving market. He returned to FedEx in March 1996.

A Hong Kong citizen born on May 1, 1961, he holds a bachelor's degree in history from the University of Hong Kong.
