Interview skills workshop

In this workshop, the speaker talked about the interview skills which was very helpful. For example, the make-up and manner of a good interviewer. The speaker also told us the frequently asked interview questions. Thus, we can prepare for the real interviews in the future.

<u>Reflection</u>

In this company visit, I have learnt many useful stuff that can apply in my daily life. I also learnt how a big company works. It is divided into many department and they co-operate with each other to provide the best services to their customers. Sometimes, , the staff may even be required to communicate with their consumers in different countries by using their advanced facilities, such as internet connections. Besides, I have also learnt many interview skills, like presentation techniques and dressing code. Through the mock interview, we have learnt to stay calm in answering some challenging questions and to present the best of your abilities to others.

Job Shadowing with CITIC TELECOM CPC

On the 22 April, we spent the day in the CITIC Telecom CPC office for the job shadowing. It was the first day after their Easter holiday, so they had a lot of work on that day.



Our mentors are employees of the Engineering and Service Project Department. The major service of the company is network service which is service for companies but not the general public. Therefore, they are responsible for setting up the network service for the clients (companies). They stay in the office most of the time, using computers and phones to contact their clients.

From our observation, they always use Putonghua to communicate with the clients, and they use Excel very often. They also told us that their clients prefer using phone to email for contacting. Therefore, they will send an email to the client after making the phone call for confirmation and for keeping record. This is to make sure that the data/information can be used as evidence in the future in case of having any argument. They also mentioned the intranet among their department, which can keep client service records, and share the records among the project managers. This helps the project managers to follow up the cases easier and faster if any of them leave the company.



Through the job shadowing, we can really feel how stressful working is. Many problems will be aroused; the problem solving skills need to be very good, so as the communication skills. We think we should focus more on enhancing our English and Putonghua as an international language as China's market is growing bigger. Furthermore, we have learnt how important group

work is. On that day, one of our mentors, Janice, faced difficulty in solving client's problem, she struggled for a while, and the project manager next to her offered her some help and help Janice solved the problem. In this case, we have learnt the

importance of cooperation which sometimes things cannot be done by only one person. Also, we learnt to keep records and the data carefully and keep it as a habit, to prevent losing information. Otherwise, there will be no evidence to support if anyone challenges it.



Apart from the problem-solving skills and communication strategies, our mentors also taught us about time management, which is applicable and essential in all fields, including both school and workplace. Urgency and importance of an issue is often taken into consideration when we prioritize our jobs. A Lot of people may think that issues in 'Area I' should be done first. In fact, what need most of our time and attention are actually issues in 'Area II' as we can address things before they become urgent, hence

ensuring ourselves having sufficient time and resources to cope with suddenly pop-up, urgent and important issues.

Besides learning the workplace skills, as students, we were encouraged to set up our goals, follow our dreams and choose those related subjects. Our members have shared their experience with us, from finding their jobs to working here in the IT industry. Most of them have studied in universities after setting up their goals. We should now study hard and pursue our dreams. Though the
