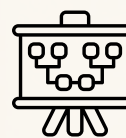

# What Makes This Different

## Why HKGCC

Through HKGCC's business network, students gain access to leaders, workplace exposure and practical learning experiences that go beyond a conventional summer programme.

### Chamber Business Network

Participants gain exposure to HKGCC's business ecosystem, including Chamber leaders, industry professionals, HR representatives and corporate guests.

### Real Workplace Immersion

Participants will visit **Cathay City** for workplace observation and business exposure, helping them connect learning with real corporate environments.

### Power Lunch - Junior Series

Across the 4 days, students will join Power Lunch - Junior sessions with **4+** Chamber and industry leaders. These lunches are designed for leadership sharing, business etiquette practice, professional conversation and confidence building.

### Application, Not Lectures

The programme includes interactive workshops, self-awareness exercises, personal branding practice, individual presentation, pitching training and a final group showcase.

### Career Follow-up

All graduates will receive a Priority Talent Review / Career-Readiness Interview. Top performers may be considered for additional recognition and internship opportunities.

# What Students Will Learn

## Core Learning Pillars



### Personal Branding & Executive Presence

Students will learn how to introduce themselves professionally, create a strong first impression, communicate with confidence and present their personal strengths clearly.



### Future Thinking & Career Mindset

Students will explore how to think beyond fixed career paths, recognise future trends, adapt to uncertainty and take proactive ownership of their development.



### Self-Awareness & Team Dynamics

Through colour-based self-awareness and team exercises, students will better understand their strengths, working style, stress responses and how to collaborate with others.



### Workplace Exposure & Business Understanding

The **Cathay City** visit, Power Lunch - Junior and Chamber-led interactions will help students understand workplace expectations, professional behaviour and real-world business contexts.



### Pitching & Presentation Skills

Students will practise how to structure ideas, present with confidence, engage an audience and communicate effectively under pressure.
